<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Cowley's Hire Centre 2100</b>
PACO KID lost the right front plate during the running.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Fell Engineering 1200</b>
<p><b>IMPERIAL DUKE</b> (K Leung) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>When making the bend near the 850 metres <b>SO DANSO</b> (D Johnson) became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>HADDON HALL</b> (B Grylls) which shifted in. As a result <b>SO DANSO</b> then shifted out off the heels of <b>HADDON HALL</b> hampering <b>STREET WARS</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>IMPERIAL DUKE</b> which were both forced wider on the track.</p> <p><b>FILLE DU ROI</b> (S Spratt) over-raced through the middle stages and near the 800 metres the mare had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>HADDON HALL</b>.</p> <p><b>STREET WARS</b> lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Croft Poles 1200</b>
<p><b>A Forbes</b> was fined \$300 for failing to make the contracted weight for LIA and was replaced by C Dell.</p> <p><b>PLAYBOY PRINCE</b> (S Spratt) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>CRAFTY LOVE</b> (M Du Plessis) shifted in when leaving the barriers inconveniencing <b>CEDAR ROSE</b> (M Sweeney).</p> <p><b>LIA</b> (C Dell) began awkwardly shifting out and inconveniencing <b>CHACHI ARCOLA</b> (B Grylls).</p> <p><b>CEDAR ROSE</b> over-raced when being restrained through the middle stages.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Judge House of Ale 1200</b>

**CEE TEE ARE** (R Hutchings) was slow to begin.

**RED LAMAR** (K Leung) shifted in abruptly when leaving the barriers making contact with **ANOTHER EDITION** (B Grylls) which was inconvenienced.

**TO BE SURE** (M Sweeney) began awkwardly losing ground.

**OUR KISMET** (S Spratt) began awkwardly.

50 Metres after the start **SMEDLEY** (L Magorrian) was allowed to shift in crowding **ELUSIVE UNICORN** (R Smyth) which was steadied losing ground.

**HUCKLEBERRY FLYER** (D Johnson) over-raced in the early stages.

**RED LAMAR** raced wide without cover throughout.

The favourite **BUCKLEBURY** (L Innes) lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out over the final 200 metres. When questioned Rider L Innes could offer no other reason for the mare's performance.

**Race 5**

**A'Fare Caterers 2100**

**SUGGESTIVE SMILE** (D Johnson) shifted out when leaving the barriers inconveniencing **BLOSSOM QUEEN** (L Innes) which had begun awkwardly.

**LONELY BOY** (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly losing ground.

**LUCY BEE** (M Sweeney) began awkwardly shifting out and then shifting back in abruptly unbalancing its rider.

When leaving the straight on the first occasion **LONELY BOY** raced ungenerously and shifted out briefly.

**LUCY BEE** was held up rounding the final turn and then early in the final straight.

**HOOPSAIN BOLT** (S Spratt) was held up early in the final straight behind the tiring **IKE EISENHOWER** (R Smyth).

**HOOPSAIN BOLT** raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres to the inside of **SUGGESTIVE SMILE** which had a tendency to lay in under pressure.

**Race 6**

**91.6 More FM 1400**

**JENUWIN** (M Du Plessis) underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to race.

**CARNELIAN LIGHTS** (C Dell) and **REVES EN ROUGES** (S Spratt) both began awkwardly.

**TIPIPK** (L Innes) shifted out when leaving the barriers crowding **CHRISTIAN GREY** (R Hutchings) which was then further crowded by **CAPTAIN EARNIE** (P Turner) which had shifted in abruptly.

**AFRICAN STAR** (M Sweeney) shifted in when leaving the barriers hampering **THE PATRIOT** (D Johnson) which had begun awkwardly.

**ALREADY GONE** (R Smyth) over-raced in the early stages and then passing the 900 metres was forced wider on the track by **THE PATRIOT** which had shifted out when over-racing. **THE PATRIOT** and **ALREADY GONE** then both raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

**CAPTAIN EARNIE** made the corner awkwardly passing the 850 metres.

**TIPIPK** shifted in under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **DEVITO** (B Hutton) passing the 50 metres.
