RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MCKENZIES ELECTRICAL & RE SOLUTIONS (1300M)
BLATHWAYT underwent a veterinary check at the barrier after blood was observed in the mouth of the gelding and was cleared to start.	
Race 2	KURANUI CLASSIC SPRINT (1000M)
HENRY POOTLE was slow away then was further hampered when MISS LIGHTNING began awkwardly and shifted out. ROSAMOSA began awkwardly dislodging rider B Murray who was uninjured. IRISH KING was hampered and had to be eased shortly after the start when OUR BOI MAX hung inwards. A Taylor reported that DAL SORAY hung out throughout. When questioned into the disappointing run of SAMMY FOX , J Riddell said the mare was fractious prior to the start, travelled comfortably throughout, but when placed under pressure failed to respond as expected.	
Race 3	WAIRARAPA TIMES AGE SPRINT (1000M)
COLONEL LINCOLN was tightened on jumping away. Apprentice rider B Murray (VICE MARSHALL) was shown footage of his ride in the presence of senior rider J Riddell after he allowed his mount to get close on the heels of MI APACHE HORSE which resulted in his mount clipping that runner's heel,	

blundering and almost dislodging him.

COLONEL LINCOLN shifted in abruptly near the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

Race 4 "150 YEAR CELEBRATION OF RACING IN 2015 "3YO (1400M)

MISS MAKI was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 8.15am. A veterinary clearance is required before the filly next races.

The start of this event was delayed approximately 2 minutes at the request of the TAB.

FANTAMO underwent a veterinary examination and was cleared to start after becoming fractious in the barrier.

KAIRANGA LAD hung out leaving the barrier hampering **NOVA EIGHT**.

KAIRANGA LAD over-raced in the early stages.

AWESOME DIVA hung out rounding the final bend.

D Turner (KAIRANGA LAD) was dislodged on pulling up. **D Turner's** obligation to weigh-in was waived. **D Turner** was attended to by St John's staff and cleared to ride.

Race 5 B&B CONTRACTING 1300 (1300M)

WEE JEAN had to be checked and lost ground rounding the first turn when racing inside **REAIS** which hung inwards.

GOLD bumped with **SHAH** shortly after turning for home shifting that runner a little wider as a result.

A Post-race Veterinary examination of **REAIS** revealed the mare to have suffered severe ligament damage to a hind leg and was humanely euthanased.

FRANZAC shifted out under pressure over the final stages.

Race 6 DARKIE BARROW MEMORIAL (2050M)

GIRL WITH A PEARL was slow to begin.

BLAME DE ANGELS made the first bend awkwardly.

I'M BELLA over-raced in the early stages.

ADRIENNE raced three-wide without cover until being allowed to stride forward to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

NO COMMISSION raced three-wide without cover over the final 1000 metres.

I'M BELLA gave ground quickly near the straight entrance and in doing so was hampered when **DUROYAL** and **ADRIENNE** both shifted ground.

When questioned into the run of **ADRIENNE** which finished the race off only fairly, **R Myers** said the mare had to work too hard from its wide draw and the effort told at the finish.

STAR EMERALD charged the gates prior to the start and returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area.

Race 7 MARQUIS OF NORMANBY HOTEL CARTERTON (2050M)

NO FEAR made firm contact with the outside fence on leaving the birdcage and dislodging the rider **A Taylor**. **NO FEAR** underwent a veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching.

ANGEL MINE had to be steadied at the winning post on the first occasion when **BRAD THORN** shifted in when not clear. **J Riddell (BRAD THORN)** was issued with a warning.

Race 8 POPE & GRAY CONTRACTORS (1600M)

OEEE bounded on leaving the barrier and lost ground.

TRIPLE BILLING raced three-wide without cover throughout.

ALICIA which was leading at the time, compounded quickly near the 800 metres and subsequently collapsed. A veterinary examination revealed the mare had died of a heart attack.

When questioned on the run of **DIBIASE**, **H Tinsley** could offer no excuses.
