RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 RD1 HAWERA INL MDN (2100m)

The track was downgraded by the Stewards to heavy 10 prior to race one, following showers.

SINGAPORE GIRL was crowded leaving the barrier and settled back.

PHONE GIRL was slow to begin.

BLACK ZAMBUKA raced wide without cover in the early stages so was taken forward to lead near the 1400 metres.

SINGAPORE GIRL lay in over the early stages of the home straight and had to be straightened.

When questioned into the performance of **PHONE GIRL** rider R Hutchings was of the opinion that the filly may have been unsuited to the step up to 2100 metres.

When questioned into the performance of **MY MAGICIAN** rider R Hannam was of the opinion the mare was unsuited to the heavy track conditions.

Race 2 ELTHAM VETS/AGRIFEEDS (1600m)

SECRET WHISPER jumped away awkwardly and placed **KATIE MCKEEN** in restricted room momentarily. **KATIE MCKEEN** dipped and had to be steadied when crossing the junction near the 1350 metres.

SHOW THE BEEL raced wide without cover throughout.

HEART OF DARKNESS lay inwards under pressure near the 400 metres and hampered the weakening **KOHI ROAD**.

When questioned into the performance of **SECRET WHISPER** rider M Cameron could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 3 RD1 HAWERA NUFARM 3YO MDN (1600m)

NEAT BELT shifted in leaving the barrier hampering **NITRO TED** which was forced inwards into the line of **SALLYMONT JEU** which was hampered and lost ground.

MISCHIEVOUS MIS raced keenly in the early stages.

I'M CHARLIE (D Turner) was crowded passing 1000 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of **NEAT BELT** (R Hutchings) which shifted in marginally. Rider R Hutchings was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

ZIMMZEE ran off when leading passing the 800 metres, hampering **NITRO TED** and **HIGH LIKELY** which were forced over extra ground. Trainer K Zimmerman was advised that **ZIMMZEE** must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to next racing.

Rider M Cameron reported to the Stewards that his mount **HIGHLY LIKELY** may benefit with the addition of blinkers.

Race 4 RD1 HAWERA BALANCE MDN (1600m)

LADY JESSICA raced wide without cover throughout.

SMUGGLERS COVE (R Hutchings) shifted out in search of clear racing room passing the 300 metres and in doing so hampered **KEY WEST** which lay inwards. Rider R Hutchings was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

CAVATINO shifted out entering the home straight in search of better going.

Race 5 RD1 HAWERA INGHAMS MDN (1200m)

AWESOME DIVA and MIHAIA began awkwardly.

ROULETT jumped inwards at the start and when being corrected shifted into the line of **CASSIE ANNE** which clipped that runners heel and blundered.

WORZELL GUMMIDGE raced ungenerously in the early stages and near the 1100 metres shifted in and away from **LITTLE DREAMER** resulting in **CALL ME HOLLY**, which was racing to its inside being tightened and losing its position. **WORZELL GUMMIDGE** then continued to over race.

NIPPA MARY made the final corner awkwardly.

Race 6 RD1 HOLDEM CONTRACTING LTD MDN (1200m)

ZAFRENZY began awkwardly.

MER NOIRE shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier inconveniencing **BRECON BELLE.** A short distance further **MER NOIRE** was hampered when **FASHION LASS** hung out into its line.

ZAFRENZY raced ungenerously over the early stages.

MY MUSTANG MOLLY raced keenly in the early and middle stages and near the 900 metres when being restrained, was inclined to get its head up.

MY MUSTANG MOLLY hung outwards in the final straight and near the 200 metres inconvenienced DYSNOMIA which lay in simultaneously.

Race 7 RD1 HAWERA AGRISEEDS/PIONEER (1400m)

BINGO(at 1.45 pm) and **HEIGH UP KEEP** (at 2.45 pm) were late scratching's due to change in track conditions.

CLAPATHUNDA began awkwardly.

GOOD RISK was slow to begin.

ANNIETIZ shifted out under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned into the performance of **POWER TRIP** rider D Turner advised that the gelding may benefit with a step up to 1600 metres.

Rider K Chiong reported that her mount **NORMAN** had hung throughout.

Race 8 RD1 HAWERA ECOLAB (2100m)

ADRIENNE was slow away.

JENNY'S OKAY raced ungenerously in the home straight on the first occasion.

MALACHY LAD hung in when making the bend near the 800 metres.

JACKABEAN hung out in the home straight.

When questioned into the improved performance of BEAU ZED trainer P Keegan was of the opinion the gelding was suited to todays track conditions.
