<p>AZRAF began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>DUSAUTOIR began awkwardly shifting out crowding MY AVATAR on to the hind quarters of ITSALLBELT.</p> <p>PRINCE EDEN over raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>LIGHT HANDED raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SINGAPORE GIRL was over racing in the home straight on the first occasion.</p> <p>ITSALLBELT was inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened.</p> <p>J Parkes (ITSALLBELT) was warned with regard to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 2	MOLLER JOHNSON LTD 2YO
<p>DELUXE EDITION and HIGHWAY were slow to begin.</p>	

SHOTGUN VIC began awkwardly shifting out bumping IFFITEL . Passing the 1100 metres HIGHWAY when racing greenly lay in onto the heels of MATAKANA having to be firmly restrained.	
Race 3	CLASS HARVEST CENTRE MDN
ENCOSTOW and ZEDENUF were both slow to begin. OMA ELLE began awkwardly shifting in. ALICORN and BISHOPBRIGGS came together on jumping away. MR EXCLUSIVE raced three wide without cover throughout. The rider of ENCOSTOW J Parkes reported that after being slow away the gelding was unable to make any discernable ground in the home straight as it was unsuited to the puggy ground. Trainer F Auret reported ENCOSTOW would be spelled.	
Race 4	SANDFORDS RURAL CARRIERS 1200M
REACHFORTHESTARS was slow to begin. GOLD MOET was slow to begin and then raced ungenerously in the early stages. MR INK lay out under pressure in the final straight. Trainer K Grey was fined \$50 after FASHION GURU was presented without its notifiable gear (blinkers).	
Race 5	PGG WRIGHTSON HAWERA MDN 3YO
IT'S A WONDER and GESEMI were both slow to begin. IT'S A WONDER over raced when being restrained off heels near the 1000 metres and then was held up rounding the turn having to shift wide on the track into clear running in the home straight. V Ravikumar (HI SWIFT PRINCESS) was fined the sum of \$100 for unnecessary use of the whip on a horse out of contention. GESEMI after being slow away was under a hard ride from near the 1000 metres and failed to make up any ground despite the riders urgings. Rider J Parkes said GESEMI was unsuited to the slow 9 track.	
Race 6	SUPER LIQUOR 1600
POWER TRIP underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the start and was passed fit to race. GOOD RISK was slow to begin. GOOD RISK lay out under pressure in the final straight. When questioned into the run of CARBIDE rider M Cameron said the gelding hung throughout and could offer no tangible excuse for the horse's performance.
