RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TAURANGA CHRISTMAS RACES – BOOK NOW 1400
<p>SIR JACK REMINGTON (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, shifting in, making contact with GARDEZ LA FOI (J Oliver).</p> <p>SCHRODINGERS CAT (R Myers) began awkwardly.</p> <p>THE BOUNCER (M Dravitzki) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>KING PANAMERA (R Smyth) shifted out abruptly shortly after leaving the barrier, hampering JUST IDEAL (M Coleman) which lost ground.</p> <p>SCHRODINGERS CAT over-raced in the early stages, and then was obliged to race three wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>GARDEZ LA FOI raced ungenerously when making the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>ROCKY ROAD (D Johnson) had a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure approaching the 600 metres, and then commenced to give ground.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of ROCKY ROAD rider D Johnson was of the opinion that the gelding had failed to handle the existing track conditions.</p> <p>Trainer Mr L Reid (GERRY MERITO) was reprimanded for making contact with his jockey prior to having weighed in.</p>	

Race 2	JEREMY PRYOR – BAYLEYS 1400
<p>JOKING (R Myers) began awkwardly.</p> <p>NGATIRA GOLD (B R Jones) began awkwardly, shifting in, making contact with JESSHANIMO (Z Moki) which lost ground.</p> <p>ANAHEIM (L Magorrian) was slow away.</p> <p>DANCE (D Johnson) and CENTAVADA (M Cameron) both raced keenly when making the bend passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>BRONDAN (S Collett) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>STEFFI'S SECRET (U Holmquist) had a tendency to shift out under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of STEFFI'S SECRET trainer Mr B Cook advised that he had been pleased with the filly's fresh-up performance at Wanganui on 31 May 2014. Mr Cook further advised that STEFFI'S SECRET had disappointed at Taranaki 5 June 2014, and following the race the filly was found to have minor muscle issues in her back. Mr Cook explained STEFFI'S SECRET had been working well leading into today's event, and was confident of an improved performance.</p>	
Race 3	ZEST 3YO
<p>LAMASON (M Cameron) began awkwardly, shifting out, hampering EL BANDIDO (D Johnson) which lost ground. Also inconvenienced as a result was GOTTA KEEPER (B R Jones) which lost ground.</p> <p>GETALONGHOME CINDY (L Magorrian) and SHEZ BUBBLY (S Collett) were both obliged to race wide without cover from near the 900 metres.</p> <p>Rider D Johnson reported that EL BANDIDO had been uncomfortable in the existing track conditions.</p> <p>GOTTA KEEPER returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary examination the blood was found to be consistent with a minor laceration.</p>	
Race 4	SEEKA KIWIFRUIT INDUSTRIES 1200
<p>BRIAN'S HONOUR (D Johnson) stumbled leaving the barrier and shifted in, hampering GINJA NINJA (O Bosson) which lost ground. Contributing was outward movement from AAJA NACHLE (M Cameron).</p> <p>VIBRANT MOSS (R Myers) and SUNBEAM (M Coleman) were slow away.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of GINJA NINJA rider O Bosson advised that after suffering interference at the start of the race GINJA NINJA had got further back than intended, and then had reacted poorly to the track surface kick-back. GINJA NINJA underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>REGALIA (R Hutchings) which was not persevered with in the final straight, underwent a veterinary examination after rider R Hutchings advised the mare had felt indifferent. REGALIA was found to have a delayed respiratory recovery. Trainer D Rogerson was asked to advise the progress of REGALIA in days subsequent.</p>	
Race 5	GPS-IT PRECISION LAND MAPPING 2100
<p>SAVED BY THE BELL (H Tinsley) began a little awkwardly, shifting out making contact with LE BON FIN (M Dee). Shortly after the start DIAMOND GRACE (D Johnson) was crowded to the inside of STAGEHAND (C Dell) which shifted in. As a result DIAMOND GRACE had to be steadied losing ground. Apprentice rider C Dell was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres HAYLEY GRACE (D Hain) had to be steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of STAGEHAND which shifted in. Apprentice rider C Dell was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must be fully clear when shifting ground.</p> <p>Approaching the 350 metres BAHHTON (B R Jones) and GET OUT OF IT (M Cameron) came together with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced. BAHHTON then steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SECOND INNINGS (L Magorrian) which shifted out. Apprentice rider L Magorrian was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>Passing the 350 metres FAIR FLEET (U Holmquist) shifted out with PEREGRINE (R Smyth) then shifting away from that runner and continued to shift out crowding LE BON FIN which had improved on to that runner's heels. As a result KATIE MCKEEN (K Chiong) which was racing to the outside of LE BON FIN was crowded for a distance. Inconvenienced as a result was HAYLEY GRACE. Apprentice rider R Smyth was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on her record. R Smyth was further advised she must take corrective action sooner than she had.</p> <p>Trainer G McBeth was fined \$50 after the stable representative presented KATIE MCKEEN to race without notified gear (blinkers).</p>	
Race 6	ORORA KIWI PACKAGING – LRK TRAYS KIWIFRUIT CUP
<p>INTRANSIGENT (K Chiong) was slow to begin.</p> <p>INNOVATION (M Dee) began awkwardly, shifting out and making contact with ONE ABOVE (B R Jones) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>REGALO REAAL (R Hannam) was a little slow to begin.</p>	

