## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>FRUITFED SUPPLIES IRRIGATION SYSTEMS MAIDEN HURDLE (2500 metres)</b>
<p><b>WILBUR</b> jumped outwards at the first fence hampering <b>TIZZA SECRET</b>.  <b>RED ON BLACK</b> and <b>REGAL SECRET</b> put in poor jumps at the first fence.  <b>MUTT WILLIAMS</b> landed awkwardly at the fence near the 600 metres.  <b>RED ON BLACK</b> raced wide throughout.  <b>VENERATE</b> misjudged the last fence.  Rider M Gillies considered something amiss with <b>REGAL SECRET</b>, which finished well back. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>FRUITFED SUPPLIES TECHNICAL SERVICES HURDLE (2500 metres)</b>
<b>KING OF ROCK</b> was slow away.	

**BRER** ran down his fences throughout.

**BRER** put in a poor jump at the fence near the 600 metres dictating **HOUNDSCRY** outwards over extra ground.

Shortly after jumping the fence near the 600 metres, **KING OF ROCK** was steadied when racing in restricted room between **INDIKATOR** and **PLATINUM CHOICE**.

**PLATINUM CHOICE** had to be steadied near the 500 metres when crowded for room between **INDIKATOR** and **ARMADIO ESTRADA**.

**INDIKATOR** was held up rounding the final turn.

**KING OF ROCK** had difficulty finding clear running early in the final straight.

**HOUNDSCRY** put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.

**COLT FORTY FIVE** jumped indifferently at the rear throughout.

**ARMADIO ESTRADA** pulled up sore following the race. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a significant tendon injury to the left foreleg.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PGG WRIGHTSON MAIDEN SPRING (1200 metres)</b>

**OCEAN PARADE** began awkwardly, losing ground.

**LABILL** and **BE YOURSELF** began awkwardly and came together leaving the barriers.

**KAYLEEN** was slow away.

**LINCOLN'S LEGACY** raced three wide without cover throughout.

**GOLAN EXPRESS** was held up near the 250 metres.

R Hannam, the rider of **BE YOURSELF** was issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift outwards near the 200 metres hampering **OCEAN PARADE**. Contributing to the incident was inward movement from **LUCKY TO BE COOL** which lay in, having to be corrected by its rider.

Rounding the final turn, passing the 400 metres **OCEAN PARADE** (M Ulucinar) shifted outwards forcing **LUCKY TO BE COOL** wider on the track, into the line of **PELLETIER** which was hampered. M Ulucinar was issued with a warning.

**OCEAN PARADE** again shifted out near the 300 metres making contact with **LUCKY TO BE COOL**.

**FAALTLINE** was held up over the concluding stages.

**KAYLEEN** was hampered near the 250 metres when **AETERNUM** lay in under pressure and over the final stages **KAYLEEN** was unable to obtain clear running.

**LA BECANE** (J Parkes), when being ridden with vigour near the finish, shifted inwards abruptly and tightened **KARENZA** (B Grylls), which had to be steadied. **LA BECANE** when being corrected, shifted outwards into the line of **AETERNUM** (L Callaway), resulting in that runner clipping the heels of **LA BECANE** and falling after the line. **FAALTLINE** (D Walker) which was following was unable to avoid the fallen runner and was brought down. Both riders, L Callaway and D Walker, respectively, were uninjured.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections of the third placed **KARENZA** viewed footage of the finish, but elected not to proceed with an objection against the winner, **LA BECANE**.

A subsequent veterinary examination of **AETERNUM** failed to reveal any abnormality while **FAALTLINE** suffered superficial abrasions.

When questioned regarding the performance of **PELLETIER**, rider R Hutchings said his mount got back initially from its wide draw and finished the race off fairly after having to make its run wide.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>AGRONICA STEEPLECHASE (4000 metres)</b>

**PALERMO** misjudged the first of the double on the first occasion and landed awkwardly.

**MISTER DEEJAY** put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres on the first occasion, inconveniencing **MR ALIGN**.

**MR MOR** shifted out prior to jumping the fence near the 1400 metres and tightened **AND THATZ SCOTTY**.

**SMOKE** lost ground at the fence near the 1000 metres.

**AND THATZ SCOTTY** was retired from the race prior to the last fence when well beaten.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>FRUITFED SUPPLIES CUSTOMER SERVICES MAIDEN SPRING (1400 metres)</b>

A Taylor was unable to attend the meeting due to illness and was replaced on **AZRAF** by S Collett. A Taylor was advised that a medical clearance is required.

