Race 1	VERO.CO.NZ 1300
	<p>IMPERIAL DUKE (L Innes) and EL BANDIDO (K Myers) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>EMPATHY (V Gatu) began awkwardly, shifting out.</p> <p>OUR MOLLY MALONE (B Hutton) had a tendency to over-race through the early stages.</p> <p>Passing the 350 metres SCARLET CHAPARRAL (M Sweeney) shifted wider on the track when improving, inconveniencing IMPERIAL DUKE which had a tendency to lay in.</p> <p>Near the 150 metres GETALONGHOME CINDY (L Magorrian) shifted out under pressure, inconveniencing EMPATHY. L Magorrian was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that he must take corrective action more readily.</p>
Race 2	BROWN PENNELL CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1200
	<p>The start of this race was delayed three minutes at the request of TAB Racing Control.</p> <p>RICH BILLIE MARSH (S Spratt) began awkwardly.</p> <p>MAGIC BELLE (L Innes) stumbled leaving the barrier, losing ground.</p> <p>RICH BILLIE MARSH raced keenly when leading.</p> <p>SEA MAJOR (M Sweeney) lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>RICH BILLIE MARSH shifted out passing the 50 metres, inconveniencing SEA MAJOR.</p>

Race 3	JUDEA TAVERN 1200
<p>BELLBIRD (L Innes) shifted in abruptly leaving the barrier, hampering SUGAR PLUM FAIRY (P Turner) which became unbalanced.</p> <p>QUICKASUCAN (K Myers) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Approaching the 150 metres HAYPIN (J Oliver) shifted out abruptly when struck with the whip.</p> <p>M Sweeney (FARM BOY), K Myers (QUICKASUCAN) and M Coleman (NEWS OF THE WORLD) all advised their respective mounts failed to handle the existing track conditions.</p>	
Race 4	GILMOURS TAURANGA 2100
<p>NOTHING TRIVIAL (M Coleman) was slow away.</p> <p>PHEROZARDO (B R Jones) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>A Jones (KING'S FORTUNE) and S Spratt (ONE O EIGHT) reported that their respective mounts had failed to handle the existing track conditions.</p> <p>Jockey M Coleman reported that NOTHING TRIVIAL had failed to see today's distance out in the existing track conditions.</p> <p>C Dell (THENAMESBOND) was reprimanded by Stewards and reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 5	HYNDS PIPE SYSTEMS 1400
<p>JOHN GRAY (M Sweeney) was slow to begin.</p> <p>HIGH ROLLER (B Hutton) had a tendency to lay in when making the bend near the 900 metres.</p>	
Race 6	BAYLEYS COUNTRY 1600
<p>PERFECT START (B R Jones) was slow to begin.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of PERFECT START rider B R Jones could offer no tangible explanation for the mare's performance. PERFECT START underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could not find any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 7	BETHLEHEM MOTOR INN 1400
<p>PEREGRINE (B Grylls) was briefly held up entering the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of PERMESSO rider L Innes could offer no excuses other than the mare may have found the existing track conditions too arduous in a fresh state. PERMESSO underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could not find any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 8	TAURANGA HARDWARE & PLUMBING 1400
<p>INIS ROSE (B R Jones) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>CALL THE SHOTS (B Hutton) and MAT DILLON (C Dell) came together when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>POLYATOMIC (L Innes) began awkwardly, shifting out, making contact with REEPERBAHN (A Forbes) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>Approaching the 1100 metres CAST KING (J Wong) shifted out and away from REEPERBAHN, hampering ISTIMAGIC (M Wenn). As a result SUPER THUNDER (B Grylls) which was following was inconvenienced.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres CALL THE SHOTS shifted out slightly, placing BAGSAGOLD (K Myers) in restricted room.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres NGATIRA GOLD (M Sweeney) shifted out under pressure, inconveniencing the weakening CALL THE SHOTS.</p> <p>MAT DILLON raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>J Wong (CAST KING) and K Myers (BAGSAGOLD) both advised that their respective mounts had been unsuited by the existing track conditions.</p> <p>SUPER THUNDER lost the off fore plate during the running.</p>
