RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1CROWLEY FORGE MASTER FARRIERS STAYERSJABEZ was slow away and then raced wide throughout.RED SUNSET raced greenly in the run down the straight on the first occasion and attempted to jump the running rail nearthe 1600 metre crossing, dislodging R Myers who was attended to by medical staff and cleared to fulfil her remainingengagements. Trainer M Oulaghan was advised that RED SUNSET which sustained moderate to severe grazing, must trialbefore next racing. All other runners in the field apart from GREY GURU and LUCKY SPUR had to take evasive action beingtaken wide to avoid the fallen R Myers. HIGGS BOSON was struck by a section of the running rail dislodged in this incidentand required veterinary attention for a tendon injury.CECIL had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early and middle stages of the run home.GREY GURU had to steady near the 100 metres when hampered by HOT LIPS (S Doyle) which shifted out to continue toimprove. S Doyle was issued with a warning.

Race 2 LINCOLN LODGE JUVENILE

D Bradley (LYRIC'S WAY) received a minor injury to the eye area in the birdcage prior to the race when struck by his mount.

MAGGIE'S SECRET raced keenly down the back straight.

TORNADO ALLEY hung out rounding the turn and made the 400 metre bend awkwardly.

Race 3 MCI AND ASSOCIATES / WOODVILLE WAIRARAPA HORSEFLOATS DASH

M Dravitzki (JUMP FOR JOY) was injured in the birdcage when struck in the face by her mount and was replaced by **S Doyle. M Dravitzki** was cleared to fulfil the remainder of her engagements.

JUMP FOR JOY bounded when the start was made and began awkwardly.

TAKEMEHOMEBABE and CHANTILLY LASS came together when the start was made.

PRETTY PLEASE began awkwardly and shifted in shortly after the start.

TALK TO ME was pushed wide on the turn

When questioned regarding the performance of **SILENTO**, **J Riddell** was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited by the tempo of the race.

When questioned into the performance of **TALK TO ME** which finished well back, **D Walker** said the mare was never travelling comfortably. A post-race veterinary examination of **TALK TO ME** revealed a slightly slow recovery rate.

Race 4 PRENTERS READY MIX CONCRETE SPRINT

JERRICO raced a little keenly in the early and middle stages.

ROHAISE was briefly disappointed for racing room in the middle stages of the run home.

Race 5 TUI "BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889" DASH

PEWTER was slow to begin.

VEININSKY jumped inwards at the start and made contact with the barrier and then came together with **SAMSI** which had also begun awkwardly.

LORRAINE shifted in abruptly shortly after the start unbalancing D Bradley.

PATIENCEA over-raced in the early and middle stages.

VEININSKY raced keenly and got its head up when being steadied before being allowed to stride forward from the 900 metres.

PATIENCE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SAMSI was carried a little wider on the home turn by **PATIENCE** which ran a little wide.

WORKINGCLASS had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early stages of the home straight.

LORRAINE was reluctant to take a gap when presented in the home straight due to it racing greenly so was taken wider in order to obtain clear running. **LORRAINE** was then held up for some distance prior to the 100 metres. When questioned **D Bradley** said the mare raced greenly throughout and he would be recommending to connections that the blinkers be removed prior to the mare's next start.

Race 6 BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL WOODVILLE-PAHIATUA CUP

HOLY SMOKE was slow away.

IAMISHWARA race three and four-wide without cover throughout.

L'AMOUR was briefly held up shortly after entering the home straight.

FAIRWAY WISH raced in restricted room near the finishing line.

When questioned into the run of **FRITZY BOY, H Tinsley** said the tempo of the race was not run to suit the gelding under 59.5kgs. Trainer A MacGregor advised that he would now consider spelling the gelding.

Race 7 GOLDEN BAY CEMENT METRIC MILE

PLATINUM CHOICE was slow away.

CRAFTY LAD was unable to gain clear racing room throughout the home straight.

PLATINUM CHOICE was held up in the early and middle stages of the race.

WORD'S OUT and **THATZ IT** bumped near the 250 metres when both runners shifted ground in search of clear running. **LEGLESS** shifted in near the 200 metres with **LA CLAIRETTE** having to steady briefly.

REVOLVE was inclined to shift out under pressure in the home straight.

A post-race veterinary inspection of **TWILIGHT DOLL** which finished several lengths last failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer G Haigh undertook to monitor the horse over the coming days and report any changes to the Stewards. G Haigh advised that he would now consider spelling **TWILIGHT DOLL**.