**NATIONAL PRIDE** and **CAPER CALEB** both began awkwardly.

**MISS MAKA** raced three wide without cover throughout.

**AZRAF** over-raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

**CAPER CALEB** raced in restricted room over the final 150 metres, having to be steadied near the 75 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **DE RUSSIAN QUEEN**, rider J Parkes advised that the filly had raced greenly in its race-day debut.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>FRUITFED SUPPLIES STAYERS HANDICAP (2200 metres)</b>

**MENDOZA** became fractious and flipped over in the back parade ring and following a subsequent veterinary inspection was declared a late scratching at 1.51pm.

**PILLAR TO POST** began awkwardly.

**PILLAR TO POST** was steadied to avoid the heels of **SONNY BEN** (S MacNab), which shifted in near the 1400 metres. S MacNab was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

**SAIL AWAY** and **SINGLE GIRL** both raced wide without cover throughout.

**DUMINY** was held up near the 300 metres having to change ground inward to improve.

**Race 7** | **ROOTS, SHOOTS AND FRUITS SPRINT (1400 metres)**

**ENDEAVOUR** reared immediately prior to the start, dislodging rider B Lammas who was uninjured. Starter, G Phillips was advised that when in similar circumstances in future he is expected to have the runner removed from the barriers and veterinary inspected. Following the event stewards ordered a veterinary examination of **ENDEAVOUR** which did not reveal any abnormality.

Immediately after the start **KINGIESSTAR** was tightened and lost ground when runners either side shifted ground.

**ENDEAVOUR** had to steady near the 1100 metres when **ROSE AND CROWN** (R Hannam) shifted in. R Hannam was advised to exercise care.

**THIEN LY** had to steady for some distance passing the 1000 metres when in restricted room.

**PICKPOCKET** had to steady off heels when the pace eased approaching the 600 metres, which resulted in **PICKPOCKET**

shifting out dictating **RULE THE COURT** which was improving to its outside, outwards into the line of **FREELINKS** and

**DIMITRIOS**, which were both hampered. **TAKEMEHOMEBABE** also had to avoid heels near the 600 metres and shifted out taking **ENDEAVOUR** over a little extra ground.

**ZEDENUF** was held up rounding the turn.

**THIEN LY** was held up early in the home straight prior to obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.

**KINGIESSTAR** raced in restricted room early in the home straight.

**Race 8** | **AGRONICA HANDICAP MILE (1600 metres)**

**LORD OF THE STARS** was slow away.

**SHOW NO EMOTION** jumped inwards at the start, further hampering **IN FOR FUN**, which had begun a little awkwardly.

**HOOPSAIN BOLT** had to be steadied going into the first turn near the 1400 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **SHOW NO EMOTION**. **HOOPSAIN BOLT** then got its head up and raced ungenerously for a distance.

**SHOW NO EMOTION** had a tendency to over-race when being restrained in the middle stages.

**SHOW NO EMOTION** shifted out to obtain clear running rounding the final turn near the 350 metres, taking **LEVI** and **HESALLJAZZ** wider on the track.

**Race 9** | **BALLANCE AGRI-NUTRIENTS LTD MAIDEN STAYERS (2100 metres)**

**KACHINA** began awkwardly.

**COOL HAND DUKE** raced in restricted room to the inside of **POWERADE** near the 1900 metres. **COOL HAND DUKE** was then inclined to over-race when being restrained.

**POWERADE** also commenced to over-race, getting its head up and shifting outwards across the heels of **DON GALLARDO** leaving the straight on the first occasion.

**POWERADE** continued to over-race having to be firmly restrained off the heels of **DON GALLARDO** at the 1400 metres.

**BOOSTING ELEANOR** race wide without cover around the first bend.

**SPARE CHANGE** raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

When questioned, R Hutchings (**ST RHYTYM**) and B Lammas (**SPARE CHANGE**) were unable to offer any excuses for the poor performances of their respective rides.

**Race 10** | **DOW AGROSCIENCES MILE FINALE (1600 metres)**

**GIRL WITH A PEARL** began awkwardly and was slow away.

**EDGE OF GLORY** raced three wide without cover throughout.

**KOORRABYE** was held up for some distance passing the 200 metres prior to gaining clear running near the 100 metres.
