## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>HAWTIN RACING 1580</b>
<p><b>ROC'S ARE DIAMONDS</b> (A Collett) shifted inwards leaving the barriers, crowding <b>EVA QUICK STEPH</b> (S McKay) on to <b>THE SECRET'S OUT</b> (J Oliver) with <b>EVA QUICK STEPH</b> then being buffeted losing ground. <b>EVA QUICK STEPH</b> was held up rounding the turn passing the 400 metres, and was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>NZ FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 1400</b>
<p><b>INTO THE MYSTIC</b> (A Collett) was slow away (3L). <b>ALL THE ANSWERS</b> (J Whiteside) began awkwardly. <b>FREEWHEELER</b> (S Collett) had to be steadied near the 1100 metres when crowded for room by <b>ASHIMA</b> (L Innes) which was taken in by <b>MAJESTIC CHIEF</b> (M Sweeney) which shifted in when being steadied. <b>FREEWHEELER</b> then raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained. <b>ESKIMO KISS</b> (C Grylls) had to steady as a result. M Sweeney was advised that he must exercise greater care when shifting ground, and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record. <b>FREEWHEELER</b> was steadied approaching the 400 metres when awkwardly placed.</p>	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>LIMMER LODGE 1150</b>
<p><b>SHOT IN THE DARK</b> (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly.  <b>MOONRAKER</b> (S McKay) was crowded leaving the barriers.  Passing the 1100 metres <b>EVENTIDE</b> (T Thornton) raced in restricted room to the inside of <b>RIO CLARO</b> (M McNab) which shifted in with <b>EVENTIDE</b> then shifting out and away from <b>GREY GHOST</b> (S Collett) crowding <b>SHOT IN THE DARK</b>.  <b>WITHOUT QUESTION</b> (A Collett) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages.  Approaching the 300 metres <b>SLEEK SECRET</b> (J Oliver) was crowded between <b>PRAIRIE CREEK</b> (B R Jones) and <b>MOONRAKER</b> which both shifted ground under pressure.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>OTL GROUP 1150</b>
<p><b>FACEUP</b> (S Collett) was slow away.  <b>ALAMER</b> (M McNab) began awkwardly and shifted outwards, crowding <b>ATTILA</b> (T Thornton) and <b>ENGLISH LADY</b> (A Collett) which both lost ground.  Passing the 1000 metres <b>DUBAIINSTYLE</b> (C Grylls) raced in restricted room to the inside of <b>PRODIGAL SON</b> (L Innes) and was inconvenienced as a result.  <b>ENGLISH LADY</b> raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 800 metres.  <b>ROCKET NAVIGATOR</b> (B R Jones) raced ungenerously for a distance approaching the 600 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>PONDEROSA MISS 1150</b>
<p><b>MR KNOWITALL</b> (S McKay) and <b>DRAW THE LINE</b> (J Oliver) were crowded leaving the barriers.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>REKA RACING 2000</b>
<p><b>HOLD THE DREAM</b> (U Holmquist) was crowded leaving the barriers.  <b>VICTORYSHALLBEMINE</b> (V Colgan) over-raced when being restrained near the 1600 metres.  <b>IZ</b> (B R Jones) underwent a post-race veterinary inspection, including laryngoscope examination, which found the gelding to be a grade 5 roarer. Trainer, Mr P Lock, advised that <b>IZ</b> is now likely to be retired from racing.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>DEBBIE SWEENEY BIRTHDAY WISHES 1150</b>
<p><b>BILL BISON</b> (M Hills), and <b>KNIGHTS VALLEY</b> (A Collett) were slow away.  <b>SMOKED</b> (S McKay) began awkwardly and shifted out, hampering <b>MIGHTY CLIVE</b> (M McNab) which lost ground.  Shortly after the start rider D Hain permitted his mount <b>BE BEAUTIFUL</b> to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of <b>SAMCHAZO</b> (T Thornton) which was dictated inwards crowding <b>WICKEDLY</b> (A Jones) and <b>BEAR</b> (C Grylls) which were both checked losing ground. D Hain admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with his license to ride in races suspended 30 July – 8 August, inclusive (4 riding days).  <b>MIGHTY CLIVE</b> raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres and was steadied. When questioned rider M McNab advised that the gelding had been a little reluctant amongst other runners in its debut race today.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>WAIPA HIRE 1580</b>
<p><b>MAXIMUM HEIGHT</b> (S McKay) began very awkwardly, and then was dictated outwards by <b>LITTLE ALFIE BROWN</b> (R Norvall) which lay out when leaving the barriers. As a result <b>MAXIMUM HEIGHT</b> shifted out crowding <b>CHILL BILL</b> (M McNab), <b>NOTTOOBAD</b> (A Collett) and <b>LETMEBY</b> (A Jones) which were all hampered losing ground.  <b>SECONDS OUT</b> (T Thornton) raced keenly when being steadied in the early stages.  Rider A Collett (<b>NOTTOOBAD</b>) was reminded of her obligations when riding out to the finish when circumstances permit her to do so.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>WINTER RACING AT WAIPA 1580</b>
<p><b>KAKAHU NELL</b> (B Hutton) was slow away, and then clipped a heel shortly after the start and blundered.  <b>LOTUS LAUD</b> (U Holmquist) was steadied passing the 1400 metres. <b>LOTUS LAUD</b> then raced keenly through the middle stages, and shifted outwards near the 1200 metres hampering <b>JESSHANIMO</b> (Z Moki). Video footage proved to be inconclusive, with Rider U Holmquist being advised she must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.  <b>JUD STRUNK</b> (A Schwerin) lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres making contact with <b>ROCKET QUEEN</b> (M Sweeney) approaching the winning post.</p>
