RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS PREMIER			
SWEET SUITOR shifted out at the start into the line of THE GOVERNATOR which settled back.				
BELLAPIN, MCLAREN and ATOZED all raced keenly in the early stages.				
THE GOVERNATOR had to be steadied when racing in restricted room near the 600 metres.				
THE GOVERNATOR had to shift out passing the 200 metres in order to continue to improve.				
MCLAREN was held up for some distance prior to the 150 metres.				
When questioned on the performance of ATOZED, rider M du Plessis was of the opinion the mare may have found the				
track too firm for her liking coupled with the fact that she had not started for some time.				
Race 2	NME GROUP PREMIER			
DUBAI SHUFFLE shifted out abruptly on jumping dictating STRAIGHT AHEAD out onto GIRL WITH A PEARL which was				
bumped and got back as a result.				
LA PETITE bumped heavily with RINGO STARR at the start and got back. In consequence RINGO STARR was unbalanced for				
a short distance.				
CORPORAL LINCOLN was obliged to race three-wide without cover in the early stages so was allowed to stride forward				

near the 1600 metres.

LEGAL ADVICE over-raced in the middle stages.

LADY PLATINUM was held up momentarily passing the 250 metres.

ROMPERS was obliged to race wide throughout.

EARL OF DONCASTER was held up throughout the final straight.

When questioned on the performance of **GIRL WITH A PEARL**, rider J Parkes reported that after settling further back than he had intended the mare had failed to run on as expected. He further added that **GIRL WITH A PEARL** may have been unsuited to the firmness of today's track.

Race 3 MITSUBISHI ELECTRIC 3YO PREMIER

IRISH STRINGS began awkwardly.

RIVER HEAD shifted out abruptly on jumping tightening **COLONEL LINCOLN, DESIGNATED DRIVER** and **SILVER ECLIPSE**. **HE'S GOLD** over-raced over the early stages.

COSMIC CUBE commenced to race greenly shortly after leaving the barriers and approaching the 1000 metres ducked out abruptly dictating **SILVER ECLIPSE** out onto the hindquarters of **CAUTHEN** which resulted in **CAUTHEN** becoming unbalanced for several strides. **COSMIC CUBE** continued to race greenly for the remainder of the event.

MIGHTY SOLOMON was held up near the 250 metres and passing the 200 metres, when taken out across the heels of **RIVER HEAD** to improve, was dictated wider when **RIVER HEAD** which when laying out, shifted out.

Race 4 GAZLEY PREMIER

CHOP CHOP which was fractious prior to the start, was subsequently slow to begin.

BRACKENWOOD was slow to begin.

MASTER THOMAS began awkwardly.

CHOP CHOP raced keenly for a short distance passing the 800 metres.

BRACKENWOOD was dictated wider passing the 700 metres when on the heels of **TEXAS YELLOW ROSE** which, when attempting to improve, to the outside **NOVA SCOTIA** was in turn taken wider when **NOVA SCOTIA** shifted out. **MION JAY** hung out approaching the final turn.

LUMIERE BLUE and COOL SPUR were crowded near the 250 metres when between MYMINKCOAT which lay in and BELLACAT which lay out.

LORRAINE was obliged to race three-wide throughout.

ANTONIO had to steady approaching the 200 metres and then raced in restricted room over the final stages.

Stewards lodged a Request for a Ruling under Rule 632 into the start made by **RAMPANTEXCUSE** which was being held by a barrier attendant as the start was affected. After hearing all evidence and submissions the Judicial Committee determined that **RAMPANTEXCUSE** had been disadvantaged and subsequently declared the gelding a non-starter.

Race 5 TIGER PRAWN DESERT GOLD STAKES (GROUP III)

BRAH SPRING dislodged rider L Innes during the preliminary, however was quickly recaptured and declared fit to start following a veterinary inspection at the barrier.

WHISTLING DIXIE became fractious in the barrier stall and underwent a veterinary examination before being cleared fit to start.

DIAMANTINE began awkwardly and lost ground.

TRIPLE BILLING began awkwardly.

FERGALICIOUS lay out shortly after the start and tightened **HOT ROD, SLICE OF CLASS** and **CYCLONE TRACY** which was checked as a result. **HOT ROD** lost ground in this incident.

MOOZOON shifted out and bumped with **MISS SELBY** shortly after the start.

MOOZOON over-raced in the middle stages.

MISS SELBY had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the turn and in the early part of the home straight.

BRAH SPRING hung out throughout the final straight and over the final stages could not be fully tested.

MOOZOON lay out near the post.

COSTA VIVA hung inwards over the final 300 metres and had to be straightened on several occasions. Rider **M Cameron** reported that the filly had been a little disappointing and its inclination to hang inwards which was uncharacteristic. Trainer **J Bridgeman** said that **COSTA VIVA** had appeared to pull up in normal post-race condition but undertook to advise

of any abnormality which may become apparent.

Race 6 VIRGINIA TURNER SUMMER CUP

PIRINITETE began awkwardly and was slow away.

THE PAINTER reared as the start was made and was slow away.

JULIANN over-raced in the early stages.

JULIANN was held up rounding the turn and in the early part of the home straight.

CONFUSED had some difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres.

When questioned on the performance of first day winner **SOUTHERN SAV**, rider **N Harris** reported that the gelding had travelled only fairly during the running and when the tempo increased passing the 800 metres was unable to quicken at that point, however when in the final straight **SOUTHERN SAV** had run on fairly.

When questioned into the form reversal of the winner JULINSKY PRINCE which ran last at its previous start at Taupo on 3 December, 2013, trainer F Auret advised that on that occasion the gelding over-raced in the early and middle stages, and in					
his opinion had failed to see out the 1950 metre trip under its top weight of 59kgs.
