## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>CROWLEY FORGE MASTER FARRIERS STAYERS</b>
<p><b>JABEZ</b> was slow away and then raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>RED SUNSET</b> raced greenly in the run down the straight on the first occasion and attempted to jump the running rail near the 1600 metre crossing, dislodging <b>R Myers</b> who was attended to by medical staff and cleared to fulfil her remaining engagements. Trainer M Oulaghan was advised that <b>RED SUNSET</b> which sustained moderate to severe grazing, must trial before next racing. All other runners in the field apart from <b>GREY GURU</b> and <b>LUCKY SPUR</b> had to take evasive action being taken wide to avoid the fallen <b>R Myers</b>. <b>HIGGS BOSON</b> was struck by a section of the running rail dislodged in this incident and required veterinary attention for a tendon injury.</p> <p><b>CECIL</b> had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early and middle stages of the run home.</p> <p><b>GREY GURU</b> had to steady near the 100 metres when hampered by <b>HOT LIPS (S Doyle)</b> which shifted out to continue to improve. <b>S Doyle</b> was issued with a warning.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>LINCOLN LODGE JUVENILE</b>
<b>D Bradley (LYRIC'S WAY)</b> received a minor injury to the eye area in the birdcage prior to the race when struck by his mount.	

<p><b>MAGGIE'S SECRET</b> raced keenly down the back straight.</p> <p><b>TORNADO ALLEY</b> hung out rounding the turn and made the 400 metre bend awkwardly.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MCI AND ASSOCIATES / WOODVILLE WAIRARAPA HORSEFLOATS DASH</b>
<p><b>M Dravitzki (JUMP FOR JOY)</b> was injured in the birdcage when struck in the face by her mount and was replaced by <b>S Doyle</b>. <b>M Dravitzki</b> was cleared to fulfil the remainder of her engagements.</p> <p><b>JUMP FOR JOY</b> bounded when the start was made and began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>TAKEMEHOMEBABE</b> and <b>CHANTILLY LASS</b> came together when the start was made.</p> <p><b>PRETTY PLEASE</b> began awkwardly and shifted in shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>TALK TO ME</b> was pushed wide on the turn</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>SILENTO, J Riddell</b> was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited by the tempo of the race.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of <b>TALK TO ME</b> which finished well back, <b>D Walker</b> said the mare was never travelling comfortably. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>TALK TO ME</b> revealed a slightly slow recovery rate.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PRENTERS READY MIX CONCRETE SPRINT</b>
<p><b>JERRICO</b> raced a little keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>ROHAISE</b> was briefly disappointed for racing room in the middle stages of the run home.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>TUI "BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889" DASH</b>
<p><b>PEWTER</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>VEININSKY</b> jumped inwards at the start and made contact with the barrier and then came together with <b>SAMSI</b> which had also begun awkwardly.</p> <p><b>LORRAINE</b> shifted in abruptly shortly after the start unbalancing <b>D Bradley</b>.</p> <p><b>PATIENCEA</b> over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>VEININSKY</b> raced keenly and got its head up when being steadied before being allowed to stride forward from the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>PATIENCE</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>SAMSI</b> was carried a little wider on the home turn by <b>PATIENCE</b> which ran a little wide.</p> <p><b>WORKINGCLASS</b> had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early stages of the home straight.</p> <p><b>LORRAINE</b> was reluctant to take a gap when presented in the home straight due to it racing greenly so was taken wider in order to obtain clear running. <b>LORRAINE</b> was then held up for some distance prior to the 100 metres. When questioned <b>D Bradley</b> said the mare raced greenly throughout and he would be recommending to connections that the blinkers be removed prior to the mare's next start.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL WOODVILLE-PAHIATUA CUP</b>
<p><b>HOLY SMOKE</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>IAMISHWARA</b> race three and four-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>L'AMOUR</b> was briefly held up shortly after entering the home straight.</p> <p><b>FAIRWAY WISH</b> raced in restricted room near the finishing line.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>FRITZY BOY, H Tinsley</b> said the tempo of the race was not run to suit the gelding under 59.5kgs. Trainer A MacGregor advised that he would now consider spelling the gelding.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>GOLDEN BAY CEMENT METRIC MILE</b>
<p><b>PLATINUM CHOICE</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>CRAFTY LAD</b> was unable to gain clear racing room throughout the home straight.</p> <p><b>PLATINUM CHOICE</b> was held up in the early and middle stages of the race.</p> <p><b>WORD'S OUT</b> and <b>THATZ IT</b> bumped near the 250 metres when both runners shifted ground in search of clear running.</p> <p><b>LEGLESS</b> shifted in near the 200 metres with <b>LA CLAIRETTE</b> having to steady briefly.</p> <p><b>REVOLVE</b> was inclined to shift out under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary inspection of <b>TWILIGHT DOLL</b> which finished several lengths last failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer G Haigh undertook to monitor the horse over the coming days and report any changes to the Stewards. G Haigh advised that he would now consider spelling <b>TWILIGHT DOLL</b>.</p>
