RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 BALCLUTHA/LAWRENCE/MILTON NIGHT'N DAY FOODSTORES 1600m

RED DAGGER blundered at the start.

TRICIA'O began awkwardly and was slow to begin.

RED DAGGER and ASSASSIN both raced keenly for several strides passing the 1500 metres as the pace steadied.

VOUSSOIR raced wide in the early stages.

TRICIA'O made momentary contact with the rail passing the 850 metres.

TUTOR was trapped wide through the middle stages.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favourite **TRICIA'O** rider S Wynne reported the filly had raced greenly throughout but had run home fairly and would benefit from today's experience.

Race 2 PETER LYON SHEARING/SPEIGHT'S MAIDEN 1200m

CAIRNSVILLE was slow to begin.

MISS MEERKAT began awkwardly and was further hampered when YOUNG JIM shifted out abruptly shortly after the start. LANGTON KATIE raced wide without cover throughout. MIDNIGHT MOCHA raced greenly throughout.

Approaching the 900 metres **CAIRNSVILLE** who was racing greenly and hanging badly shifted in abruptly crowding and checking **HUGHES THAT GIRL** who was crowded into the rail losing considerable momentum. As a consequence of this incident **MISS MEERKAT** was also hampered. **CAIRNSVILLE** continued to hang and race greenly with the connections advised that the gelding was on a racing manners warning. Trainer K Cairns advised he would be making some gear adjustments and hopes to engage a senior rider for its next start.

FASCINATE and GALLANT BOY both raced keenly through the middle stages

Passing the 300 metres PEAK HOUR shifted out momentarily inconveniencing MIDNIGHT MOCHA.

FASCINATE was unable to gain full clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

YOUNG JIM shifted out abruptly in the shadows of the post but was always well clear of other runners.

Stewards requested a post-race veterinary inspection of **HUGHES THAT GIRL** which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 3 ETRUSCO AT THE SAVOY/LEITH LIQUORLAND R65 HCP 1200m

STRIKE UP THE BAND was slow to begin.

MAHBEER had to be severely restrained when racing keenly at the 900 metres resulting in the trailing **MASTER CHIEF** having to be steadied. **SPITTING IMAGE** who was racing keenly also had to be steadied as a result.

Passing the 250 metres **MASTER CHIEF** shifted out to find clear racing room and in doing so dictated **STRIKE UP THE BAND** wider on the track.

D Prastiyou the rider of favoured runner **SPITTING IMAGE** reported that his mount pulled hard for the majority of the race and when let down proved disappointing.

Race 4 LYNDSAY MOYLE MEMORIAL RATING 75 1200m

ARISTA shifted in at the start making firm contact with **TOMMY TUCKER** who was dictated in and crowded **GOLDEN CASTLE** with all three runners getting back as a result.

RECORDING raced wide throughout and keenly through the middle stages.

Passing the 200 metres **REMIND ME** (R Bishop) shifted in momentarily crowding **MR TRIMBOLE** who had to steady. R Bishop was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) careless riding.

TOMMY TUCKER raced in restricted room over the last 100 metres and was held up in the shadows of the post.

Race 5 BENGERBURN STATION RATING 65 & JUMPERS 2200m

KEEP IT TIGHT gave ground from the 600 metres finishing in last placing.

Passing the 150 metres the rider of **DELACROIX** accidentally dropped the left hand rein when the gelding was hanging losing some momentum.

Race 6 WALTER PARKER MEMORIAL RATING 65 1400m

GIOCCHINO blundered and was slow away.

SECRET GURU shifted out abruptly at the start losing momentum.

OUR SANTANA raced keenly through the early stages.

SECRET GURU blundered at the 800 metres losing momentum.

GIOCCHINO had to be steadied passing the 600 metres when over-racing.

OUR SANTANA lay in over the concluding stages and had to be straightened.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favourite **GALLANT RUBY** rider C Barnes advised the Stewards that her mount raced further back than expected after drawing wide and raced keenly in the middle stages however, did continue to make ground in the straight. She added in her opinion the filly is better suited to more give in the track.

Race 7 PUBLICANS CHALLENGE CUP RATING 85 1600m

The rider of **AL ASKAN** D Prastiyou momentarily lost his right side iron for several strides as the start was made.

SOUTHERN SAV was slow to begin and then slow through the early stages.

MAGIC EPIC began awkwardly losing ground.

SPLIT DECISION shifted in abruptly passing the junction at the 1400 metres dictating **HEXIE HAO** inwards momentarily.

MAGIC EPIC and HEZA KOOL KAT both raced keenly through the middle stages.

When spoken to regarding the performance of **MIKABELLA** rider A Morgan advised the Stewards the mare had been slightly disappointing but added she would benefit from today's race.

When spoken to regarding the performance of **SOUTHERN SAV** rider B Pitman advised the Stewards that the gelding had been a little bit slow to begin but had maintained contact with the field and as the pace eased through the middle stages raced keenly for some distance and then when the field sprinted from the 500 metres was left flat footed and only battled over the concluding stages in his first start for two months.

Race 8 TEMUKA TRANSPORT RATING 65 1600m

CHASUBLE and ALYSSA BELLE made contact shortly after the start.

ALYSSA BELLE hung throughout.

GERVASIO raced keenly when leading.

STRUCTURE was held up throughout the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

K Williams rider of RED BULL advised the Stewards that the gelding had a nice run throughout however failed to let down

and she had advised the connections that in her opinion the horse would benefit with the addition of blinkers.

When spoken to regarding the performance of **ALYSSA BELLE** rider T Moseley advised that the mare had hung throughout which had not helped today's performance.

Rider B Pitman advised that **GERVASIO** raced keenly throughout, did not let down and would benefit from today's run.
