## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TREES TAVERN TOKOROA 2000
<p><b>JIGGER INN</b> (V Colgan) was late scratched on veterinary advice at 12.34 pm at the barrier, when the gelding was found to be mildly lame in the off foreleg.</p> <p><b>SOUL SISTA</b> (M Coleman) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TYCOON CLASS</b> (J Jago) shifted out jumping away, making contact with <b>SERENEANOVA</b> (M Du Plessis) forcing that runner on to <b>SHEL'BLITZEM</b> (S Spratt) which lost ground.</p> <p><b>TYCOON CLASS</b> raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the winning post on the first occasion, and continued to do so for some distance.</p> <p><b>SINO HEIGHTS</b> (J Oliver) was obliged to race wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres <b>BY GOLLY</b> (T Thornton) shifted out to improve forward and in doing so inconvenienced <b>ROOF OF RECKONING</b> (B Hutton).</p> <p>Passing the 900 metres <b>OUTLINE</b> (M Dee) became awkwardly placed on heels, shifting out, inconveniencing <b>ALL OKAY</b> (B R Jones).</p> <p><b>EKRAARSTATIC</b> (C Grylls) was steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>KINDALEICA</b> (S Collett) for a distance passing the 400 metres.</p>	

**KINDALEICA** had a tendency to lay out throughout the race.

Approaching the 250 metres **SENTEBALE** (M Hills) shifted away from **BY GOLLY** which had shifted out slightly under pressure with **SPEEDY JAX** (B Grylls) then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **SENTEBALE** having to be steadied.

When questioned regarding the performance of **OUTLINE** apprentice rider M Dee advised that there had been no tangible excuse for today's performance.

**Race 2 OS SERVICES LIMITED 1400**

**ST MOET** (C Grylls) was slow to begin.

**SHOW MACCOOL** (M Du Plessis) jumped away awkwardly.

**CURLI** (D Johnson) was inclined to lay out throughout.

**THE LINK** (J Oliver) lay out in the final straight when placed under pressure finishing wide on the track.

**Race 3 RETOX SPORTS BAR & TOKOROA COSMOPOLITAN CLUB 1200**

**HYSTERIA LANE** (C Grylls) and **MATANGI BOY** (J Jago) were both slow to begin.

**PENTATHLON** (M Du Plessis) jumped away awkwardly and then was further hampered by **EYESONYOU** (D Johnson) which shifted out.

**FLAVIGNY** (M Coleman) and **ATTENTION SEEKER** (V Colgan) raced greenly in the early to middle stages.

**HERO I AM** (S Spratt) shifted out approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running, inconveniencing the weakening **BORNTOACHIEVE** (M McNab).

Following the race **BORNTOACHIEVE** underwent a veterinary examination including an endoscopic procedure which could find no abnormality.

**Race 4 TOKOROA CLUB (INC) 1200**

**RATMANSKY** (C Grylls), **JACKY PAPER** (T Wenn) and **DEEBEE DON** (M Coleman) were all slow to begin.

**RASCAL** (M McNab) shifted out when jumping away, placing **RATMANSKY** in restricted room for a short distance.

**DJANGO** (S Spratt) over-raced in the early and middle stages, and had to be restrained off the heels of **VETTEL** (V Colgan) approaching the bend near the 800 metres, shifting out and forcing **STINGER** (T Thornton) over ground. **DJANGO** and **STINGER** were then being obliged to race wide for the remainder of the race.

**DJANGO** shifted out when weakening passing the 300 metres, inconveniencing **STINGER**.

**RASCAL** returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils, and after undergoing a veterinary inspection was deemed to be a bleeder and as such is subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing in New Zealand.

**Race 5 PRIMA PARK BLOODSTOCK 1200**

**CRUISEO** (B R Jones) was slow to begin.

**SOUTHERN COMET** (M Dee) knuckled leaving the barrier shifting out, inconveniencing **BONETE** (S Spratt).

**BECKHAM** (V Colgan) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**Race 6 POCKETS Q MASTERS TOKOROA 1400**

**RESUME** (M Dee) began awkwardly.

After beginning awkwardly, **EXCITAR** (D Johnson) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

Crossing on to the course proper **CHINA TEA** (C Grylls) ducked in inconveniencing **MAGIC MEMORIES** (M Du Plessis).

**KAABA** (T Thornton) and **ESTELLE** (V Colgan) both made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres.

**SOPHISTICATE** (M Coleman) raced wide without cover throughout.

**EXCITAR** shifted out passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running inconveniencing the weakening **RESUME**.

**ESTELLE** made the final turn awkwardly and was not persevered with in the final straight. V Colgan reported that the filly had not received a lot of luck during the running being obliged to race wide for the majority of the event.

**ESTELLE** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which found no obvious abnormality.

**Race 7 LALLY & SYMES SOUTH WAIKATO CUP**

**LETMEBY** (M Coleman) and **ESKABAR** (M McNab) came together leaving the barrier when **LETMEBY** shifted out.

**SHEZ KAPABLE** (M Du Plessis) and **CRISTAL HEIGHTS** (D Johnson) were both slow to begin.

**KING PICCOLO** (M Dee) raced four wide leaving the straight on the first occasion before attempting to improve forward passing the 1200 metres, but was unable to obtain running closer to the running rail and was obliged to race three wide without cover.

Following the race **RINGO STARR** (T Thornton) underwent veterinary treatment suffering from heat stress. Trainer D Greene undertook to report to Stewards the progress of **RINGO STARR** including the results of further veterinary

tests.

**Race 8**

**MATLEY FINANCIAL SERVICES 1400**

**SATAY** (T Thornton) was removed after striking the barrier to undergo a veterinary examination, being cleared fit to run.

**BLACK RUSSIAN** (S Spratt) blundered leaving the barrier, losing ground.

**QUINTASTICS** (B Hutton) began awkwardly making heavy contact with **SATAY** which lost ground.

**SATAY** returned to the enclosure with blood present due to a minor laceration in a nostril.

**Race 9**

**TEAM WEALLEANS 1600**

After becoming fractious in the starting stalls **TERSE** (M Dee) was slow to begin.

**FIREPOWER** (B Hutton) was hampered leaving the barrier by **PANNO ROSSA** (D Johnson) which shifted out.

**FIREPOWER** raced greenly in the early stages.

**READY TO RUMBLE** (S Spratt) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**PINDALU** (B Grylls) raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 250 metres **PINDALU**, **DAREYOUTO** (H Tinsley) and **THE HAWK** (V Colgan) were crowded between **EL TYSON** (S Collett) which shifted out to obtain clear running and **TERSE** which shifted in under pressure. Both riders S Collett and M Dee were reprimanded by Stewards and advised that they must exercise greater care in future when shifting ground.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MAGNIFIER** jockey C Grylls reported that the gelding had a breathing irregularity. **MAGNIFIER** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer G Richardson undertook to report to Stewards anything that may become apparent in days subsequent.
