RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NEW WORLD OTAKI MAIDEN
<p>The start of this race was delayed due to several runners proving difficult to load away. VITAARI GIRL and INSCRUTABLE were slow away. KEEN TEMPO commenced to over-race shortly after leaving the barriers and continued to do so through the early and middle stages. DAL CAMINO raced three-wide without cover. EFRON was held up passing the 600 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 250 metres.</p>	
Race 2	NEW WORLD STOKES VALLEY 2YO MAIDEN
<p>ENCHANTREZZ shifted out on jumping away hampering DIGNIFY. SIAN hung outwards throughout. K Smith the rider of MAGGIE'S SECRET admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (i) (d) in that approaching the crossing near the 700 metres he angled his mount in when not clear of ENCHANTREZZ which clipped a heel and blundered. After hearing all evidence K Smith had his licence to ride in races suspended by the JCA from the close of racing on Saturday</p>	

25 January 2014 until the close of racing on Thursday 6th February 2014. (3 CD riding days)
When questioned into the performance of **RON'S LAST** which finished tailed off, **H Tinsley** said the gelding raced greenly throughout and was unsuited by the track condition today. He further felt the gelding would benefit from the experience of today's run.

Race 3	NEW WORLD RAILWAY METRO HANDICAP

VICE MARSHALL and **PRETTY PLEASE** bumped at the start.
GOLDEN JUBILEE raced keenly early.
SOUND BARRIER was held up and unable to improve in the home straight until passing the 200 metres.
WORKINGCLASS was held up in the home straight prior to gaining a clear run near the 150 metres.
L Innes reported that **OVER AND ABOVE** made abnormal breathing noises during the running.
PRETTY PLEASE broke down passing the post and underwent veterinary attention for a pelvic injury.
Immediately following the event Stewards became aware that **WORKINGCLASS** and **SOUND BARRIER** which had drawn barriers 1 and 2 respectively had incorrectly started the event from barrier stalls 2 and 1. A Request for a Ruling was lodged with the JCA who after considering all relevant submissions determined that both **WORKINGCLASS** and **SOUND BARRIER** be declared starters with authorisation of dividends to be accordingly given. Starter Mr G Phillips admitted a breach of Rule 631 (2) and was fined the sum of \$300.

Race 4	NEW WORLD WELLINGTON CITY WELLINGTON CUP PRELUDE

THE PAINTER got back at the start.
HELL YEAH raced keenly in the early stages.
HELL YEAH was held up for some distance in the home straight until passing the 200 metres
The rider of **JULIANN, R Myers** dropped her whip passing the 200 metres.
When questioned into the run of **JULIANN, R Myers** said the mare was disappointing and had appeared to be in a normal post-race condition on pulling up. Stable representative John Donovan advised that the mare would undergo a veterinary examination over the coming days and any abnormalities will be reported to the Stewards.

Race 5	NEW WORLD HUTT CITY MAIDEN

BLATHYWAYT and **HIGH TEC** were slow away.
KENOSKI lay out shortly after leaving the barriers hampering **LADY JESSICA** and **CENTRE ATTENTION**.
FANTAMO over-raced in the early and middle stages.
Going into the bend near the 1000 metres **CRACKLIN ROSIE** had to steady off the heels of **PERFECT MIX** which was crowded for room by **CORBYN** which lay in and away from **PREMEAUX**.
Near the 800 metres **CENTRE ATTENTION** had to be steadied off the heels of **STONEMASON** and shifted out hampering **CORBYN**.
HIGH TEC shifted out under pressure over the final stages of the race.
D Bradley reported that **STONEMASON** raced greenly and hung out rounding the turn.
D Johnson reported that **CRACKLIN ROSIE** had been unable to quicken on the good track.

Race 6	NEW WORLD THORNDON HANDICAP

The start of this race was delayed 2 minutes at the request of the TAB.
SWORNTOPERFECTION made contact with **MISTER SPIDERMAN** when shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.
When questioned regarding the performance of **GRENADE, M Du Plessis** was of the opinion that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 7	NEW WORLD CHURTON PARK MAIDEN

CAV IN THE CASTLE dislodged rider **J Riddell** during the preliminary and after being recaptured underwent a veterinary examination at the start prior to being cleared to start.
PICCADILLY began awkwardly and lost ground.
KALINGA, CAV IN THE CASTLE, PHONE GIRL and **SUPEREFFICIENT** were all slow away.
CAV IN THE CASTLE raced three-wide without cover throughout.
Near the 1200 metres when being steadied, **PERONI** went back onto **KALINGA** which had to steady. Hampered as a result was **SUPEREFFICIENT**.
KALINGA was held up early in the final straight.
CAV IN THE CASTLE returned to the enclosure with blood in the left nostril. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a laceration as a result of the mare hitting the front of the barrier gate.

Race 8	NEW WORLD WILLIS STREET METRO HANDICAP

PEWTER was slow away.

PEWTER commenced to over-race approaching the 1300 metres and continued to do so throughout the middle stages shifting out across heels passing the 1100 metres forcing **EDENSONG** over extra ground. **PEWTER** then raced wide without cover rounding the bend.

BAM A LAM raced ungenerously when being restrained off heels near the 900 metres.

BAM A LAM was held up rounding the bend near the 500m and had some difficulty finding clear room in the straight.

PEWTER which ran last returned to the enclosure with blood in a nostril. A veterinary inspection of the gelding revealed a laceration.
