RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HAWKE'S BAY EASTER 2YO MAIDEN
<p>CIDER (J Parkes) jumped inwards abruptly at the start and bumped OUR ROBERTO (R Hannam). CIDER then lost momentum when it dipped in the heavy going a short distance further. OUR ROBERTO raced greenly in the lead throughout. CIDER had to steady off heels when the pace eased passing the 800 metres and was inclined to lug inwards in the home straight. Rider J Parkes said the gelding was unsuited to the heavy going. Connections advised that CIDER would be spelled. EXQUISITE JEWEL (M DEE) made the 400 metre bend awkwardly. R Hutchings could offer no excuse for the disappointing run of BRACHETTO.</p>	
Race 2	COMCAT EASTER HANDICAP SPRINT
<p>WAIT A SEC (V Colgan) began awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly making contact with FRANKLY (R Hutchings) which</p>	

<p>was forced outwards onto KATE (S Collett). As a result FRANKLY and KATE lost ground. SHE'S SLINKY (D Bradley) over-raced in the early and middle stages. RED DAKOTA (B Lammas) raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider S Collett reported that her mount KATE was unsuited to the going which she described as puggy.</p>	
Race 3	TE WHANGAI ROMNEYS EASTER STAYERS
<p>At the request of the TAB Race 3 was delayed 3 minutes. COLT FORTY FIVE (T Russell) began awkwardly, making contact with ROSEHIP (C Grylls), and lost ground. DELICIANO (D Bradley) and I'LL'AVA'ALF (J Parkes) were slow away. J Shackleton rider of SAVAROSE was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground after she allowed her mount to shift inwards tightening SAN PEDRO (M Dee) and KING OF ROCK (S Collett) shortly after the start. CRISTAL HEIGHTS (V Colgan) raced three wide without cover around the first bend before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 2000 metres. KING PICCOLO (A Taylor) which was inclined to over-race then shifted outwards across the heels of CRISTAL HEIGHTS once crossed by that runner, forcing SAVAROSE three wide until SAVAROSE improved forward to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres. SAN PEDRO (M Dee) shifted outwards across the heels of KING PICCOLO near the 900 metres inconveniencing ROSEHIP which was forced over extra ground. HUARWEE (D Johnson) commenced to give ground rapidly near the 800 metres inconveniencing KING OF ROCK. HUARWEE was then pulled up and took no further part. Rider D Johnson considered something amiss. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality but the gelding may have possibly suffered a displaced soft palette. Trainer D Hayes advised that he would report to the stewards anything that should arise in the coming days. DELICIANO lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	PETER AND MARG HALES MILE
<p>J Shackleton replaced D Turner on DON'TLIKEMONDAY. DON'TLIKEMONDAY (J Shackleton) was slow away. NEW GREENFIELD (R Norvall) raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 5	DUNSTAN FEEDS AUTUMN SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER
<p>CHIPOTLE (B Murray) began awkwardly and lost ground. CASILLAS (C Grylls) ducked out abruptly near the 100 metres. When questioned into the disappointing performance of ELYSIUM rider S Collett reported that the mare was unsuited to the track conditions.</p>	
Race 6	THE NAPIER PARK SPRINT
<p>SHEZGORGEIOUS (D Bradley) and JACK'S POINT (V Johnston) both hit the front of the gates anticipating the start and after a veterinary inspection were cleared to start. SHEZGORGEIOUS (D Bradley) was slow away. EBULLIENT (S Collett) began awkwardly losing ground. Rider O Bosson (I AM SAM) dropped his whip near the 250 metres. When questioned into the disappointing run of ALLEYOOP rider J Parkes could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality. Trainer J Bridge reported that the mare would now be spelled. Rider V Colgan reported that ATOZED which finished last failed to handle the heavy track. A post-race veterinary examination of ATOZED failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 7	GO "IT'S A DUNDEEL" – HAWKE'S BAY HERO
<p>ACUTELYGOLD (M Cameron) shifted inwards leaving the barriers crowding PETONE PRINCE (V Colgan) onto CHESS KING (V Johnston). HESALLJAZZ (C Grylls) had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages shifting outwards near the 1100 metres to avoid the heels of DELILAH DELTORO (R Hutchings) hampering SIR DELAHOYA (O Bosson) and CHOPPER (M Dee).</p>	
Race 8	WINDSOR PARK HAWK'E BAY GOLD CUP
<p>INTRASIGENT (R Hannam) and SOU'EAST (D Hain) were slow away. JETSET LAD over-raced in the early and middle stages with rider O Bosson reporting that his saddle had shifted forward. Near the 2000 metres REVELATOR (V Johnston) shifted outwards abruptly across the heels of JETSET LAD hampering ABRAHAM LINCOLN (D Bradley) before being corrected by its rider. V Johnston was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground. When questioned into the run of SILVERDALE rider D Johnson was of the opinion that the gelding did not see the 2200 metres out on the testing track. When questioned into the run of NORTH OF SUNSET rider S Collett could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality. C Grylls rider of PACKING TYCOON stated the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.</p>	
Race 9	DESERT GOLD CLUB EASTER MILE
<p>B Lammas replaced D Turner on FIELD DAZE</p>	

ZEDETTA (R Norvall) and **PANNO ROSSA** (D Johnson) were tightened at the start when **TAIPA TIGER** (D Bradley) began awkwardly.

ELLIE'O (T Russell) was slow away.

MAHORA GOLD (K Smith) had to be steadied shortly after entering the home straight when **DON'STOPGIRL** (R Hannam) and **FIELD DAZE** (B Lammas) shifted out.

When questioned into the disappointing run of **SAVANITE** rider V Colgan said the filly was unsuited to the going.
