RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Westbury Stud 2200
<p>AROSE (R Smyth) knuckled when jumping away.</p> <p>CATCH ON (M Coleman) which was racing outside the leader got its head up when being restrained near the 1800 metres.</p> <p>T Thornton, the rider of TABLE ONE, was dislodged from her mount near the 1600 metres. Ms Thornton was attended to by ambulance personnel and the Course Doctor before being transferred to hospital for x-rays and further evaluation of an injury to her left leg. Also at that point of the race ESKABAR (A Forbes) was steadied with rider A Forbes advising that the gelding had re-acted poorly to the presence of CATCH ON which was improving to its outside. When being steadied ESKABAR went back on to ROCK EXPRESS (BR Jones). Hampered as a result of the dislodged rider were SECOND INNINGS (J Jago), STONELEIGH (K Leung) and TEAM PETE (L Satherley). Evidence was taken from riders M Coleman, A Forbes, BR Jones and J Jago with inquiries into this incident being adjourned due to the unavailability of Ms Thornton.</p>	

Following the race **TABLE ONE** and **CATCH ON** both required veterinary attention, **TABLE ONE** for a laceration to the right front knee and **CATCH ON** for a laceration to the left hind cannon bone.
CATCH ON was badly hampered by the rider-less horse passing the 1400 metres resulting in **ESKABAR** and **SECOND INNINGS** also being inconvenienced.
STONELEIGH raced three wide without cover.
POETRY (M McNab) was briefly held up entering the final straight and when shifting out to obtain clear running made contact with **ROCK EXPRESS** near the 350 metres.
ESKABAR raced greenly in the final straight shifting outwards abruptly passing the 300 metres and continued to have a tendency to shift ground under pressure for the remainder of the race.

Race 2 | **Property Press 2YO**

BORNTOACHIEVE (J Jago) shifted out leaving the barriers hampering **EYESONYOU** (M Coleman).
ROCK DA (M Sweeney) began awkwardly.
 Shortly after the start **ROCK DA** and **ANDNOWURMINE** (K Leung) both raced in restricted room to the inside of **JET TRAC** (M McNab) which shifted in slightly. As a result **ROCK DA** and **JET TRAC** both had to steady.
DARCI'S DREAM (A Forbes), **BORNTOACHIEVE** and **ANDNOWURMINE** all over-raced in the middle stages as a result of the slow tempo of the race with **BORNTOACHIEVE** shifting out passing the 800 metres and racing three wide without cover for the remainder of the race. As a result **ANDNOWURMINE** was forced four wide to race wide without cover from that point.
DARCI'S DREAM shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres inconveniencing **ROCK DA**.
BORNTOACHIEVE shifted out under pressure passing the 250 metres hampering **DARCI'S DREAM** which was forced out on to **ANDNOWURMINE**. J Jago was issued with a warning and advised that he must stop riding and straighten his mount more quickly than he had on this occasion.
 M McNab was treated by the Club's Doctor following this race suffering from dehydration.

Race 3 | **Barfoot & Thompson 1400**

PINDALU (R Norvall) and **ALADDIN** (M Coleman) came together leaving the barriers.
DEFIANT ROSE (R Smyth) was a little slow to begin.
 Approaching the 1100 metres **BACHELOR BRAVE** (M McNab) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **ALADDIN** which had steadied with **BACHELOR BRAVE** then over-racing for a distance.
PINDALU was held up rounding the final turn before shifting in to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.
BACHELOR BRAVE shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres inconveniencing **ERNIE** (BR Jones) which was forced wider on the track. Also inconvenienced as a result was **TORRIO** (M Sweeney) and **PONDAROSA MISS** (D Hain).
BACHELOR BRAVE then raced greenly when placed under pressure.
 Approaching the 100 metres **ISEEMAGIC** (B Grylls) shifted away from **BACHELOR BRAVE** dictating **DEFIANT ROSE** in on to **PINDALU** which had to be steadied.
BR Jones (ERNIE) dropped his whip near the 250 metres.
 Following the race M McNab advised that he was feeling unwell and after being examined by the Club's Doctor was stood down from his remaining rides suffering from dehydration.

