## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>RD1 HAWERA INL MDN (2100m)</b>
<p>The track was downgraded by the Stewards to heavy 10 prior to race one, following showers.</p> <p><b>SINGAPORE GIRL</b> was crowded leaving the barrier and settled back.</p> <p><b>PHONE GIRL</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BLACK ZAMBUKA</b> raced wide without cover in the early stages so was taken forward to lead near the 1400 metres.</p> <p><b>SINGAPORE GIRL</b> lay in over the early stages of the home straight and had to be straightened.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of <b>PHONE GIRL</b> rider R Hutchings was of the opinion that the filly may have been unsuited to the step up to 2100 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of <b>MY MAGICIAN</b> rider R Hannam was of the opinion the mare was unsuited to the heavy track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ELTHAM VETS/AGRIFEEDS (1600m)</b>
<p><b>SECRET WHISPER</b> jumped away awkwardly and placed <b>KATIE MCKEEN</b> in restricted room momentarily.</p> <p><b>KATIE MCKEEN</b> dipped and had to be steadied when crossing the junction near the 1350 metres.</p>	

<p><b>SHOW THE BEEL</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>HEART OF DARKNESS</b> lay inwards under pressure near the 400 metres and hampered the weakening <b>KOHI ROAD</b>.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of <b>SECRET WHISPER</b> rider M Cameron could offer no tangible excuse.</p>	
Race 3	<b>RD1 HAWERA NUFARM 3YO MDN (1600m)</b>
<p><b>NEAT BELT</b> shifted in leaving the barrier hampering <b>NITRO TED</b> which was forced inwards into the line of <b>SALLYMONT JEU</b> which was hampered and lost ground.</p> <p><b>MISCHIEVOUS MIS</b> raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>I'M CHARLIE</b> (D Turner) was crowded passing 1000 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of <b>NEAT BELT</b> (R Hutchings) which shifted in marginally. Rider R Hutchings was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p><b>ZIMMZEE</b> ran off when leading passing the 800 metres, hampering <b>NITRO TED</b> and <b>HIGH LIKELY</b> which were forced over extra ground. Trainer K Zimmerman was advised that <b>ZIMMZEE</b> must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to next racing.</p> <p>Rider M Cameron reported to the Stewards that his mount <b>HIGHLY LIKELY</b> may benefit with the addition of blinkers.</p>	
Race 4	<b>RD1 HAWERA BALANCE MDN (1600m)</b>
<p><b>LADY JESSICA</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SMUGGLERS COVE</b> (R Hutchings) shifted out in search of clear racing room passing the 300 metres and in doing so hampered <b>KEY WEST</b> which lay inwards. Rider R Hutchings was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>CAVATINO</b> shifted out entering the home straight in search of better going.</p>	
Race 5	<b>RD1 HAWERA INGHAMS MDN (1200m)</b>
<p><b>AWESOME DIVA</b> and <b>MIHAIA</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>ROULETT</b> jumped inwards at the start and when being corrected shifted into the line of <b>CASSIE ANNE</b> which clipped that runners heel and blundered.</p> <p><b>WORZELL GUMMIDGE</b> raced ungenerously in the early stages and near the 1100 metres shifted in and away from <b>LITTLE DREAMER</b> resulting in <b>CALL ME HOLLY</b>, which was racing to its inside being tightened and losing its position. <b>WORZELL GUMMIDGE</b> then continued to over race.</p> <p><b>NIPPA MARY</b> made the final corner awkwardly.</p>	
Race 6	<b>RD1 HOLDEM CONTRACTING LTD MDN (1200m)</b>
<p><b>ZAFRENZY</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MER NOIRE</b> shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier inconveniencing <b>BRECON BELLE</b>. A short distance further <b>MER NOIRE</b> was hampered when <b>FASHION LASS</b> hung out into its line.</p> <p><b>ZAFRENZY</b> raced ungenerously over the early stages.</p> <p><b>MY MUSTANG MOLLY</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages and near the 900 metres when being restrained, was inclined to get its head up.</p> <p><b>MY MUSTANG MOLLY</b> hung outwards in the final straight and near the 200 metres inconvenienced <b>DYSNOMIA</b> which lay in simultaneously.</p>	
Race 7	<b>RD1 HAWERA AGRISEEDS/PIONEER (1400m)</b>
<p><b>BINGO</b>(at 1.45 pm) and <b>HEIGH UP KEEP</b> (at 2.45 pm) were late scratching's due to change in track conditions.</p> <p><b>CLAPATHUNDA</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>GOOD RISK</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ANNIETIZ</b> shifted out under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of <b>POWER TRIP</b> rider D Turner advised that the gelding may benefit with a step up to 1600 metres.</p> <p>Rider K Chiong reported that her mount <b>NORMAN</b> had hung throughout.</p>	
Race 8	<b>RD1 HAWERA ECOLAB (2100m)</b>

**ADRIENNE** was slow away.

**JENNY'S OKAY** raced ungenerously in the home straight on the first occasion.

**MALACHY LAD** hung in when making the bend near the 800 metres.

**JACKABEAN** hung out in the home straight.

When questioned into the improved performance of BEAU ZED trainer P Keegan was of the opinion the gelding was suited to todays track conditions.
