## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MOTORCYCLE HQ / PROPERTY BROKERS TARARUA DISTANCE</b>
<p><b>AND THATZ SCOTTY</b> bumped heavily with <b>BEFORUNOIT</b> at the start resulting in <b>BEFORUNOIT</b> settling back.</p> <p><b>VIA DOLOROSA</b> over-raced in the lead throughout.</p> <p><b>EVASIVE TRACY</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>AND THATZ SCOTTY</b> raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>VIA DOLOROSA</b> commenced to give ground sharply passing the 600 metres and went back onto <b>TIZZA SECRET</b> which had to steady off that runner's heels.</p> <p><b>GOLDEN PENNY</b> shifted ground inwards under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened on several occasions.</p> <p><b>AND THATZ SCOTTY</b> returned to the enclosure minus a hind plate.</p> <p><b>R Hutchings</b> could offer no excuses for the performance of <b>SAND BIRD</b>.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>VIA DOLOROSA</b>, <b>S Doyle</b> said the gelding had little left after pulling fiercely in the early and middle stages.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>STRINGFELLOWS /MCDUGALLS FILLIES AND MARES</b>

<p><b>MINGS GIRL</b> reacted adversely to the application of a tongue tie when parading and refused to proceed to the start. Stewards gave permission for the mare to race without the tongue tie.</p> <p>Shortly after the start <b>MINGS GIRL</b> when being ridden up attempted to buck. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's racing manners.</p> <p>Turning out of the back straight <b>CAROUSEL</b> shifted in and bumped with <b>MISS LIGHTNING</b> resulting in <b>CAROUSEL</b> becoming unbalanced momentarily.</p> <p><b>MY OPINION</b> was not persevered with after rider <b>D Walker</b> felt the mare go amiss near the 400 metres. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a ruptured blood vessel in the right hind leg. While undergoing veterinary treatment on the course, the condition of <b>MY OPINION</b> deteriorated resulting in the mare having to be euthanized.</p>	
Race 3	<b>POWER FARMING MANAWATU JUMPERS FLAT</b>
<p><b>SEA EAGLE</b> was slow to begin and then raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the event.</p> <p><b>SELAMAT</b> raced keenly early.</p> <p><b>D Miller</b> reported that <b>FLYNN</b> which disappointed, was not comfortable at any stage in the puggy ground.</p> <p><b>D Miller</b> was reminded of his obligations with respect to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 4	<b>AFFCO NZ LTD / JAMES &amp; SON 3 YEAR OLD</b>
<p><b>SAN JARA</b> shifted out abruptly on jumping away simultaneously as <b>SOCIAL KIWI</b> jumped in resulting in <b>STADALCA</b> being tightened and losing ground.</p> <p><b>MISCHIEVOUS MIS</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>R Hannam</b> reported that <b>FREELINKS</b> was unsuited to the heavy 10 track.</p>	
Race 5	<b>JOHN TURKINGTON LIMITED METRIC MILE</b>
<p><b>ALPHABET STREET</b> had to steady near the 600 metres when attempting to improve to the outside of <b>BAZINGER</b> and inside of <b>COUNT BASIE</b>. <b>ALPHABET STREET</b> then lost momentum and only battled in the home straight.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>ROCKY ROAD</b> which gave ground quickly near the 600 metres, <b>T Harris</b> said the gelding was inclined to lug out and did not handle the Heavy 10 track.</p> <p><b>N Quinn</b> admitted a charge under Rule 638 (3) (b) in that he used his whip on <b>LITTLE BENNY</b> outside the guidelines prior to the 200 metres and was fined \$175.</p>	
Race 6	<b>NAYLOR LAWRENCE &amp; ASSOCIATES / TUI HQ DASH</b>
<p><b>DON'T BLAME BUSTER</b> was tightened and got back at the start.</p> <p><b>REGINALD</b> raced wide without cover down the back.</p> <p><b>GOLDEN BAY</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>DON'T BLAME BUSTER</b> was held up in the early part of the home straight.</p> <p><b>DON'T BLAME BUSTER</b> returned to the enclosure with blood traces present in one nostril. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed trauma and the gelding is not deemed to be a bleeder.</p>	
Race 7	<b>TARARUA HELIWORK / FARMLANDS PAHIATUA HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>THE LONE RANGER</b> raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>FLIPPANT</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>M Dravitzki</b> was questioned into her ride after <b>DON'TLIKEMONDAY</b> got some distance off the pace in the early stages. <b>M Dravitzki</b> explained that the gelding was reluctant to hit out in the puggy going particularly in the back straight and only let down when angled wide over the final stages.</p>	
Race 8	<b>DANNEVIRKE DAIRY SUPPLIES LIMITED SPRINT</b>
<p><b>GALLETA</b> underwent a veterinary examination prior to the start after being kicked and was cleared to race.</p> <p><b>HAZY DAZE</b> returned to the enclosure with blood in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the gelding sustained an injury to both nostrils after making contact with the barrier prior to jumping and should not be declared a bleeder.</p> <p>When questioned on the run of <b>ZARTAN</b>, <b>H Tinsley</b> said the gelding raced greenly throughout.</p> <p><b>M Dee</b> the rider of the winner <b>HESTOLEMYROSES</b> was reminded of his obligations with regard to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>R Hannam</b> reported that <b>HAWKEYE CHIEF</b> did not handle the Heavy 10 track.</p>
