RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1PIAKO MITSUBISHI '1230'VICTOR HUGO (D Johnson) was slow to begin.

KANALI (B Grylls) was obliged to race three wide, without cover, throughout.

R Hutchings (**THE IVY**) was reminded of his obligation when riding his horses out to the finish line if there are circumstances which permit him to do so.

Race 2 ILES CASEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS '1230'

POCKETS (S McKay) was slow to begin, and then over-raced in the early and middle stages.

POWER STAR (D Johnson) raced ungenerously in the early stages.

MAESTRO TOM (A Jones) raced wide without cover throughout.

POCKETS was inclined to lay in over the final stages when placed under pressure.

Race 3 A T COOK CONTRACTING '1950'

COOLIBAH (D Johnson) jumped away awkwardly.

LUCKY TONIGHT (M Cameron) after becoming fractious in the barriers was slow to begin.

Approaching the 200 metres **KICK BACK** (R Myers) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **WRECKING CREW** (K Leung).

WRECKING CREW raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **GLITZABEEL** rider M Coleman could offer no tangible excuses. **GLITZABEEL** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination, including an endoscopic examination which found dirt to be lodged in the upper airway.

When questioned regarding the performance of **COOLIBAH** rider D Johnson advised the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

T Busuttin the trainer of **WOWOWOW** (T Thornton) was questioned regarding its improved performance. T Busuttin explained that he had been satisfied with the fresh-up performance of **WOWOWOW**, but had been disappointing at its subsequent start which he attributed to sand kick-back from the Ruakaka surface, and he was hopeful of an improved performance today.

Race 4

CELTIC CHIEF (M Dee) jumped away awkwardly.

KEEP ROCKING (T Thornton) and **THE LINK** (J Oliver) were both slow to begin.

Race 5 FARMLANDS ROTORUA '1400'

DEESSE DE LA MODE (R Hutchings) and MISS GRACE (M Ulucinar) were both slow to begin.

MISS GRACE raced ungenerously in the early stages.

Passing the 100 metres **RICH TED** (B R Jones) raced in restricted room for a distance between **ZEDENUF** (D Johnson) and **QUANTUM MAELSTROM** (M Coleman) which were both inclined to shift ground under pressure.

TOTRA RULES (T Thornton) hung inwards and could not be ridden to advantage in the final straight.

Race 6 NZI '2200'

LUCKY CHARM (U Holmquist) jumped away awkwardly.

FIREPOWER (M Cameron) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

MAEVE DAVONE (B Grylls) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages with the saddle shifting forward.

Race 7 INL-SUPPLEMENTARY FEED. WE'VE GOT YOU COVERED '1950'

The declaration of a rider for **SWEET MOLLY** was missing until 12.15pm due to an administration error.

IDAHO'S CHOICE (M Cameron) was slow to begin and was further hampered when **LADY LINDAUER** (J Oliver) shifted out, forcing **DON DIEGO** (L Satherley) into that runner's line.

Approaching the winning post on the first occasion **DON DIEGO** and **IDAHO'S CHOICE** made contact when both runners were racing greenly. **IDAHO'S CHOICE** continued to race greenly for a short distance.

ST SATURNIN (M Coleman) raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **LORD SHIVA** (R Myers) near the 50 metres.
