#### RACE COMMENTS:

# Race 1 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE SYDENHAM HURDLES (3100m)

**SEA EAGLE** raced wide without cover from the 1800 metres.

**NEEDASTAR** jumped hesitantly throughout and was retired from the event passing the 400 metres, not jumping the last two hurdles.

A post race veterinary inspection of **NEEDASTAR** revealed the gelding to be lame in the right front leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to **NEEDASTAR** racing next.

### Race 2 EKRAAR @ LINWOOD PARK PREMIER THREE-YEAR-OLD (1200m)

In the early stages **THEM OR US** which was racing greenly got its head up when being restrained to obtain a position closer to the rail.

**ZIPPIN** which was racing greenly over raced in the early stages.

In the early part of the run home MR TREV was restrained and shifted outwards to obtain clear running.

**SILVER HIHO** raced greenly in the straight and shifted outwards over the concluding stages.

A post race veterinary inspection of MISS FORTUNE which finished a distant last did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Co-Trainer M Pitman advised they expected **MISS FORTUNE** to race well however were disappointed and feel the filly may not have backed up from her previous run.

## Race 3 ECHOES OF HEAVEN @ LINWOOD PARK PREMIER (1800m)

**HOUNDSCRY** was a little slow to begin.

**REGALO REAAL** raced wide for the majority of the race.

**SUPERTURF** commenced to weaken prior to the 800 metres finishing a distant last. A post race veterinary inspection of **SUPERTURF** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. The connections advised it is their intention to consider a jumping career for the gelding.

**PHEASANT** improved wide rounding the home turn.

When questioned regarding the performance of **PENCURI**, rider R Myers advised that the gelding travelled well throughout however commenced to weaken from the 200 metres and proved somewhat disappointing.

R Black, the rider of **SARAGARHI**, admitted a charge under Rule 638(3)(b) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 200 metres and was fined \$400 by the JCA.

## Race 4 CUP WEEK TICKETS ON SALE NOW MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE (3200m)

T Harris, the rider of **HUNKY DORY**, was fined \$100 under Rule 330(3)(c) for failing to claim down to his riding weight.

**JAMIE LEE** put in poor leaps at the fences near the 2400 and 2100 metres.

**ATOMIC ROAD** was retired from the event near the 500 metres, not jumping the last two fences.

**FAITES VOS JEUX** made a faulty leap at the last fence and lost momentum.

**STUERTZER** put in a poor leap at the last fence, landed awkwardly and unbalanced rider C Singer who was dislodged. C Singer was examined by St John Paramedics and passed fit to continue with his riding engagements.

**JAYJAY**, **ATHENRY** and **STORM HOME** were retired from the event at the 300 metres, not jumping the last fence. Connections of **BRER** reported that the gelding lost the left hind plate during the race and suffered a minor laceration to the same leg.

# Race 5 NZI KORAL STEEPLECHASE (4250m)

Near the 2800 metres the saddle on **UPPER CUT** shifted forward, with rider I Lupton retiring the gelding from the race.

**KEEP IT TIGHT** dipped on landing after jumping the fence near the 2400 metres.

**THE FOX** landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 1500 metres, dislodging rider N Quinn. Neither horse nor rider were injured in this incident.

Near the 1200 metre jump **TIM** landed awkwardly.

**DANE RULER** fell at the last fence dislodging rider M Cropp. The trailing **TIM** (T Harris) was unable to avoid the fallen runner and also fell.

**TIM** which returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils underwent a veterinary inspection which included an endoscopic examination, revealing the gelding to have suffered head trauma as a result of the fall. **TIM** subsequently received veterinary treatment.

A post race veterinary inspection of **DANE RULER** revealed the gelding to have fractured the left fore pastern and was subsequently humanely euthanased.

Riders N Quinn, M Cropp and T Harris were examined by St John paramedics and cleared fit.

#### Race 6 MILLENNIUM HOTELS & RESORTS PREMIER SPRINT (1200m)

On jumping ANZAC STAR and GOSSIPING bumped.

## Race 7 GOLD CLUB PREMIER (1400m)

TACTICALL was slow to begin.

**NORTH AND SOUTH** jumped awkwardly and lost ground.

**DUFFERS CREEK** and **GERVASIO** raced keenly in the early stages.

# Race 8 ESTARONLINE 117<sup>TH</sup> WINTER CUP (1600m)

Shortly after the start TAURUS, WILLY DUGGAN, KEEPA TRAMP and TEDDYTWINKLETOES were crowded between I AM SAM which shifted inwards slightly and OUR GAZZA which shifted outwards. As a result TAURUS, WILLY DUGGAN and KEEPA TRAMP all lost ground.

**WILLY DUGGAN** raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

In the straight **COAT OF ARMS** hung in.

When questioned regarding the performance of **OUR GAZZA**, rider D Bradley advised that in his opinion the gelding is better suited to a wetter looser track.

# Race 9 AVON CITY FORD PREMIER (1600m)

GEISHA GIRL was slow to begin.

**MY CHINO** was crowded on jumping and lost some ground.

**REEPERBAHN**, **INDY RULER** and **EL BEE DEE** raced keenly in the early stages.

Passing the 400 metres GOLD 'N CASH and MY CHINO bumped, with the weakening GOLD 'N CASH having to be steadied.

## Race 10 SPEIGHT'S PREMIER (1200m)

RALPH'S GIFT was slow to begin.

On jumping RED RIPPER shifted inwards and bumped BERENICE.

KUZANOV jumped awkwardly losing a little ground and then raced keenly in the early stages.

AGNUS BROWN raced keenly early.

Near the 800 metres BERENICE was steadied when awkwardly placed close to the heels of THE BOUNCER.

Near the 500 metres **SHE'S SLINKY** which was held up for clear running bumped **THE BOUNCER** on several occasions. **SHE'S SLINKY** was then eased and shifted outwards approaching the 250 metres to obtain clear running.
