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## SUPPLEMENTARY:

<b>Avondale Jockey Club – Monday 13 January 2014</b> <b>Race 3 – Avondale Supporters Club 1600</b> Apprentice <b>A Taylor</b> in conjunction with her employer, Mr G Rogerson, admitted a charge of failing to ride her mount <b>JIGGER INN</b> out to the finish of the race at an adjourned inquiry which was held today. After viewing video footage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Miss Taylor's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, Wednesday 22 January until the conclusion of racing on Monday 3 February 2014, 9 riding days.
<b>Matamata Racing Club – Friday 17 January 2014</b> <b>Race 1 – The Price Racing 2000</b> Trainer R James reported that <b>MORETTI</b> would now be spelled following its disappointing performance and subsequent veterinary examination which found <b>MORETTI</b> to have a respiratory infection.
<b>Counties Racing Club – Saturday 18 January 2014</b> <b>Race 9 – Tuakau Cossie Club Racing Section 1600</b> Trainer R James advised that <b>FULL COUNT</b> had undergone further evaluation and treatment after <b>FULL COUNT</b> was found to have a respiratory infection following the race.

## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>VERO INSURANCE 2100</b>
<b>GEE WHIZ</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>VONCINI</b> (L Innes) began awkwardly. <b>I'VE GOT THIS</b> (M Hills) lost its footing and blundered leaving the barriers. <b>TOETWOTOE</b> (R Hutchings) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. <b>MAYGROVE</b> (O Bosson) and <b>VIOLETTA STAR</b> (A Collett) raced wide in the early stages.	

<p><b>CUPCAKE</b> (T Thornton) was held up behind the tiring <b>HEARTS'N'SPADES</b> (M McNab) for a distance passing the 600 metres. <b>GEE WHIZ</b> which was giving ground was checked when reacting badly after being placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>VIOLETTA STAR</b> which lay in away from <b>MAYGROVE</b> which shifted in when improving forward to the outside of <b>VIOLETTA STAR</b> near the 500 metres. O Bosson was issued with a warning.</p> <p>M McNab (<b>HEARTS'N'SPADES</b>) dropped his whip near the 350 metres when well beaten.</p> <p><b>CUPCAKE</b> hung inwards in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>VIOLETTA STAR</b> passing the 300 metres having to be corrected by its rider.</p> <p><b>TOETWOTOE</b> was held up early in the final straight having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>LORD CASANOVA</b> (H Tinsley) had a tendency to lay inwards in the final straight having to be straightened by its rider on several occasions.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the poor performance of <b>I'VE GOT THIS</b> rider M Hills advised that the intention had been to ride the gelding forward but after a poor beginning had settled at the rear and failed to recover being unable to quicken when placed under pressure near the 600 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>RACE WITH TE AKAU – OWNERS COME FIRST 2100</b>
<p><b>TILDA</b> (S Collett) commenced to over-race near the winning post on the first occasion, and when being restrained shifted out across the heels of <b>DIDGERIDOO</b> (B Grylls) forcing <b>GAME CHANGER</b> (C Dell) over extra ground passing the 1800 metres. <b>TILDA</b> then improved forward three wide around the first bend to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.</p> <p><b>IT'S GOT TO BE YOU</b> (C Grylls) had to be steadied near the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>DIDGERIDOO</b> which lay in. B Grylls was advised to exercise care. <b>KENDOKA</b> (M Cameron) was then held up behind <b>IT'S GOT TO BE YOU</b> rounding the bend until near the 450 metres.</p> <p><b>SACRED KNIGHT</b> (R Hutchings) hung outwards rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>DELVEEN</b> (M Dee) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing <b>MISS HERB</b> (M Sweeney) near the 300 metres.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary inspection of <b>IT'S GOT TO BE YOU</b> did not reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>GREENE BROTHERS – ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT SALES &amp; SERVICES 1400</b>
<p><b>CARNELIAN LIGHTS</b> (R Norvall) was crowded leaving the barriers between <b>ICAN'TSTOPTHERAIN</b> (C Grylls) and <b>VALOREPHIN</b> (M Cheung) which both began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>PACO KID</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>ABERDEEN</b> (A Jones) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>ICAN'TSTOPTHERAIN</b> commenced to over-race for a distance when making the bend passing the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>VALOREPHIN</b> raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>ASTRA</b> (K Myers) was held up when disappointed for a run passing the 350 metres when <b>HINUERA</b> (T Thornton) shifted out under pressure simultaneously as <b>VALOREPHIN</b> lay in. <b>VALOREPHIN</b> then shifted out after being bumped in this incident hampering <b>ICAN'TSTOPTHERAIN</b>.</p> <p><b>BHIWANI</b> (M Cameron) was held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight, and when shifting outwards across the heels of <b>HARRY CLAASSEN</b> (S Collett) to obtain clear running near the 300 metres made slight contact with <b>HINUERA</b>.</p> <p><b>PANELLA</b> (M Coleman) was badly held up near the 300 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>TECHNICAL WELDING SERVICES/RIVER ROAD BLAST AND PAINT 1200</b>
<p><b>KALINDA</b> (L Magorrian) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BROADWAY EXPRESS</b> (M Du Plessis) shifted out leaving the barriers inconveniencing <b>LADY HUNTINGDON</b> (M Dee).</p> <p><b>PRINCE BRUNO</b> (R Hutchings) shifted out leaving the barriers making contact with <b>ERNIE</b> (J Adams) which then became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>DEVITO</b> (R Smyth).</p> <p><b>EXCITAR</b> (D Johnson) began awkwardly and then raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early and middle stages. Approaching the 900 metres <b>BLACKWOOD</b> (D Hain) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>SHOW MACCOOL</b> (C Grylls) which was racing ungenerously when being steadied. <b>BLACKWOOD</b> then had to be restrained.</p> <p><b>SHAARA</b> (K Myers) made the bend approaching the 800 metres awkwardly further inconveniencing <b>BLACKWOOD</b>. <b>SHAARA</b> then raced ungenerously for a distance. K Myers advised that <b>SHAARA</b> had proved difficult to ride throughout the race.</p> <p><b>DEVITO</b> raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>MONOVALE FARM YEARLINGS @ KARAKA 1200</b>
<p><b>DREAMS MAKER</b> (M Sweeney) began awkwardly and then was further inconvenienced by <b>DREAMCOAT</b> (C Grylls) which shifted out.</p> <p><b>MANNY</b> (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>CASSIE MAY</b> (T Thornton) raced a little ungenerously approaching the 800 metres when shifting in and becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>DREAMCOAT</b>.</p> <p><b>CASSIE MAY</b> shifted out passing the 450 metres making contact with <b>EWENIGHT</b> (O Bosson) briefly losing its footing.</p> <p><b>EVEREADY</b> (S Collett) raced in restricted room to the inside of <b>CALYPSO</b> (D Johnson) passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>When questioned T Thornton was unable to offer any excuses for the disappointing performance of <b>CASSIE MAY</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>GREENE BROTHERS – LEISURE SALES &amp; SERVICE 1600</b>

