## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>THREE VALLEYS SALES DRAFT MAIDEN SPRINT (1200m)</b>
<p><b>AMANDAHUGNKISS</b> underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race.</p> <p><b>LONE WOLF</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>KEEPITASECRET</b> was crowded between <b>GILD THE LILY</b> and <b>COLONEL ANNE</b> at the start and lost ground.</p> <p><b>KEEPITASECRET</b> over raced in the middle stages and hung outwards.</p> <p><b>COLONEL ANNE</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>MARKS</b> hung outwards passing the 250 metres crowding <b>COLONEL ANNE</b> which had to be steadied and shift ground inwards to gain a clear run. Also in this incident <b>JIP JOP SHOP</b> and <b>KEEPITASECRET</b> were forced wider, resulting in <b>D'BOY</b> which was improving to their outside having to steady and shift ground inwards. <b>JIP JOP SHOP</b> went to the line untested when <b>MARKS</b> continued to lay outwards.</p> <p>Following this race C Johnson, the rider of 5<sup>th</sup> placed <b>COLONEL ANNE</b>, lodged a protest under Rule 642(1) against 4<sup>th</sup> placed <b>MARKS</b>. After hearing evidence the JCA upheld the protest, with the placing's confirmed as 1<sup>st</sup> <b>HURIKIN</b>, 2<sup>nd</sup> <b>GALLANT DAN</b>, 3<sup>rd</sup> <b>GILD THE LILY</b>, 4<sup>th</sup> <b>COLONEL ANNE</b>, 5<sup>th</sup> <b>MARKS</b>.</p> <p>Trainer N Ridley was advised that a warning had been placed against the racing manners of <b>MARKS</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ONCEUPONATIME &amp; PATAPAN R75 1200 (1200m)</b>
Rider K Walters advised that <b>ORAKA PRINCE</b> had travelled well however failed to let down when placed under pressure	

over the concluding stages.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>CENTRAL SI OWNERS &amp; TRAINERS ASSN DASH R65 (1200m)</b>
<b>GALLANT BABE</b> was restrained shortly after the start from its wide draw. Rider L Callaway advised that his mount <b>LICKWISH</b> raced greenly throughout. <b>INDIVIDUAL</b> lost the right hind plate during the running.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>D'CASH MILE R75 (1600m)</b>
<b>THEMONEYZMINE</b> shifted outwards at the start onto <b>WINCHESTER</b> which in turn crowded <b>EL BEE DEE</b> onto <b>SAMPHIRE</b> , with both runners getting back as a result. <b>HALO BUSTER</b> lay outwards over the concluding stages. Following this race the track was downgraded to Slow 7.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>ENGAGEMENT CONGRATULATIONS TO MARIA &amp; ALEX MDN (1600m)</b>
<b>PULP FICTION</b> and <b>MY CHINO</b> were slow to begin. <b>MCDONALD</b> shifted out at the start inconveniencing <b>FAST EDDIE SLEVIN</b> , <b>HI YO KO</b> , <b>SHE'S PAYBACK</b> and <b>ABITOFACHANCE</b> which all had to steady. <b>MISS CLEVEDON</b> over raced in the early stages. <b>PULP FICTION</b> raced wide throughout. <b>OLE GINGE</b> hung inwards rounding the final bend. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>MY CHINO</b> , rider C Johnson advised that the mare had travelled well into the race but was unable to improve in the prevailing track conditions.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>PORT FM &amp; GUTHRIE BOWRON HANDICAP R65 (1600m)</b>
<b>SEDUISANTE</b> was a late scratching by Stewards at 4.05 pm after refusing to parade to the start. Trainer N Ridley was advised that a warning had been placed against the mare's manners. <b>RACHEL RAFTER</b> was crowded between <b>FALZANO</b> and <b>WHARE CREEK</b> at the start and got back as a result. <b>WHARE CREEK</b> raced wide throughout.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MCINTOSH CATERING MAIDEN STAYERS (2100m)</b>
Racing into the first bend <b>DRESSED 'N' READY</b> when racing greenly was awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>SWELTER</b> , having to steady and shift out across heels. <b>PENNY KATE</b> raced wide in the early and middle stages. <b>SWELTER</b> tired from the 800 metres. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have a slow recovery rate. <b>ROSHEEN</b> (C Johnson) shifted ground outwards passing the 400 metres when not clear of <b>GALLANT SATIN</b> and <b>PENNY KATE</b> , resulting in both horses being checked. Rider C Johnson admitted a breach of Rule 638(1) (d) with the JCA suspending Mr Johnson's licence to ride at race meetings for 5 days effective 23 March to 3 April 2014 inclusive.
