RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JO MCGARTLAND MEMORIAL OPEN HURDLE (3000m)
<p>JAMIE LEE and ONE FOR THE MONEY began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>HARRY HILL made a poor leap at the first hurdle losing momentum and jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p>NEEDASTAR raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>NEEDASTAR and SUPERCHARGED made heavy contact with the fence near the 1900 metres.</p> <p>NEEDASTAR made a poor leap at the fence near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>DANISH RULER and NEEDASTAR both made poor jumps at the fence by the 1000 metres.</p> <p>NEEDASTAR made a faulty leap near the 600 metres, giving ground from that point on, and again made a faulty leap at the last fence almost dislodging rider M Gillies.</p> <p>ONE FOR THE MONEY made a poor leap at the last fence.</p> <p>When questioned regarding his riding tactics over the early stages, M Gillies advised that NEEDASTAR raced keenly when challenged passing the 2400 metres and only settled near the 1400 metres. He added that the presence of SUPERCHARGED resulted in NEEDASTAR not settling despite his efforts. Stewards reprimanded M Gillies, reminded him of his obligations and instructed him that a rider of his experience would be expected to exercise better judgment in future.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the riding tactics adopted on SUPERCHARGED over the early stages, K Hillis advised he was instructed to lead and was comfortable sitting outside NEEDASTAR in the running, however he was unaware of how far in front the first two horses were. Taking into consideration this being his first race day ride over hurdles, Stewards reprimanded K Hillis, reminded him of his obligations and instructed him to show better judgment in future.</p>	

A Kuru admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) for excessive use of the whip and was fined \$200 by the JCA.
A post race veterinary examination of **NEEDASTAR** revealed a slow recovery rate.

Race 2 | **D'CASH DASH RATING 75 (1200m)**

Shortly after the start **FRAGRANT** was tightened between runners and lost ground.
HALO BUSTER raced keenly through the early stages.
DAVONE CODE raced wide throughout.

Race 3 | **CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSN SPRINT R65 (1200m)**

LATIN SAINT shifted out on jumping forcing **CHEEKY TART** and **MAHBEER** wider.
MARY BURKE was hampered when bumped by **MAHBEER** which shifted outwards shortly after jumping.
Shortly after the start **SHES ALL CLASS** shifted away from inside runners making contact with **SOMETHINGS BURNING**, resulting in **WANNABEAWALLABETOO** being forced across heels and losing ground as a result.
SHES ALL CLASS raced wide throughout.
Passing the 400 metres **MARY BURKE** became awkwardly placed on heels and had to steady when **SAND'IOR** was shifted wider by **MAHBEER**. Rider **L McKay** (**MAHBEER**) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).
Passing the 300 metres **SHES ALL CLASS** which was tiring shifted in making contact with **SAND'IOR** which became awkwardly placed on the heels of **MAHBEER** which was shifting outwards. Rider **L McKay** was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 4 | **PORT FM F&M MAIDEN (1200m)**

KEEPITASECRET began awkwardly and got back.
GILD THE LILY began awkwardly.
KASUNDI knuckled on jumping and shifted out making firm contact with **SUPER TROUPER**.
ISHIACOURT raced wide throughout, shifting wider rounding the final bend.
In the straight **SPIDER LILY** lay inwards having to be straightened on a number of occasions, and proved difficult to ride.

Race 5 | **EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES OPEN STEEPLES (4280m)**

HIGH FORTY raced keenly early and jumped indifferently over the early stages.
JAYJAY made a poor leap at the fence by the 3000 metres.
POWER PACK jumped slowly during the first round.
JAYJAY ran the fence down near the 2200 metres.
JAYJAY made a poor leap at the last fence, landing awkwardly and dislodging rider **M Cropp** who was uninjured.

Race 6 | **POINT LUMBER RATING 65 HANDICAP (1600m)**

HUGHES THAT GIRL which was fractious behind the barriers, losing its footing and dislodging rider **C Barnes**, underwent a pre race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race. **C Barnes** was uninjured in this incident.
BELT UP raced keenly with its head up for some distance in the early and middle stages.
SMUCKERS raced wide throughout.
Passing the 700 metres **HAILES ABBEY** blundered and lost momentum.

Race 7 | **SPEIGHT'S STAYERS RATING 75 (2100m)**

COMMANDER CODY and **GEE GEE GIRL** were hampered between runners as the start was effected.
COMMANDER CODY raced keenly for a short distance thereafter.
BRAEHILL was held up for a short distance having to steady off heels rounding the bend.
Apprentice R Black admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 200 metres, and was fined \$200 by the JCA.
