## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MCROBBIE CONTRACTING 1400</b>
<b>EL CORBY</b> (L Satherley) began awkwardly. Following this race the track was downgraded to Dead(5).	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>APPARELMASTER COASTLINE DRYCLEANERS 1400</b>
<b>AMBITIOUS DANCER</b> (D Johnson) shifted in on jumping away hampering <b>SKYLLA</b> (R Hutchings). <b>BAROSSA DUKE</b> (M Hills) over-raced in the early and middle stages racing three wide without cover throughout. <b>AMBITIOUS DANCER</b> (D Johnson) had a tendency to lay out under pressure inconveniencing <b>BAROSSA DUKE</b> (M Hills) near the 100 metres.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1200</b>
<b>BROKASH</b> (B R Jones) was a late scratching at 1.35 pm after refusing to parade to the start. Co-trainer Mr R Lang was advised that <b>BROKASH</b> must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next. As a result this race started approximately two minutes late. <b>QUEEN OF EXCUSES</b> (J Wong) was inclined to over-race in the middle stages. <b>CAPISTRANO MAGIC</b> (D Johnson) made the final turn awkwardly shifting outwards away from <b>BACK ON SONG</b> (R Hutchings) making contact with the hind quarters of <b>TRUE SPIRIT</b> (M Dravitzki). <b>SHEBANG</b> (M Wenn) raced wide without cover throughout. <b>QUEEN OF EXCUSES</b> was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight brushing <b>FELICITY HALL</b> (K Myers) on a number of occasions. Following this race the track was further downgraded to Dead(6).	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MATHIS ELECTRICAL 1600</b>
<b>WHATWASTHAT</b> (J Jago) and <b>VELVET GUINNESS</b> (K Myers) were slow to begin. <b>SOPHISTICATE</b> (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly. <b>MIDNIGHT REIGN</b> (B Hutton) raced ungenerously in the early stages. <b>WHATWASTHAT</b> raced greenly in the final straight.	

Race 5	TEAM WEALLEANS 2100
<b>NORTH OF SUNSET</b> (D Johnson) had a tendency to shift ground under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing <b>FASTNFREE</b> (A Jones) passing the 100 metres.	
Race 6	THE FRESH MARKET 1200
<b>SAME AS</b> (L Satherley) was slow to begin. <b>BORN HAPPY</b> (M Du Plessis) began very awkwardly. <b>RED CAVIAR</b> (R Hutchings) also began awkwardly and shifted inwards away from <b>BORN HAPPY</b> simultaneously as <b>BISQUEE</b> (c Grylls) jumped outwards. This resulted in both sides of <b>EL BANDIDO'S</b> (K Myers) barrier moving with the gelding being placed in restricted room and struck in the head losing ground. <b>RED CAVIAR</b> made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly hampering <b>SAME AS</b> . <b>SAME AS</b> lay out when racing greenly rounding the final turn and in the straight. <b>EL BANDIDO</b> had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.	
Race 7	NEW WORLD WHAKATANE 1600
<b>HE SURE IS</b> (K Leung) was slow to begin. <b>ISTILANE</b> (R Hutchings) made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly when over-racing hampering <b>SAINT MARTINS</b> (M Du Plessis), <b>DEEBEE DON</b> (M Coleman) and <b>DIAMOND EDGE</b> (C Grylls). <b>ISTILANE</b> continued to over-race around the bend. <b>NOAH JON</b> (L Satherley) raced three wide without cover throughout. <b>SWEET RITA</b> (B Grylls) had to be restrained off the heels of <b>COPS 'N' COYOTE</b> (D Johnson) near the 500 metres. <b>DIAMOND EDGE</b> was held up and unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 150 metres. With regard to the improved performance of <b>GOODN'TARG</b> , the stable representative advised that the filly had been suited by today's rain affected track conditions.
