## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>BODY &amp; SOUL FITNESS OTAKI HIGHWEIGHT (1600 metres)</b>
<b>JUST COLLIE</b> lay in under pressure inconveniencing <b>BE YOURSELF</b> near the 150 metres. <b>KINGIESSTAR</b> returned to the birdcage minus the off-fore plate. <b>M Gillies (IRISHWISE)</b> admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 200 metres and was fined the sum of \$175.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>NIGEL SMITH TRACTORS &amp; FARM MACHINERY OTAKI HIGHWEIGHT (2100 metres)</b>
<b>SINGLE GIRL</b> shifted outwards leaving the barriers hampering <b>I SUGGEST</b> , which lost ground. <b>GIRL WITH A PEARL</b> was slow away. <b>SELAMAT</b> had to be steadied near the 1800 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>JACK’S BOY</b> (M McNellis), which shifted in. M McNellis was issued with a warning. When questioned into the improved performance of <b>HEIR SUPPLY</b> , trainer T Taylor advised the gelding was better suited to highweight grade races and also benefitted from wearing ear covers, which appeared to have a calming effect. <b>SHARE THE BLAME</b> and <b>HEIR SUPPLY</b> both raced wide throughout in search of better footing.	

<p><b>SHARE THE BLAME (R Hutchings)</b> lay out under pressure in the home straight and made contact with <b>HEIR SUPPLY</b> for some distance near the 150 metres. R Hutchings was advised that he is expected to exercise more care when placed in similar circumstances.</p> <p><b>GIRL WITH A PEARL</b> was disappointing, finishing last. Rider J Riddell stated that <b>GIRL WITH A PEARL</b> was unsuited to the holding, Heavy(11) track conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormalities, other than a slow recovery rate.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>KAYZED RACING 2YO HANDICAP (1200 metres)</b>
<p><b>PRICE TAG</b> over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SUMMONED</b> shifted inwards under pressure near the 300 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>DANIEL MCGILL PLUMBING MAIDEN (1380 metres)</b>
<p><b>HOSEA</b> was hampered leaving the barriers, losing ground.</p> <p><b>APLOMB</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>POSTBOY</b> raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>HOSEA</b> was steadied to avoid the heels of the weakening <b>WRECKING BALL</b> near the 500 metres.</p> <p>B Lammas (<b>DAL FINIAN</b>) was spoken to regarding the use of his whip in the home straight.</p> <p><b>T Kahlon (DAME WYNNIE)</b> admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that she used her whip unnecessarily on a horse out of contention and was fined the sum of \$100.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the poor performance of <b>WRECKING BALL</b>, rider J Parkes advised the gelding was unsuited to today's very testing track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection of <b>WRECKING BALL</b> did not reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>KAYZED RACING SYNDICATION HANDICAP (1380 metres)</b>

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>NIGEL SMITH TRACTORS &amp; FARM MACHINERY OTAKI MAIDEN (1380 metres)</b>
<p><b>JIBRIL</b> and <b>SENTIMENT</b> were slow away.</p> <p><b>OUR BOI MAX</b> reared at the start.</p> <p><b>DAL KYANN</b> over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>CARLTON PRINCESS</b> was tightened near the 250 metres when <b>LITTLE DRUMMER BOY</b> shifted out simultaneously as <b>FOR FASHION</b> shifted in, and momentarily became unbalanced.</p> <p>Rider R Myers reported that <b>SENTIMENT</b>, which ran last, was making a respiratory noise. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>HUNTING &amp; FISHING NEW ZEALAND – OTAKI HANDICAP (1200 metres)</b>
<p><b>SANRIBA</b> was a late scratching at the barrier at 3.26pm on veterinary advice.</p> <p><b>TWILIGHT DRAGON</b> blundered leaving the barrier.</p> <p><b>DAIELLO</b> began awkwardly and shifted inwards, crowding <b>JUSTANEXCUSE</b>, which lost ground.</p> <p><b>THE LONE RANGER</b> began awkwardly, inconveniencing <b>CIVICS ROCK</b>.</p> <p><b>TWILIGHT DRAGON</b> raced keenly in the lead in the early stages.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>CIVICS ROCKS</b>, rider A Jones said her mount could not quicken in the going.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>DANIEL MCGILL PLUMBING HANDICAP (1380 metres)</b>
<p><b>COUNT BASIE</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>PERSIAN DANCER</b> hung outwards in the home straight and had to be straightened.</p> <p>The rider of <b>WOW WHATA PRINCESS</b>, V Ravikumar, in the presence of his employer F Auret, was spoken to with regard to the use of his whip in the home straight and his celebratory gesture prior to the finish.</p>