**MANIKYA** (B Grylls) began awkwardly and then shifted out crowding **ELROI** (K Myers) and **QUEENOFTHEAMAZON** (C Grylls) which made contact with the hind quarters of **SAVAMONT** (R Hutchings).

**SAVAMONT** raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

**STRIKE BACK** (M McNab) over-raced in the early to middle stages.

**SAVAMONT** raced wide without cover throughout.

**MYSTIC MAN** (O Bosson) had to be steadied when improving up on to the heels of **MOUNTAIN JACK** (M Hills) near the 450 metres. **MYSTIC MAN** then had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

Rounding the final turn approaching the 400 metres **SAVAMONT** clipped a heel of **MORENA** (B R Jones) and blundered. Shortly after this incident **ELROI** made contact with **MORENA** when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.

**MOUNTAIN JACK** was held up rounding the final turn and did not obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.

**SPEEDING** (M Cameron) made contact with **QUEENOFTHEAMAZON** when shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres. **QUEENOFTHEAMAZON** then shifted away from **SPEEDING** inconveniencing **JIMMY HOFFA** (H Tinsley).

**ALL THE WAY** (M Dee) hung outwards in the final straight and was unable to be ridden out over the final stages as a result.

Race 7	<b>GR CLEANING SERVICES 1600</b>
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**SIR JACK RUGER** (R Hutchings) began awkwardly losing ground.

**MALINA** (B R Jones) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers crowding **KINGS DAUGHTER** (R Smyth) on to **SAFANAD** (M Cameron) which were both hampered.

**BAHRELLA** (C Grylls) began awkwardly losing ground.

**BUSTA** (A Collett) shifted out leaving the barriers inconveniencing **ITSFORFREE** (T Thornton).

**CULTO LA VIDA** (K Myers) lost its footing and blundered leaving the barriers losing ground.

**ZABERTO** (O Bosson) commenced to over-race and hang inwards passing the 1300 metres when the pace steadied with **ROCK DIVA** (L Innes) becoming awkwardly placed inside that runner's heels and shifting in crowding **SAKHEE'S STAR** (M Coleman) which was checked losing ground. Also hampered was **ITSFORFREE** (T Thornton) which had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of **SAKHEE'S STAR** and shifted out clipping a heel of **KINGS DAUGHTER** and forcing **CULTO LA VIDA** wider on the track.

**ZABERTO** continued to over-race and hang inwards through the middle stages.

Near the 1000 metres **YES** (P Turner) shifted out to avoid the heels of **BUSTA** when the pace eased into the line of **MALINA** which had to be steadied hampering **DRIVING MASTER** (M Dee) which shifted in when being restrained crowding **ZABERTO** which made contact with the running rail. A Collett was advised not to ease the pace to a degree which puts other riders in difficulty.

**SQUARE CIRCLES** (D Johnson) raced three wide without cover.

**KINGS DAUGHTER** required veterinary attention following the race to a laceration to the left hind leg as a result of being galloped on during the running.

Race 8	<b>NORTHERN JOCKEY MANAGERS 1600</b>
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**DARK AND STORMY** (M Coleman) shifted out shortly after leaving the barriers crowding **CONCHITA** (R Hutchings).

**DARK AND STORMY** raced keenly when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

**TABLE ONE** (R Smyth) over-raced in the early and middle stages and when having to be firmly restrained off the heels of **DARK AND STORMY** shifted out passing the 900 metres hampering **CONCHITA**.

**IN TUNE** (C Grylls) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**TIARA** (M Cameron) shifted out passing the 300 metres inconveniencing the weakening **THRILLA IN MANILA** (K Myers).
