RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 PHELAN RACING STABLES HURDLE

NGATIRA GOLD (M Mitchell) landed awkwardly after jumping the second fence.

MAGNA CARTA (T Harris) misjudged the third fence.

ZAVAMAR (C Studd) misjudged the fence near the 250 metres on the first occasion.

VITALI (D Miller) was inclined to run its fences down throughout.

ZAVAMAR and **BIG MEADSY** (A Kuru) were both retired from the race prior to jumping the second last fence when well beaten.

VITALI badly misjudged the second last fence and blundered on landing losing considerable ground and momentum with the saddle shifting sideways.

JUST COLLIE (E Farr) hit the last fence.

VITALI lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

When questioned regarding the poor performance of **ZAVAMAR** rider C Studd advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 2 TOWNLEY TRENCHING & ELECTRICAL HURDLE

Following race one T Harris advised that he was feeling unwell and was stood down by the on course doctor. T Harris was replaced by D Miller on **AMANOOD LAD**.

ZENOCOIN (H McNeill) and **LUCKY TONIGHT** (M Mitchell) were both slow to begin.

AMANOOD LAD began awkwardly shifting out crowding **BRAVE BUCCANEER** (S Phelan) and **MONI NUI** (E Farr) with **MONI NUI** losing ground.

AMANOOD LAD over-raced in the early and middle stages.

D'LLARO (A Kuru) and LUCKY TONIGHT (M Mitchell) both hit the fence near the 100 metres on the first occasion.

AMANOOD LAD misjudged the fence near the 1050 metres.

ISTIMAGIC (R Cole) was pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences when well beaten.

D'LLARO hit the second last fence.

TALLYHO TWINKLETOE (M Gillies) ran down the final fence and landed awkwardly.

Race 3 MILLS REEF WINERY & RESTAURANT 1950

GINGERBREAD MAN (S Wynne) and SOUTHERNMAN (R Elliot) were both slow to begin.

THE ARABIAN DUKE (A Jones) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SOUTHERNMAN contacted the running rail near the 50 metres when laying in under pressure.

Race 4 HOSPICE DINNER & AUCTION – 12 SEPT 3YO

UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT (A Jones) began awkwardly shifting out forcing **WHITTAKER** (S McKay) out on to **KING BOLT** (C Lammas) and **DANICA** (U Holmquist) with **KING BOLT** and **DANICA** losing ground.

RUSSIAN MAGIC (T Thornton) lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MADALYN** rider C Grylls advised Stewards that the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 5 CHAPMANS BUFFET @ HOLIDAY INN ROTORUA 1200

FRODO (M Hills) and LADY QUASAR (A Jones) were slow to begin.

WOOSTER (C Grylls) raced keenly in the early and middle stages, and then raced greenly in the final straight.

DELLA LAMOUR (U Holmquist) and **WOTUONABOUT** (R Elliot) came together passing the 100 metres.

CHINESE WHISPER (B Hutton) returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination confirmed **CHINESE WHISPER** to have bled with the mare now being subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing with a veterinary clearance being required prior to trialing or racing next. Trainer Mr T Mitchell advised that the mare would now likely be retired.

Race 6 KNOX ENGRAVERS ROTORUA 1400

LAUTARO (S Wynne), **REMIND ME AGAIN** (B R Jones) and **BORNINASANDPIT** (C Grylls) were all slow to begin. **BON MARCHE** (C Lammas) and **REMIND ME AGAIN** came together on several occasions in the final straight when both

runners shifted ground.

Race 7 VERN & DORIS NICKEL MEMORIAL 1400

Shortly after the start **NOTHING** (J Oliver) commenced to race ungenerously having to be firmly restrained approaching the 1200 metres, and continued to prove difficult for the remainder of the race. When questioned rider J Oliver advised Stewards that **NOTHING** had locked its jaw and had been very difficult to control. The Stewards placed a warning on the racing manners of **NOTHING**.

Race 8 MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS ROTORUA 1400

BEYOND REACH (J Oliver) was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 3.50 pm after suffering a laceration to the left stifle leaving the birdcage.

TRICKLE DOWN (C Grylls) and CULLCH FORTY FIVE (S Collett) were both slow to begin.

GOODN'TARG (M McNab) raced in restricted room rounding the bend near the 300 metres.

HEY MR (P Holmes) was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 9 ESCAPE TO RYDGES ROTORUA 2200

No racing incidents to report.
