RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ASCOT BLOODSTOCK MDN HWT (1600m)

POTTER was tightened at the start and was slow away.

BRONNTANAS began awkwardly from its outside draw.

IDAHOS CHOICE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

AND THATZ SCOTTY raced wide throughout without cover.

BRONNTANAS raced wide throughout.

IDAHO'S CHOICE was checked when attempting a narrow run to the inside of **CANTHASSLEME** approaching the home bend and was further held up for some distance in the home straight, gaining a run near the 150 metres when **CANTHASSLEME** rolled out under pressure.

STANLEY was held up near the 100 metres prior to being angled outwards into clear running.

N Quinn the rider of **BRONNTANAS** was spoken to advisedly about his whip on a horse out of contention and issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b).

Race 2 STEELFAB LTD MDN HWT (2000m)

BAHRELLA began awkwardly and got back at the start.

SPORTAVIAN was tightened at the start and got back.

LUCKY EYES was caught wide throughout.

SOMETIME LUCKY raced three wide without cover for the majority.

Race 3 WAIKATO STUD OPUNAKE CUP JULY 19TH (2000m)

STORMIN NORMAN began awkwardly and settled back.

Race 4 REGAL LODGE (1600m)

REDEMPTION jumped outwards abruptly and tightened **MALACHY LAD**, **GOOD RISK**, **JACKSUN** and **I SUGGEST** which was bumped sideways.

ARZAK began very awkwardly and lent on the side of its gate when the start was made losing several lengths.

ARZAK then raced wide throughout.

TORRADO raced wide throughout.

The saddle slipped forward on **JACKSUN** in the run along the back straight.

Race 5 REVITAL FERTILISERS (1400m)

GUSTAVO reared in the barrier prior to the start dislodging rider M Cameron who was uninjured. **GUSTAVO** was extracted from its gate and following a veterinary inspection was cleared to start.

LUMIERE BLUE shifted out abruptly at the start dictating GUSTAVO outwards which subsequently bumped with RAISEDINASANDPIT resulting in GUSTAVO getting back. LUMIERE BLUE when being corrected shifted in tightening ITSALRIGHT and THE BOUNCER which got back.

NORMAN raced wide without cover throughout.

CEE TEE ARE was momentarily held up near the 200 metres and when being angled into clear running bumped with **NORMAN.**

GUSTAVO was held up for a short distance near the 200 metres prior to gaining clear running.

Race 6 ALLAN SHARROCK RACING STABLES / I DO F&M MAIDEN (1200m)

MISS MOORE was slow away.

FASHION LASS tended to over race in the back straight.

HI FIVER raced wide throughout.

MY MUSTANG MOLLY raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

When questioned into the run of **ALICORN** rider R Hutchings said the filly raced greenly throughout and was not suited to the track conditions.

Race 7 SPEIGHT'S PUNTERS COMP JULY 19TH (1200m)

COOL MOON jumped outwards abruptly bumping **BEGUILING** which got back.

ASTANA was slow to begin.

KING NERO raced in restricted room and could not be ridden to full advantage over the final stages.
