## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>ELTHAM VETERINARY SERVICES 2000 M</b>
<p><b>HOLD THE DREAM</b> and <b>SINGAPORE GIRL</b> were slow away.          Passing the 600 metres <b>REYKJAVIK</b> had to be steadied and angled inwards to avoid the tiring <b>ST'RUTH</b>.  <b>SINGAPORE GIRL</b> shifted out under pressure over the final stages.          When questioned regarding the performance of <b>ST'RUTH</b> rider D Johnson reported that the mare was quickly under pressure near the 600 metres and failed to respond. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>AGRIFEEDS 1200 M</b>
<p><b>SIGNORINA</b> (R Hannam) and <b>SILVER BUBBLES</b> (R Myers) both began awkwardly hampering <b>BLACK IZIAH</b> (S Doyle) and <b>NIPPA MARY</b> (A Morgan) which was worst affected, losing ground.  <b>SILVER BUBBLES</b> raced three wide until near the 600 metres.  <b>SIGNORINA</b> raced wide throughout.  <b>GYPSY FAIR</b> was held up for a short distance prior to entering the home straight.  <b>KARENZA</b> (N Teeluck) shifted out under pressure near the 250 metres hampering <b>BLACK IZIAH</b> which was improving to its outside. Apprentice <b>Jockey Teeluck</b> was advised to exercise more care in future when in similar circumstances.  <b>R Hannam</b> (<b>SIGNORINA</b>) was reminded of his obligation to ride his mount out fully to the finish after he was observed to relax his ride over the concluding stages.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>ANDREW HAY 1200 M</b>

**DYSNOMIA** (D Johnson) shifted away on jumping away inconveniencing **HI FIVER** (R Myers).  
**FINKBIG** (R Hannam) shifted out shortly after jumping away dictating **TIHI KEEP A** (K Chiong) out on to **I'M YOUR MAN** (S Doyle) which was hampered losing ground.  
**JAX** (B Murray) was slow on jumping away.  
**HI FIVER** raced greenly in the back straight and near the 1000 metres shifted in and away from **JAX** which was racing to its outside and in doing so made contact with the hind quarters of **DYSNOMIA**.  
**TIHI KEEP A** raced keenly when three wide throughout.

**Race 4** | **FIELD TORQUE 1200 M**

**CASSIE ANNE** (R Myers) was slow away (3 L).  
**HOSTAGE** (R Hutchings) began awkwardly shifting out dictating **POROTENE CHANCE** which made contact with **GOLD MOET** (J Shackleton). **GOLD MOET** (J Shackleton) was then further hampered when **RIVER HEAD** (K Chiong) was taken in by **I AM LEO** (K Smith). K Smith was issued with a warning to exercise more care when shifting ground.  
**THE BOUNCER** (H Tinsley) raced wide without cover throughout.  
**RIVER HEAD** (J Shackleton) over raced through the early stages.  
**A Jones** (**POROTENE CHANCE**) dropped her whip near the 600 metres.

**Race 5** | **NEW COMMERCIAL HOTEL / TUI BREWERY 1480 M**

**PENCURI** shifted out shortly after jumping away making contact with **COOL MOON** (A Jones) forcing that runner out on to **DUFFER'S CREEK** (M Dee) with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.  
**COOL MOON** (A Jones) over raced in the early and middle stages having to be firmly restrained off the heels of **KING NERO** (V Johnston) which shifted out near the 800 metres.  
**COOL MOON** again had to be steadied off the heels of **KING NERO** approaching the 600 metres.  
Apprentice Jockey **Te Baker** (**GOLD CARD**) lost his whip shortly after entering the home straight and was obliged to ride his mount hands and heels to the finish.  
**GOLD CARD** shifted out under pressure in the final straight.  
When questioned into the run of **SNAVE** rider D Johnston stated the gelding was unsuited to the track conditions.

**Race 6** | **DAIRY MASTER MILKING SYSTEMS 1600 M**

**GALLETA** (K Chiong) lay in at the end of the back straight momentarily hampering **LE MANS** (J Parkes)  
When questioned regarding the performance of **UNIQUE** rider D Johnston reported that the mare was unable to quicken in the heavy track conditions over the 1600 metres.

**Race 7** | **CENTRAL TYRES AUTOMOTIVE 1600 M**

**RACQUETOR** (M Dravitzski), **BENNY'S SISTER** (B Lammas), **BY THE POWERS** (D Walker) and **GOOD RISK** (S Doyle) were slow away.  
When questioned into the run of **ONE KAY** which was under pressure from near the 800 metres, rider H Tinsley stated the mare was unsuited to today's track conditions.  
The Trainer of the winner **QUICK MARCH**, T Egan attributed the improved performance of the mare to a recent course of schooling over fences.
