## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HARRIS CONTRACTING SANSON/MAKOWHAI FARMS HURDLE (2900 metres)
Stewards gave permission at approximately 8.00am for M McNelis to be replaced by R Cole at the request of his employer, M Eales, to ride <b>SORTEMOUT</b> .	
<b>JUSTA TOMBOY</b> lost ground at the jump near the 2500 metres when back.	
<b>GET FLASH</b> was inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages.	
<b>HAZY DAZE</b> lost ground after jumping the fence near the 1200 metres.	
<b>CRACKA CROWN</b> put in a bad jump at the fence near the 1000 metres, landing awkwardly and losing ground.	
<b>KRASE</b> was tightened and checked shortly after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres when inside <b>HAZY DAZE (S Fannin)</b> which shifted in when not clear. <b>S Fannin</b> admitted a resultant breach of Rule 638(1)(d) and after consideration the judicial committee suspended S Fannin's licence to ride in races from the close of racing on Sunday, 26 July until the close of racing on Friday, 31 July, plus a fine of \$350.	

<p><b>GOONDIWINDI</b> was placed in restricted room near the 850 metres when awkwardly inside the heels of <b>HAZY DAZE</b></p> <p><b>CRACKA CROWN</b> was eased down passing the 800 metres. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection on <b>CRACKA CROWN</b>, which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>GOONDIWINDI</b> was retired from the event near the 700 metres when well back.</p> <p><b>HARD SHOT</b> and <b>JUSTA TOMBOY</b> were retired from the event passing the 500 metres when out of contention.</p> <p><b>BANTENEIGHTY</b> jumped the final fence awkwardly and lost momentum.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>GAVIN TEAL CONTRACTING AMATEUR (2100 metres)</b>
<p><b>GOLDYSOX</b> was a late scratching at 12.12pm after rider A McIntyre sustained an injury to her shoulder when attempting to mount the gelding.</p> <p><b>MAILLY</b> over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>SEIGAL</b> was held up for a short distance passing the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>MAILLY</b> was crowded passing the 600 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.</p> <p><b>C Roughan</b> (SEIGAL) dropped her whip near the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>H Fleming (IMA PERFECT GUY)</b> was issued with a warning with respect to the use of her whip prior to the 200 metres. <b>H Fleming (IMA PERFECT GUY)</b> was severely reprimanded after relaxing her ride passing the 70 metres when in fourth position, narrowly holding that placing at the finish.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>HARRIS CONTRACTING DANNEVIRKE MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE (4200 metres)</b>
<p><b>I'VE GOT THIS</b> jumped indifferently on the first circuit losing ground at various jumps.</p> <p><b>AND THATZ SCOTTY</b> jumped the fence near the 2200 metres awkwardly and lost momentum.</p> <p><b>WAITOKI AHI</b> (M Mitchell) got in close and misjudged the fence near the 1600 metres and fell. <b>NELLS BELLE</b> (L Kennedy), which was racing in behind, was unable to avoid the fallen WAITOKI AHI, and fell in consequence. Respective riders M Mitchell and L Kennedy were cleared to ride by paramedics. Also affected in this incident was <b>I'VE GOT THIS</b>, which was checked and lost ground.</p> <p><b>MY AVATAR</b> was eased out of the contest after jumping the fence near the 800 metres when out of contention.</p> <p><b>THE PAINTER (R Cole)</b> made a poor jump and lost ground at the second last fence and then fell at the last fence and took some time to recover when tired. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed <b>THE PAINTER</b> to have a cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer G Brick was advised that a veterinary clearance including the results of an ECG must be produced prior to <b>THE PAINTER</b> next racing. Rider R Cole was uninjured.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>THURSTON CONTRACTING STEEPLECHASE (4200 metres)</b>
<p><b>KICK BACK</b> jumped its fences high in the early stages, losing ground.</p> <p><b>GOOSEBUMPS</b> landed awkwardly at the fence near the 800 metres on the first round.</p> <p><b>BRUSHMAN</b> landed awkwardly at the last fence in the back straight on the last round, dislodging rider T Harris. T Harris was examined and cleared by medical staff.</p> <p><b>KICK BACK</b> jumped the fence at the 600 metres poorly on the last round.</p> <p><b>MAN O' MANN</b> weakened from the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>GOOSEBUMPS</b> was forced wide by the riderless horse at the fence near the 600 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>HOPKINS FARMING GROUP MAIDEN (2100 metres)</b>
<p><b>PLATINUM SONG</b> was a late scratching at the barrier on veterinary advice after the gelding pulled a plate in the preliminary which resulted in a laceration to a heel.</p> <p><b>ZEDACE</b> jumped out at the start and bumped <b>HAMILTONIAN</b>.</p> <p><b>MA BELLE KATE</b> raced four wide without cover around the first bend so was taken forward to a leading position.</p> <p><b>BEFORUNOIT</b> raced very wide in the back straight in search of better going.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>VANDENBERG SHELTER TRIMMERS MAIDEN (1200 metres)</b>
<p>D Bradley replaced J Oliver (unwell) as the rider of <b>ROCFIVE</b>.</p> <p><b>FIFTEENSIXTY</b> began awkwardly, making contact with the barrier and losing ground.</p> <p><b>IL CAMPIONE</b> and <b>ROCFIVE</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of <b>ALOT</b>, which gave ground from the 500 metres, apprentice N Teeluck reported that the mare had made irregular breathing noises on pulling up. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of <b>ALOT</b> which revealed a noise in the upper respiratory tract. Connections were advised that <b>ALOT</b> should under a follow-up examination.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>EAMES AG/CORBETT BROS MAIDEN (1600 metres)</b>
<p><b>KEEN TEMPO</b> began very awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p><b>HEAVENS KEEP</b> shifted out abruptly on jumping hampering <b>MWAADAN</b>.</p> <p><b>PHILOSOPHER</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ALTIPLANO</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>J Gracioso (UNREEL)</b> was spoken to advisedly and firmly reminded of his obligations in relation to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>	

Race 8	CB NORWOOD DISTRIBUTORS HANDICAP (1400 metres)
<p>D Mo replaced J Oliver as the rider of <b>ALLSTARS</b>. <b>RALPH'S GIFT</b> and <b>ZA BRUTE</b> were slow on jumping. <b>SPECIAL BID</b> began awkwardly and settled back. <b>ALL GINGA</b> had to be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>ANOTHER BACHELOR</b> approaching the home turn. When questioned regarding the run of <b>SPECIAL BID</b>, rider R Goldsbury reported that the mare was not suited to the Heavy (11) track conditions today. An investigation was opened and adjourned with respect to apprentice <b>T Johnson (ALL GINGA)</b> who presented himself at the scales to weigh out without a safety vest.</p>
