RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	OIL SEEDS 1600
<p>EGG (S McKay) jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>CHARLIE BOY (M Wenn) was slow to begin, and then was further hampered by MISS GRACE (L Magorrian) which shifted out.</p> <p>LAZARUS (A Taylor) was slow to begin, and then was further hampered when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p>ANNA KAYE (U Holmquist) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 900 metres BO YING (J Jago) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of ANNA KAYE which shifted in. As a result BO YING was hampered losing ground.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres ARCEE (D Johnson) shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with ANNA KAYE which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>HEISTHEONE (R Smyth) commenced to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Passing the 150 metres ON PAROLE (J Oliver) attempted to improve to the inside of that runner with HEISTHEONE then shifting in slightly, with ON PAROLE shifting away from that runner making contact with CHAPRISE (R Hutchings).</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of EL GRANDE rider M Cameron was of the opinion that the gelding may be better suited when ridden with cover.</p> <p>BO YING lost the off fore plate during the running with minor damage to the hoof wall.</p>	

Race 2	CHEEP LIQUOR 1400
<p>FARNHAM (M Cameron) became restless in its barrier stall and reared over becoming cast. FARNHAM was removed from the barrier stalls and late scratched on veterinary advice at 2.00 pm. Trainer Mr J Bell was advised that FARNHAM would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.</p> <p>ISTIS LASS (L Satherley) was slow to begin, and was further hampered between PERIA PRINCESS (B R Jones) which shifted out and LADY PETEALI (T Thornton) who shifted in.</p> <p>LADY PETEALI over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>MAN ABOUT TOWN (V Gatu) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MESSI (R Smyth) was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>ISTIS LASS was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 3	WAHAROA TRANSPORT BULK & LIQUID DIVISION 1200
<p>KINDALEICA (C Grylls) began very awkwardly, shifting out making contact with the hind quarters of POLITICALNITEMARE (R Hutchings).</p> <p>PERMISSION GRANTED (J Oliver) shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier hampering DESCHABEEL (J Wong) which lost ground.</p> <p>EL POTRO (L Satherley) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>EL POTRO commenced to race fiercely soon after the start, becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance from the 1000 metres with the saddle shifting forward passing the 800 metres. EL POTRO continued to race fiercely placing rider L Satherley in difficulty. Trainer Mr C Phelan advised that he would remove the blinkers from EL POTRO at its subsequent start.</p> <p>POLITICALNITEMARE lost the off hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 4	WAHAROA INDUSTRIAL PARK 1400
<p>CARBONADO (M Chui) began awkwardly inconveniencing BOY (S McKay).</p> <p>CARBONADO hung outwards throughout becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 400 metres. When questioned regarding the improved performance of THE SHACKLER (O Bosson) trainer Mr M Dromgool advised that the gelding had raced fiercely at his most recent starts, and had settled better today with the removal of blinkers.</p>	
Race 5	MOEMOEA PARK 1400
<p>RATATUI (A Taylor) was slow to begin.</p> <p>GARDEZ LA FOI (J Oliver) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>THE PAPERBOY (M Du Plessis) was inclined to race keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Passing the 550 metres CALL THE SHOTS (S McKay) shifted out crowding THE PAPERBOY.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres CALL THE SHOTS was briefly held up.</p> <p>BRONDAN (D Johnson) lost the off hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 6	WAHAROA TRANSPORT CONTAINER & GENERAL DIVISION 2000
<p>FAIRY CAKE (M Coleman) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers crowding LUCKY CHARM (B R Jones) which was hampered losing ground.</p> <p>BALLYPIPER (J Wong) began awkwardly shifting out with MR KANTON (L Magorrian) and HEZ COOL (R Smyth) then shifting away from that runner, crowding KAKAHU NELL (C Grylls) and RETROSPECT (R Hutchings) which were both hampered losing ground. As a result HEZ COOL continued to shift out, hampering KEEP ROCKING (K Leung) which was forced out on to ROYAL COMMAND (K Myers) and RUNNING SCARED (J Oliver) which were both also hampered, losing ground.</p> <p>AMANOOD LAD (T Thornton) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>ROYAL COMMAND raced keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>KEEP ROCKING raced keenly when awkwardly placed on heels for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>COOL ONE had to steady passing the 800 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring RUNNING SCARED. Passing the 300 metres COOL ONE had to change ground to the inside of ROYAL COMMAND which was shifting out in an attempt to find better footing.</p> <p>KEPT IN STYLE (M Cameron) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight shifting in passing the 50 metres having to be corrected by its rider, losing momentum.</p>
