## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>PALACE HOTEL TE AROHA MDN HURDLE</b>
<p><b>JOE COOL</b> (C Singer), <b>ISDABICKY</b> (A Tata) and <b>MANGAROA HUSTLER</b> (S Phelan) were all slow away.</p> <p><b>IN FOR FUN</b> (M McNelis) put in a poor jump at the first fence.</p> <p><b>IN FOR FUN</b> again put in a poor jump at the second fence making contact with <b>TEQUILA AT MIDNITE</b> (D Miller) which was forced on to the hind quarters of <b>RACQUETOR</b> (C Perrett).</p> <p><b>IN FOR FUN</b> continued to jump indifferently for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>RUSSIANOV</b> (M Mitchell) badly misjudged the fourth fence and blundered on landing dislodging rider M Mitchell. Both horse and rider were uninjured. Hampered as a result were <b>JOE COOL</b>, <b>ISDABICKY</b> (A Tata) and <b>TEQUILA AT MIDNITE</b>.</p> <p><b>JOE COOL</b> jumped the fifth fence indifferently.</p> <p><b>RACQUETOR</b> misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres.</p>	

<p><b>PYCOK FLYER</b> (W Cafferty) hit the fence near the 950 metres.</p> <p><b>MAGNA CARTA</b> (A Kuru) landed awkwardly after jumping the third last fence losing its footing and almost dislodging the rider.</p> <p><b>SKAI GLEN</b> (R Eynon) put in a poor jump at the third last fence when well back.</p> <p><b>MANGAROA HUSTLER, RACQUETOR</b> and <b>IN FOR FUN</b> were all retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten.</p> <p><b>SKAI GLEN</b> and <b>JOE COOL</b> were retired from the race prior to the second last fence.</p> <p><b>TEQUILA AT MIDNITE</b> jumped the final two fences poorly.</p> <p><b>PYCOCK FLYER</b> put in a poor jump at the second last fence.</p>	
Race 2	<b>OPIE RACING STABLES OPN HURDLE</b>
<p>S Fannin (<b>THENAMESBOND</b>) was fined \$100 after being unable to claim down to his declared riding weight.</p> <p><b>ISTIMAGIC</b> (A Kuru) landed awkwardly after jumping the second fence.</p> <p><b>BIG BROWNIE</b> (I Lupton) put in a poor jump at the second fence. <b>BIG BROWNIE</b> continued to jump indifferently for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>THENAMESBOND</b> ran down the third fence.</p> <p><b>ISTIMAGIC</b> (A Kuru) hit the third fence.</p> <p><b>NO GOVERNANCE</b> (C Singer) misjudged the fifth fence.</p> <p><b>BACK IN BLACK</b> (N Quinn) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>NO GOVERNANCE</b> got in close to the fence near the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>SOUTHERN COUNTESS</b> (D Miller) was retired from the race after jumping the fence near the 950 metres when well out of contention.</p> <p><b>THENAMESBOND</b> hit the third last fence. <b>AROSE</b> (E Farr) put in an indifferent jump at that fence.</p> <p><b>ANYTHING GOES</b> (M McNelis) hit the second last fence dislodging its rider. Both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p><b>WAITOKI AHI</b> (R Eynon) jumped the final two fences indifferently.</p> <p><b>THENAMESBOND</b> misjudged the last fence and knuckled on landing.</p> <p><b>BIG BROWNIE</b> lost the left hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	<b>TE AROHA STALLION PLACEMENT SCHEME 1300</b>
<p><b>DELLA LAMOUR</b> was declared a late scratching at 8.20 am on veterinary advice.</p> <p><b>MIDNIGHT REIGN</b> (M Wenn) began awkwardly crowding <b>DOUCETTE</b> (Z Moki) on to <b>BOOKED FOR RIO</b> (M Du Plessis).</p> <p><b>DOUCETTE</b> over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>DOUCETTE</b> dipped near the 550 metres.</p> <p><b>DOUCETTE</b> lay out under pressure near the 250 metres inconveniencing <b>BOOKED FOR RIO</b>.</p> <p><b>BULLDOZER</b> (D Nolan) had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	<b>THE SPRAY RIG – TE AROHA MDN STEEPLECHASE</b>
<p>R Cole (<b>STRAIGHT FURROW</b>) was fined \$200 after being unable to claim down to his declared riding weight.</p> <p><b>RADINKA</b> (M Mitchell) jumped outwards at the second fence with <b>BOLD RANSOM</b> (D Miller) which was following that runner putting in a poor jump.</p> <p><b>STRAIGHT FURROW</b> (R Cole), <b>GENEROUS TYPE</b> (S Fannin) and <b>JUST GORGEOUS</b> (E Farr) all put in poor jumps at the fence near the 700 metres on the first occasion.</p> <p><b>BOLD RANSOM</b> landed awkwardly and blundered after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>STRAIGHT FURROW</b> jumped the fence near the 700 metres indifferently.</p> <p><b>XALTED</b> was retired from the race prior to the second last fence when well beaten. When questioned rider S Phelan said that after the gelding jumped the two fences near the 1700 metres poorly continued to jump indifferently until being retired from the race near the 400meters. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	<b>RACING TE AROHA SUPPORTERS OPN STEEPLECHASE</b>
<p><b>MYTHS AND LEGENDS</b> (S Fannin) put in a poor jump at the first fence losing ground.</p> <p><b>SINISTA</b> (E Farr) got in close to the fence near the 1700 metres on the first occasion.</p> <p><b>MISTER DEEJAY</b> (I Lupton) jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p><b>I'M ISAAC</b> (D Miller) made contact with <b>SINISTA</b> jumping the fence near the 1000 metres with <b>SINISTA</b> becoming badly unbalanced almost dislodging its rider.</p> <p><b>TOBOUGGIE NIGHTS</b> (R Eynon) misjudged the fence near the 700 metres. <b>SMOKE</b> (A Kuru) also put in a poor jump at that fence.</p> <p><b>MYTHS AND LEGENDS</b> was retired from the race prior to the second last fence when well beaten. <b>MYTHS AND LEGENDS</b> was dismounted and required veterinary attention for a significant tendon injury to the near foreleg, and also lost the plate on the off foreleg during the running.</p> <p><b>I'M ISAAC</b> lost the near hind plate during the running and sustained a laceration to the inside of the left foreleg which required veterinary attention.</p>	

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>AXIS AUTOMOTIVE LTD 1000</b>
<p><b>SIR BLITZEN</b> was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.55 pm after being injured prior to plate inspection.</p> <p><b>ESCAPE</b> (L Satherley) raced greenly in the early stages when well back becoming tailed off and was not persevered with over the final 200 metres.</p> <p><b>STRIKE FOR KASH</b> (U Holmquist) hung out rounding the bend into the final straight, and continued to hang out for the remainder of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>KAISER AG LTD 2200</b>
<p><b>SIR AL SYD</b> (D Nolan) reared at the start and was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>VARRO</b> (R Smyth) shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers hampering <b>THE TALISMAN</b> (R Norvall).</p> <p><b>STYLE IS ETERNAL</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>BACH</b> (C Grylls) began awkwardly coming together.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>GREGORY EQUINE (2003) LTD 1300</b>
<p>Trainer Mr S Clotworthy was fined \$50 after the horse <b>SIR JACK REMINGTON</b> (L Magorrian) was presented without an item of notified gear, being ear covers. As a set of ear covers was not available <b>SIR JACK REMINGTON</b> raced minus that item of gear.</p> <p><b>DRAW THE LINE</b> (C Grylls) raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>ALUKA</b> (S McKay) had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the straight.</p>
