Rider Daniel Bothamley did not attend today's meeting due to being unwell. D Bothamley was advised that a medical clearance will be required prior to racing next.

Trainer D Hutton advised that blood tests taken from **INDIAN BURT** and **GHOSTINTHEMACHINE** following the meeting revealed both horses to have blood disorders. Mr Hutton advised that both horses would be treated and given a short spell.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 THREE VALLEYS SALES DRAFT MAIDEN SPRINT (1200m)

AMANDAHUGNKISS underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race.

LONE WOLF was slow to begin.

KEEPITASECRET was crowded between **GILD THE LILY** and **COLONEL ANNE** at the start and lost ground.

KEEPITASECRET over raced in the middle stages and hung outwards.

COLONEL ANNE raced wide throughout.

MARKS hung outwards passing the 250 metres crowding COLONEL ANNE which had to be steadied and shift ground inwards to gain a clear run. Also in this incident JIP JOP SHOP and KEEPITASECRET were forced wider, resulting in D'BOY which was improving to their outside having to steady and shift ground inwards. JIP JOP SHOP went to the line untested when MARKS continued to lay outwards.

Following this race C Johnson, the rider of 5th placed **COLONEL ANNE**, lodged a protest under Rule 642(1) against 4th placed **MARKS**. After hearing evidence the JCA upheld the protest, with the placing's confirmed as 1st **HURIKIN**, 2nd **GALLANT DAN**, 3rd **GILD THE LILY**, 4th **COLONEL ANNE**, 5th **MARKS**.

Trainer N Ridley was advised that a warning had been placed against the racing manners of MARKS.

Race 2 ONCEUPONATIME & PATAPAN R75 1200 (1200n	n)

Rider K Walters advised that ORAKA PRINCE had travelled well however failed to let down when placed under pressure

over the concluding stages.

Race 3 CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSN DASH R65 (1200m)

GALLANT BABE was restrained shortly after the start from its wide draw.

Rider L Callaway advised that his mount LICKWISH raced greenly throughout.

INDIVIDUAL lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 4 D'CASH MILE R75 (1600m)

THEMONEYZMINE shifted outwards at the start onto **WINCHESTER** which in turn crowded **EL BEE DEE** onto **SAMPHIRE**, with both runners getting back as a result.

HALO BUSTER lay outwards over the concluding stages.

Following this race the track was downgraded to Slow 7.

Race 5 ENGAGEMENT CONGRATULATIONS TO MARIA & ALEX MDN (1600m)

PULP FICTION and **MY CHINO** were slow to begin.

MCDONALD shifted out at the start inconveniencing FAST EDDIE SLEVIN, HI YO KO, SHE'S PAYBACK and ABITOFACHANCE which all had to steady.

MISS CLEVEDON over raced in the early stages.

PULP FICTION raced wide throughout.

OLE GINGE hung inwards rounding the final bend.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MY CHINO**, rider C Johnson advised that the mare had travelled well into the race but was unable to improve in the prevailing track conditions.

Race 6 PORT FM & GUTHRIE BOWRON HANDICAP R65 (1600m)

SEDUISANTE was a late scratching by Stewards at 4.05 pm after refusing to parade to the start. Trainer N Ridley was advised that a warning had been placed against the mare's manners.

RACHEL RAFTER was crowded between FALZANO and WHARE CREEK at the start and got back as a result.

WHARE CREEK raced wide throughout.

Race 7 MCINTOSH CATERING MAIDEN STAYERS (2100m)

Racing into the first bend **DRESSED 'N' READY** when racing greenly was awkwardly placed on the heels of **SWELTER**, having to steady and shift out across heels.

PENNY KATE raced wide in the early and middle stages.

SWELTER tired from the 800 metres. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have a slow recovery rate.

ROSHEEN (C Johnson) shifted ground outwards passing the 400 metres when not clear of GALLANT SATIN and PENNY

KATE, resulting in both horses being checked. Rider C Johnson admitted a breach of Rule 638(1) (d) with the JCA suspending Mr Johnson's licence to ride at race meetings for 5 days effective 23 March to 3 April 2014 inclusive.
