RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ANTON MORA & SON PAINTERS 1600
<p>JUST THE TIP blundered on leaving the barriers and shifted in making contact with TWOZNOTENOUGH. KARAKA JACK was slow away. COOL SPUR commenced to over race near the 1200 metres proving difficult to restrain and approaching the 1000 metres was taken forward to race adjacent to the leader. TWOZNOTENOUGH was taken wider near the 1200 metres and thereafter raced three wide without cover for the remainder. JUST THE TIP was inclined to over race in the middle stages when the pace ahead steadied. TWOZNOTENOUGH shied near the 200 metres, unbalancing the rider and losing momentum. KARAKA JACK was held up briefly passing the 250 metres. ROHAISE was held up rounding the turn and when in clear running passing the 250 metres was inclined to lay out.</p>	
Race 2	SCIENTIFIC DRILLING INTERNATIONAL SC MAIDEN SP COND
<p>HAPPY PLACE raced three wide without cover over the final 1200 metres. HAPPY PLACE shifted in abruptly near the 250 metres bumping with ZETOW which became unbalanced. ULTRA EXPLOSIVE lay in when placed under pressure passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p>	
Race 3	NEW PLYMOUTH CLUB 1400 RATING 85
<p>ROSE OF FALKIRK shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier hampering NIPPIN which lost ground. MANU faced keenly in the early stages. NINE PIN was held up briefly rounding the final bend. When questioned regarding the performance of NIPPIN which was outpaced throughout apprentice rider L Whelan had no</p>	

excuses. When questioned regarding the performance of ROSE OF FALKIRK rider S Collett was of the opinion the mare may be better suited to more give in the ground.	
Race 4	PHOENIX PARK TWO YEAR OLD CLASSIC (GROUP III)
<p>WILD WINGS bounded at the start and lost ground.</p> <p>MAGIC MOMENT was crowded and tightened at the winning post when inside DUEY which shifted in and away from ARTIC WOLF.</p> <p>MACKLEMORE had to steady near the 200 metres when attempting to improve into a narrow run to the inside of MAGIC MOMENT which lay in.</p> <p>ASPREY raced greenly over the final stages and could not be fully tested.</p> <p>Following the event J Parkes rider of 4th placed MACKLEMORE lodged a protest against 3rd placed MAGIC MOMENT alleging interference in the final straight. After consideration the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing run of LONGCHAMP rider R Myers reported that the colt was under pressure throughout and despite her urgings had failed to make any discernable ground, only making fair ground over the concluding stages. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of LONGCHAMP which revealed no obvious abnormality; however Trainer A Campbell undertook to report to the Stewards any matter which may become apparent in coming days.</p>	
Race 5	COCA COLA OAKS 3YO PRELUDE SW+P
<p>PHONE GIRL shifted out abruptly on jumping making contact with CELTIC WOMAN resulting in both runners getting back.</p> <p>MOOZOON raced greenly throughout and near the 1600 metres MOOZOON shifted out across the heels of POSTER GIRL forcing SPORTS ILLUSTRATED wider for a distance.</p> <p>PHONE GIRL was obliged to make its finishing run wide from the 600 metres.</p> <p>MOOZOON lay in near the 200 metres bumping with SPORTS ILLUSTRATED.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of RED MELODY rider D Bradley could offer no excuse, A post race veterinary examination of the filly failed to reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
Race 6	HOOKER PACIFIC TARANAKI CUP (GROUP III) OPEN HANDICAP
<p>LIKEAPINS was slow away.</p> <p>JULINSKY PRINCE raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>WORTHING raced keenly throughout when wide.</p> <p>BREAKING DAWN had to be straightened near the 250 metres.</p> <p>FAIRWAY WISH was jostled when tiring approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of WORTHING which finished well back rider M Hills reported that after over-racing in the early and middle stages the gelding had little left at the finish. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary inspection of WORTHING which failed to reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of POROTENE LOLLIPOP rider J Parkes stated that after being obliged to make his finishing run wide from the 600 metres, the mare failed to finish the race off as anticipated.</p>	
Race 7	NICHOLAS FINANCE SC MAIDEN SP COND
<p>BLATHWAYT was slow away.</p> <p>MION JAY shifted out on jumping and bumped with RED KING.</p> <p>RED KING was inclined to race greenly throughout.</p> <p>RED KING hung in throughout the final straight and could not be fully tested by the rider.</p> <p>MALACHY LAD and JOYOHJOY came together and brushed over the final stages.</p>	
Race 8	WATERFRONT HOTEL 2000
<p>BAJOUR and THE BIG OPAL were slow to begin.</p> <p>MONEYFORJAM raced wide without cover in the early stages prior to being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leaders near the 1400 metres.</p> <p>THE BIG OPAL raced three wide without cover from 1000 metres.</p> <p>LITTLE CHIEF had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when over racing.</p> <p>TEDDYTWINKLETOES was held up rounding the final bend and only obtained clear running near the 100 metres.</p> <p>BAJOUR (S Doyle) lay inwards under pressure over the early stages of the home straight and passing the 200 metres shifted in resulting in crowding to LITTLE CHIEF and RAMPANTEXCUSE. Rider S Doyle was issued with a warning and advised that when in similar circumstances he is expected to correct his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of MY MINKCOAT rider M Hills reported the mare had out from the 1000 metres.</p>