MATOST (J Riddell) had to steady when racing in restricted room passing the 1700 metres.
MAGNA CARTA (M Coleman) raced ungenerously when being restrained leaving the straight on the first occasion.
REGALO REAAL raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.
MATOST steadied approaching the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **HI YO SOO** (R Myers).
R Hannam advised that in his opinion **REGALO REAAL** may be unsuited to the right handed way of going.
Rider D Johnson was at a loss to explain the performance of **BRAGATO**. Trainer Mr R Joostens undertook to report to Stewards anything that may become apparent in days subsequent.

Race 7	BETHLEHEM MOTOR INN 1600

SIR ELMO (A Jones) was slow to begin.
ON THE LEVEL (O Bosson) and **ARIZONA JAZZ** (T Thornton) both began awkwardly and made contact shortly after the start.
ON THE LEVEL raced keenly through the early stages and then was obliged to race wide without cover.
PERMESSO (M Wenn) had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when racing in restricted room to the outside of **KAPSBOY** (U Holmquist) which shifted out slightly.
M Dee (**HE'S DAN**) dropped his whip near the 200 metres.
ON THE LEVEL was not persevered with over the concluding stages with the Stewards ordering a post-race veterinary examination of the gelding which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
CHILL BILL (D Johnson) underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer Mr A Forsman was asked to report anything that may become apparent in days subsequent.

Race 8	TEAM WEALLEANS TAURANGA CLASSIC

NORTH AND SOUTH (R Hannam) bounded and began awkwardly losing ground. **NORTH AND SOUTH** then raced ungenerously when being restrained through the middle stages.
Passing the 1200 metres **MAGIC BELLE** (D Johnson) shifted out when over-racing, crowding **I DO** (J Riddell).
BETTER KEEPER (R Hutchings) was held up approaching the 600 metres.
Passing the 300 metres **MAGIC BELLE** shifted out, inconveniencing **BETTER KEEPER** and **ELUSIVE TRACY** (N Harris).
KARLA BRUNI (O Bosson) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.
Rider O Bosson advised that **KARLA BRUNI** may have been unsuited by today's track conditions.

Race 9	RAWHITI HORT 1400

OUI (R Smyth), **WAINUI PRINCE** (J Oliver), **NOTTOOBAD** (D Johnson) and **ZAH GIRL** (R Hannam) all began awkwardly losing ground.
WAR STORY (R Hutchings) and **SIR AMRON** (S Collett) both began awkwardly and came together, and then were crowded when **SWAP FOR KASH** (T Wenn) shifted in crowding **NOTHING** (B R Jones) on to the aforementioned runners with both **SIR AMRON** and **WAR STORY** losing considerable ground.
Passing the 1350 metres **SWAP FOR KASH** continued to shift in crowding **NOTHING** on to **SWIPER THE FOX** (L Magorrian) which were both inconvenienced.
Approaching the 1100 metres **SWAP FOR KASH** continued to shift in with **WAINUI PRINCE** then becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels and racing ungenerously for a distance. Apprentice rider T Wenn was reprimanded by Stewards and advised she must exercise far greater care when shifting ground.
Approaching the 300 metres **SWIPER THE FOX** shifted in to obtain clear running.
IMMIGRATION (M Coleman) shifted ground inwards over the concluding stages.
IRISH HEARTBEAT (M Hills) underwent a post-race veterinary examination after returning to the enclosure with a small amount of blood in the nasal area. A Veterinary examination found the gelding to have erosions in both nostrils and a slow respiratory recovery. Trainer T Autridge was advised to report the progress of **IRISH HEARTBEAT**.
When questioned regarding the performance of **ROLL WITH PULSE** apprentice rider J Wong advised that the gelding was not entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.