Race 4 | **Blueriver Creative 1200**

DREAMCOAT (M Sweeney) knuckled leaving the barriers.
POPPAS DELIGHT (B Grylls) began a little awkwardly.
CARTELL (L Magorrian) raced in restricted room to the inside of **DREAMCOAT** for a distance passing the 1100 metres.

Race 5 | **Eggs Old Girls Challenge 1200**

PERIDOT (M Sweeney) was slow to begin.
CAST KING (J Wong) knuckled leaving the barriers.
 Apprentice R Smyth admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted her mount **DUFELLFORTE** (R Smyth) to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of **SPIRIT OF WYUNA** (M Coleman) which was hampered and forced inwards causing severe crowding to **CAST KING**, **BIG VOICES** (BR Jones) and **CASINO PARK** (P Turner) which were all checked. After hearing submissions Ms Smyth's licence to ride in races was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 5 April 2014 until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 19 April 2014, 7 riding days.
PERIDOT raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages and continued to over-race through the middle stages.
FUNHOUSE (B Grylls) had a tendency to over-race through the middle stages.
CASINO PARK was held up rounding the final turn.
DUFELLFORTE shifted ground under pressure in the final straight taking **FUNHOUSE** inwards near the 100 metres resulting in **CASINO PARK** having to be steadied. R Smyth was issued with a warning.

Race 6 | **Fuji Xerox 2200**

ENDOR (BR Jones) was slow to begin.
WISECRACK (B Grylls) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.
BEYOND DESIRE (M Sweeney) commenced to over-race leaving the straight on the first occasion and raced three wide

without cover until near the 1500 metres.

LION RED (M Coleman) shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres inconveniencing the weakening **EL SOLDADO** (J Jago) and **ENDOR**.

Race 7

Barfoot & Thompson Trophy

HIGH RISE (C Dell) and **BONINSKY** (K Leung) both began awkwardly.

NEW GREENFIELD (R Norvall) was a little slow to begin.

NEW GREENFIELD raced three wide without cover.

KING'S FORTUNE (M Sweeney) hung inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MONEYTREE** Rider M Coleman stated that the gelding had got back on a moderate pace and had been left flat-footed when the race developed into a sprint home. **MONEYTREE** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 8

Air Tahiti Nui Mile

LADY EIKO (B Grylls) was slow to begin.

KALEIDOSCOPE (M Coleman) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers crowding **BIOLOGIST** (L Satherley) on to **CANDLE IN THE WIND** (R Norvall).

DRESDEN PARK (R Smyth) which had shifted in when jumping away making contact with **LOK'N'KAY** (M Sweeney) then shifted away from that runner abruptly, crowding **RED DAKOTA** (J Jago), **KALEIDOSCOPE** and further crowding **BIOLOGIST** and **CANDLE IN THE WIND** which was checked losing ground. **CANDLE IN THE WIND** then blundered losing further ground. **RED DAKOTA** over-raced in the middle stages and when being restrained near the 1100 metres got its head up and shifted out across the heels of **BIOLOGIST**. **RED DAKOTA** continued to race ungenerously for some distance.

DRESDEN PARK was held up rounding the final turn and did not obtain clear running until passing the 250 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BIOLOGIST** Rider L Satherley stated that the gelding compounded quickly in the final straight once placed under pressure and was eased down over the concluding stages when she felt there may be something amiss. A post-race veterinary examination of **BIOLOGIST** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 9

Leave a Lasting Legacy 1400

MAILLY (K Joyce) and **GREY HERO** (M Sweeney) both began awkwardly.

DALEZINGA (T Wenn) knuckled leaving the barriers and shifted outwards making contact with **JUSTINTIME** (B Grylls) which had been slow to begin.

WOLFWHISTLE (A Forbes) began awkwardly and shifted outwards inconveniencing **BITETHEBULLET** (J Wong).

ROSE OF VIRGINIA (A Jones) shifted out off heels passing the 900 metres then racing wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

REKA (L Satherley) went off stride near the 800 metres.

DALEZINGA had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight and then was inconvenienced near the 250 metres when **JUSTINTIME** shifted in.

MAKARSKA (M Coleman) shifted outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

WOLFWHISTLE hung outwards throughout the race.
