Race 1	TREVINOS BAR & RESTAURANT MAIDEN HURDLES (3100m)			
ONE FOR THE MONEY and REVENGE both began awkwardly and lost ground.				
PILLAR TO POST misjudged the fence near the 1900 metres and dislodged rider I Lupton. I Lupton was examined by St John				
Paramedics and passed fit to fulfil his riding engagements. A post-race veterinary inspection of PILLAR TO POST revealed a				
slight laceration	to the nose but no other obvious abnormalities.			
ONE FOR THE MONEY made a poor leap over the jump near the 1700 metres.				
JACHIL made contact with the fence near the 800 metres.				
WAI NOT jumped the last fence awkwardly when challenging.				

CRYSTAL DUKE and **EVASIVE TRACY** raced wide throughout.

Race 2

MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS FILLIES & MARES RATING 75 (1500m)

BARBERRY ROZE and PFORPERFECT were crowded on jumping, with PFORPERFECT losing ground.

DAVONE CODE and **BARBERRY ROZE** brushed near the 150 metres. Shortly after **MISS THREE STARS** (S Wynne) shifted ground outwards when under pressure, crowding **BARBERRY ROZE** out onto the heels of **DAVONE CODE**. Trainer M Pitman viewed video footage of the final stages with a view to lodging an objection however elected not to proceed. Rider S Wynne was issued with a warning and advised to make a greater effort to straighten her mounts in future.

Race 3

Race 4

3 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 0-1 WIN STEEPLECHASE (3200m)

BRER underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was passed fit to start.

POWER PACK put in a poor leap when jumping the fence near the 1700 metres.

RIPDIDDLER jumped the fence near the 1000 metres awkwardly.

POWER PACK was retired from the event after jumping the third last fence. When questioned regarding the run of **POWER PACK**, rider R Doherty reported that the gelding travelled poorly throughout. A post-race veterinary examination of **POWER PACK** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. The connections advised that the gelding will be spelled.

Rider M Mitchell dismounted from **IMA DANCER** on pulling up, with the gelding being led back to the enclosure. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of **IMA DANCER** which revealed an injury to the left front tendon. The connections were advised that a vet clearance is required prior to racing next.

DUKE OF GLOUCESTER CUP SPONSORED BY THE CHRISTCHURCH HUNT (1600m)

SLAM DUNK was reluctant to load and delayed the start. The connections were warned to improve the gelding's barrier manners.

GOLDEN TOWER over raced near the 1200 metres.

REEPERBAHN raced wide throughout.

MR NIFTY was held up passing the 400 metres.

Riders **D Frye** (CONTADOR) and **B Smith** (ARAKI) were warned in regard to use of the whip prior to the 200 metres. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **MR CHEZ**, rider M Northcott could offer no tangible reason. Trainer G Rogerson advised that in his opinion the gelding did not handle the prevailing track conditions.

Race 5 VERO INSURANCE MAIDEN (1800m)

SHORTY MCNORTY shifted inwards on jumping crowding ODABELLA, MASTERZED and ASTRAVI.

VEEAREOBRO and HOLD THE DREAM raced keenly in the early stages.

LA CROUPIER raced wide throughout.

HOLD THE DREAM lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 6 RECREATION HOTEL GREYMOUTH MAIDEN (1500m)

TRUTH shifted outwards on jumping crowding STEELFIX and LOVE, with LOVE getting back as a result.

GILD THE LILY over raced in the early stages.

STEELFIX over raced in the middle stages.

Near the 350 metres **WILD BILL** (D Bothamley) lay inwards and crowded **CATALAN KING** momentarily, and continued to lay inwards. D Bothamley was advised to make a greater effort in future.

LADY GRACE raced wide throughout.

MISTAKEN IDENTITY lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

LOVE lost the near side plate during the running.

When questioned regarding the performance of **STEELFIX**, rider M Dee advised that the gelding failed to back up after the first's day effort.

Race 7 MCMILLAN EQUINE FEEDS MAIDEN (1200m)

KHE SANH began awkwardly.

GREY SAINT raced in restricted room rounding the home turn and then lay inwards throughout the home straight.

Race 8

HOSPITALITY NEW ZEALAND CANTERBURY 125TH GRAND NATIONAL HURDLES (4200m)

SEA EAGLE was slow to begin and then raced keenly in the early stages.

PRESTIGIOSA raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

HOUNDSCRY raced wide for some distance in the middle stages.

SUPERCHARGED made heavy contact with the fence near the 1700 metres and blundered on landing, dislodging rider C Singer .C Singer was examined by St John Paramedics and cleared of injury. A subsequent veterinary inspection of **SUPERCHARGED** failed to detect any obvious abnormalities.

PRESTIGIOSA misjudged the fence passing the 800 metres and lost momentum.

SEA EAGLE jumped the last fence awkwardly.

Rider A Browne (GARGAMEL) admitted a breach of Rule 638(2) in that he made a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post and was fined \$200 by the Judicial Committee.

MONI NUI lost the right front plate during the running and as a result sustained a laceration to the coronet area. When questioned regarding the improved performance of **GARGAMEL**, trainer L Beck advised that the 2nd of August was the gelding's first run in nearly three weeks and had benefited today from that run.

Race 9

HOTELIERS CHALLENGE CUP RATING 65 (1200m)

PENTULTIMATE and **UNIVERSAL** bumped on jumping.

GUARDIAN baulked at the outside rail passing the 500 metres.

Rider K Williams reported that SKEET hung outwards throughout the home straight.

When questioned regarding the performance of SPRINGWATER, rider C Johnson advised that the mare was unsuited to the holding nature of today's track conditions.

Race 10 LINDAUER RATING 65 (2000m)

GREY TOM raced wide throughout.

Rounding the turn near the 600 metres CHIPMUNK hung inwards.

HEZA BACHELOR lay inwards for the majority of the home straight.

LOVIN CONNECTION was reluctant to stride out at any stage and was eased down in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination of LOVIN CONNECTION revealed the mare to have suffered an atrial fibrillation. The connections were advised the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards on one occasion and also provide a vet clearance prior to resuming.

Rider D Walsh reported CAIRNSVILLE had hung throughout.
