RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 KEITH CAREW COMMEMORATION MAIDEN

BREAKING PROTOKOL (R Stam) began awkwardly and lost ground.

DANCED ALL NIGHT (D Turner) raced wide in the early stages.

NO QUOTA(J Riddell) raced three-wide without cover in the early and middle stages prior to obtaining cover near the 1200 metres.

THIEVING SISTERS (T Russell) had to steady when on heels near the 1000 metres.

HAZY DAZE (H Tinsley) raced wide from the 1000 metres.

AZRAF (D Walker) hung in badly over the final 300 metres having to be straightened several times.

The connections of **BREAKING PROTOKOL (R Stam)** which failed to maintain contact and tailed off were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding with regard to its competitiveness. Trainer D Parry advised that BREAKING PROTOKOL would no longer be persevered with as a racing proposition from her stable.

A post-race veterinary examination of **POWERADE (J Parkes)** which was under pressure near the 800 metres failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 2 WORLD TRAVELLERS & AARON BIDLAKE RACING MAIDEN SPRINT

NGAWAKA (J Riddell) began awkwardly and lost ground.

KAYLEEN (A Taylor) was slow to begin.

LITTLE DRUMMER BOY (D Bradley) shifted in shortly after leaving the barriers dictating PELLETIER (H Tinsley) in onto

GOLDYSOX (S Doyle) which became unbalanced and lost ground. D Bradley was issued with a warning.

LITTLE DRUMMER BOY continued to race greenly in the early stages.

LINCOLN'S EXPRESS (B Lammas) raced three-wide without cover throughout.

PELLETIER raced wide from the 800 metres.

NGAWAKA was held up near the 500 metres and when attempting to improve, had its momentum interrupted after

KAYLEEN rolled in tightening NGAWAKA. Apprentice A Taylor was issued with a warning.

Race 3 TOWER GATES 3YO MAIDEN

STONEMASON (D Bradley) was slow to begin.

BLACK BELT (D Turner) raced greenly throughout and had to steady off the heels of **TIE ME DOWN** going into the first turn.

CAROUSEL (Te Baker) raced four-wide throughout.

J Parkes the rider of LE MANS was advised to exercise care after he allowed his mount to shift in at the first turn causing

CLASSIC DRAGON (V Johnston) to steady.

CLASSIC DRAGON raced keenly throughout.

TIE ME DOWN (M Dravitzki) hung out rounding the turn and throughout the home straight.

Race 4 AGPACK RD1 MAIDEN SPRINT

DIAMOND CUT which was kicked in the parade ring underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier and was cleared to start.

GOLAN EXPRESS had a warning placed on its barrier manners after proving difficult to load and delaying the start.

VALOIS (Te Baker) was slow to begin.

DIAMOND CUT (B Lammas) raced wide without cover throughout.

WERRIBEE (J Riddell) was held up briefly near the 250 metres.

DANNY BOY (M Hudson) had some difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn and then raced greenly over the final 150 metres.

M Hudson (DANNY BOY) was uninjured after being dislodged on pulling up.

When questioned regarding the performance of KARENZA, J Parkes could offer no excuse.

Race 5 NUFARM SPRINT

SIR KINGSWOOD (B Murray) and WHOOPIE GEE (C Anderson) were slow to begin.

KALGOORLIE BOMBER (A Morgan) was outpaced in the early stages and lost contact.

SIR KINGSWOOD had to steady when in restricted room near the 700 metres.

Race 6 WRC 150TH JUBILEE MAIDEN MILE

GLORIANO dislodged rider **V Johnston** behind the barrier who was uninjured.

GLORIANO jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

MOUNTBATTEN (D Walker), ANUTHA HULA (A Morgan) and INAZUMA (M Dravitzki) were all slow away.

SHRILEY'S SECRET (D Bradley) raced wide without cover throughout.

CAN COUP (H Tinsley) raced four-wide without cover from the 800 metres.

INAZUMA was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

SHIRLEY'S SECRET lay in passing the 250 metres and had to be straightened.

When questioned regarding the performance of **REYKJAVIK**, **J Riddell** could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary examination of **REYKJAVIK** failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 7 AGRISEEDS MILE

BAZINGER (A Taylor) was slow to begin and then raced greenly for a short distance.

SPIKE MILLIGAN (J Shackleton) raced wide without cover throughout.

BAZINGER raced wide with without cover from the 1000 metres.

KOORRABYE (M Dravitzki) was held up briefly near the 500 metres.

Both MISS ENDERS (J Parkes) and TAIPA TIGER (D Bradley) shifted ground under pressure over the final stages.

J Shackleton (SPIKE MILLIGAN) was reprimanded and reminded of her obligation to ride her mount out fully to the finish after she relaxed her ride over the final few strides narrowly holding third position.

Race 8 G V ELECTRICAL STAYERS HANDICAP

PARTY GIRL was a late scratching at the barrier at 4.05pm on veterinary advice after becoming cast in the barrier. Trainer D

Haworth was advised that the mare must trial before next starting.

PRINCESS SAYYIDA (J Parkes) proved reluctant to enter the barrier stalls.

MISS CLAWDY (N Teeluck) lay in shortly after jumping crowding KICK BACK (S Wynne) which got back.

CHRYSOLITE (V Johnston) and JUST ISHI (B Murray) were slow to begin.

CHRYSOLITE over-raced in the early and middle stages of the race.

THE BACHELOR (J Shackleton) was hampered on the turn when racing in restricted room between MISS CLAWDY which was laying out and SAN PEDRO (R Hannam)

MISS CLAWDY lay out rounding the final turn.

THE BACHELOR lay in down the final straight.

JUST ISHI lay in near the 150 metres and again near the 70 metres having to be straightened on both occasions. Rider **A Taylor** reported that her mount **NOVA SCOTIA** was sore on pulling up after dipping near the straight entrance. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance will be required before **NOVA SCOTIA** next races.
