RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WHITE ROBE LODGE & AB LIME MAIDEN (1200M)

WRITTENINTHESTARS was declared a late scratching at 1.44pm by order of the Stewards after having bolted for a lap and a half of the track with rider T Direen unable to control the mare.

ELEGANT CROSSING began awkwardly.

SHIRLEY BROOK raced wide through the early stages.

Passing the 250 metres **PEAK HOUR** made contact with **OUR CASTLE** when attempting to shift that runner wider on the track. **PEAK HOUR** was then held up and had to be steadied for some distance before having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear racing room passing the 150 metres.

R Doherty the rider of **PETER PARKER** reported the saddle had moved in the early stages of the event placing him in some

difficulty.

Race 2 GORE NEW WORLD & HOKONUI RURAL TRANSPORT MAIDEN (1335M)

NEED A WILSON'S began awkwardly and lost ground with rider R Doherty losing his off side iron for a short distance.

AREUFORREEL was obliged to shift ground inwards passing the 1200 metres when taken in by **HEAVE HO** resulting in **NEED A WILSON'S** being momentarily inconvenienced.

JOE BONANNO was obliged to race wide through the early stages.

AREUFORREEL raced in restricted room in the final 75 metres.

Passing the 75 metres **THE ROOK** shifted in and away from **JOE BONANNO** momentarily inconveniencing the tiring **ELLIES CHOICE**.

THE ROOK was reluctant to take a marginal gap to the inside of **JOE BONANNO** over the concluding stages.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favourite **AREUFORREEL** apprentice rider R Black advised after initially getting further back than anticipated the mare was finding the line well however raced in restricted room over the final 75 metres.

Race 3 SWITZERS VALLEY TRANSPORT MAIDEN (1335M)

THEGREATPICKPOCKET was declared a late scratching at 1.58pm on veterinary advice when displaying soreness after suffering a bee sting in the girth region.

The start of this event was delayed 3 minutes and 30 seconds due to **GALLANT DAN** refusing to load into the barrier. **GALLANT DAN** was declared a late scratching at 2.58pm with the connections advised the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.

BLINDED BY DELITE raced wide through the early stages.

CROYDON raced keenly through the early to middle stages.

SWEET BUT NEAT was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.

Rider D Skerrett (**REGAL RANGER**) defended a charge pursuant to Rule 638(2) alleging that he performed a celebratory gesture prior to the Winning Post. After viewing replays and hearing evidence from the Stewards and Mr Skerrett the JCA found the charge proved and imposed a fine of \$100.

Race 4 NORTH GORE DAIRY – ON THE SPOT HANDICAP (1335M)

CITYCENTA began awkwardly.

ISHIGOLD also began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with **PATRICE**.

SHE'Z A VIRTUOSO was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

ISHIGOLD had to steady and change ground passing the 200 metres.

Race 5 JOHN BRICK MEMORIAL MAIDEN (2000M)

ROTAR began awkwardly.

QUEST FOR LUCK was slow over the early stages.

Shortly after the start **PRODIGE** had to steady when **TUILLIBARDINE** shifted in momentarily.

TULLIBARDINE, LOOSE GOOSE and THE BUBBLY ONE all raced keenly through the early stages due to the lack of pace.

PRODIGE raced wide throughout before giving ground from the 600 metres.

Passing the 1100 metres ZAC'S GIRL began to race keenly and shifted out taking ROTAR wider on the track.

Passing the 700 metres BIG MEADSY had to steady and shift ground when held up by the tiring PRODIGE.

THE BUBBLY ONE was held up for clear racing room over the final 100 metres when a marginal run between **ASSASSIN** and **TULLIBARDINE** closed when both these runners shifted ground marginally.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BIG MEADSY** apprentice rider D Prastiyou advised the gelding had never travelled well throughout and had disappointed. Mr Prastiyou further added in his opinion **BIG MEADSY** would be better suited to tracks with more moisture in them.

Race 6 AON INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP (2000M)

WHISKY REIGN began awkwardly making contact with the gate and got back as a result.

NOLAWOOD also began awkwardly and lost some ground.

LORD YARBOROUGH made the crossing awkwardly at the 1600 metres when being steadied to take a position.

APARIMA DAN raced wide through the middle stages before being taken forward to sit outside the leader at the 1100 metres.

SHE'Z A PRIMA DONNA raced wide throughout.

Passing the 700 metres **LILIQUE** when awkwardly placed on the heels of **WHISKY REIGN** attempted to shift ground and made firm contact with **SHE'Z A PRIMA DONNA** resulting in **LILIQUE** becoming unbalanced for several strides.

HOWLONGDOWEWAIT was held up throughout run home only gaining clear racing room over the final 50 metres.

When spoken to regarding the performance of **APARIMA DAN** apprentice rider J Wong was of the opinion the gelding had failed to handle today's Good 3 track conditions.

Race 7 PETERS GENETICS & GRANT FARMING PARTNERSHIP HANDICAP (1335M)

DOUBLE TAP raced keenly over the early stages.

HALO FLIGHT raced wide over the early stages.

WAITINO BISCUIT was obliged to race wide throughout.

GOOGLE ME was held up for clear racing room rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.

Passing the 100 metres WAITINO BISCUIT and FLYING STORM made contact.

Passing the 50 metres **DOUBLE TAP** shifted out under pressure placing **TUG O' WAR** in restricted room.
