RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TOUR DE TARANAKI MAIDEN (2000M)
<p>BAYRUM began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with THE BIG OPAL. I CANDY was slow to begin.</p> <p>SCOTCH HOPPA began awkwardly and was very slow into stride, losing considerable ground. Connections of SCOTCH HOPPA were advised that a warning is placed against the mare with regard to its racing manners.</p> <p>BAYRUM over raced early, so was taken out to avoid heels near the post on the first round and in doing so hampered THE BIG OPAL.</p> <p>IRISH SPRING had to be steadied rounding the first bend when awkwardly placed inside the heels of LYKAROC. CRIMSON PRINCE was held up for some distance prior to the 200 metres. LYKAROC raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	

<p>When questioned into the run of BAYRUM rider M Hudson stated the gelding pulled hard, continued to over race and failed to settle throughout.</p> <p>Apprentice Jockey A Taylor (LYKAROC) noticeably stopped riding her mount out fully in the home straight and eased LYKAROC down over the final five strides holding third placing by half a head. A Taylor was reprimanded and given a warning, in that she must ride her mounts out fully to the finish when circumstances permit.</p>	
Race 2	THE KIWI BUTCHER SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST 2YO (1200M)
<p>BUFFALO BOY stood flat footed in the barrier and was slow to begin.</p> <p>SAKURA raced keenly when wide throughout.</p> <p>WHEELER FORTUNE hung outwards in the straight.</p>	
RACE 3	THE MILL SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST (1200M)
<p>HE'S GOLD began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT over raced in the early stages and passing the 1000 metres had to shift ground outwards to avoid the heels of COMMAND.</p> <p>A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT was briefly held up passing the 200 metres prior to being angled inwards in order to improve.</p> <p>A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT shifted in over the final stages and momentarily hampered IMAPUSS near the finish.</p>	
Race 4	NICCI GOODIN DESIGNER FLORIST (1200M)
<p>SINGAPORE GIRL was tightened shortly after the start and got back when there was movement from runners either side.</p> <p>ITSALRIGHT hung out rounding the bend near the 800 metres taking TOKAYZ MAGIC and NORMAN wider on the track.</p> <p>NORMAN raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>R Smyth (GOLDIE) was advised to exercise care after she allowed her mount to shift inwards shortly after entering the home straight hampering SINGAPORE GIRL which became unbalanced for several strides.</p> <p>OUTOFTIME was dictated outwards approaching the 200 metres when ULTRA EXPLOSIVE was angled out in search of clear running.</p>	
Race 5	HOOKER PACIFIC SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST (1800M)
<p>PARK PRINCESS was slow to begin and settled back.</p> <p>NORTH OF SUNSET over raced rounding the first bend.</p> <p>TRICKJAH raced wide rounding the first bend.</p> <p>M Hudson the rider of MISS ANA admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards near the 1500 metres when not clear of NORTH OF SUNSET which was checked and made contact with the running rail. After deliberations M Hudson had her apprentice jockeys licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 18.01.14 up to the close of racing on 02.02.14 (4 days).</p>	
Race 6	WEST END BOWLING CLUB MAIDEN (1600M)
<p>LOVE ME MOORE shifted in simultaneously as OUR GIRL KATE shifted out resulting in crowding to TRANSLUCENCE, OUR ZULU GIRL, and WILLHE which lost ground at the start.</p> <p>NEK MINIT jumped inwards at the start and bumped with MION JAY.</p> <p>KIRKININI which raced keenly in the early stages made the first bend awkwardly.</p> <p>LOVE ME MOORE raced keenly along the back straight and near the 900 metres when being steadied off the heels of MION JAY shifted in abruptly and hampered OUR ZULU GIRL which made contact with the running rail. Also hampered was TRANSLUCENCE which was forced to race three wide without cover.</p> <p>Passing the 600 metres OUR ZULU GIRL</p> <p>DURHAM ROSE and NEK MINNIT were held up early in the final straight and were denied a narrow run passing the 200 metres to the inside of LAST CITE which shifted in under pressure.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of I'M FAIR DINKUM jockey A Forbes stated the gelding travelled well to the home straight but when placed under pressure failed to quicken.</p>	
Race 7	STAPLES RODWAY SUPPORTING LIFE EDUCATION TRUST (1600M)
<p>PALMERS PRIDE was tightened and got back at the start.</p> <p>I CHIANTI raced wide early.</p> <p>FERGALICIOUS was held up early in the home straight prior to gaining clear running over the final 100 metres.</p> <p>PALMER'S PRIDE was held up for a short distance early in the home straight, prior to be angled inwards in order to improve.</p>	
Race 8	OIL & GAS RACEDAY TWILIGHT SUNDAY FEBRUARY 2ND MAIDEN (1400M)

SILKYSAND was bumped at the start and got back.

LEATHER N' LACE raced three wide without cover throughout.

CLYDE made the first bend awkwardly, and raced wide into the home straight where it hung inwards under pressure.

K Leung the rider of **ZETOW** admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards near the 50 metres when not clear of **SILKYSAND** which was checked between **ZETOW** and **TWOZNOTENOUGH** (A Taylor) which shifted in marginally. After deliberations K Leung had his apprentice jockeys licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 18.01.14 up to the close of racing on 26.01.14 (5 days).
