## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Fell Engineering Maiden 2100</b>
<b>KIMS MESSAGE</b> (R Hutchings) was slow away. <b>TUKAWA</b> (D Johnson) over-raced when leaving the straight on the first occasion. Passing the 350 metres <b>TUKAWA</b> lay in, crowding <b>EGG</b> (T Thornton) which had to be steadied.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Kumara's Farewell Maiden Mile</b>
<b>CHAMPAGNESOCIALIST</b> (U Holmquist) was slow away. <b>CHARLIE PRIDE</b> (D Johnson) shifted in jumping away, making contact with <b>LITTLE RILEY</b> (R Smyth) forcing that runner in on to <b>JUSTIFIED</b> (L Magorrian) which then shifted away from that runner, forcing <b>INA JAM</b> (R Hutchings) inwards which was hampered.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Carters Chippies Mile</b>
<b>RULALINE</b> (M Coleman) over-raced in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>SECRET LILY</b> Apprentice Rider R Smyth could offer no tangible excuses, advising that the mare had been unable to quicken when placed under pressure. A veterinary examination failed to find any obvious abnormalities. Trainer D Logan advised the filly is affected by soft soles and this may have attributed to the performance.	

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Waipu Hotel 1200</b>
<p><b>FLYING FANTASY</b> (T Wenn) began awkwardly, losing ground.  Soon after leaving the barrier <b>TWIST OF FATE</b> (M Du Plessis) had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>BLACK MASCARA</b> (C Grylls).  <b>TWIST OF FATE</b> raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early and middle stages.  <b>ROYAL TOAST</b> (R Hutchings) raced wide without cover throughout.  <b>AMBER RAYNE</b> (R Smyth) lay out when making the final bend running wider on the track.  <b>FLYING FANTASY</b> shifted out under pressure early in the final straight when struck with the whip.  <b>TWIST OF FATE</b> raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>AMBER RAYNE</b> passing the 100 metres when that runner shifted out.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Dunstan Feeds Maiden 1200</b>
<p><b>HANNIBAL LECTER</b> (R Smyth) and <b>LISTOWEL</b> (C Grylls) came together, leaving the barrier.  <b>SAVANNAH SOMOYA</b> (T Thornton) shifted out abruptly when leaving the barriers, hampering <b>STELLAR WAY</b> (U Holmquist) and <b>CHADSDALE</b> (R Hutchings).  <b>FINNS HALO</b> (M Cameron) shifted in when leaving the barriers making heavy contact with <b>MIA ROSE</b> (S McKay) with <b>MIA ROSE</b> then shifting in abruptly, crowding <b>SERENGETTI SUN</b> (L Innes) which had to steady, losing ground.  <b>MISS BUFFO</b> (M Hills) began awkwardly, losing ground.  <b>HANNIBAL LECTER</b> made the first bend awkwardly and then lay out for the remainder of the race.  <b>DANCING DONNA</b> (D Johnson) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the middle stages.  Passing the 950 metres <b>SAVANNAH SOMOYA</b> shifted out when being restrained off the heels of <b>LISTOWEL</b> making contact with <b>MIA ROSE</b>. <b>SAVANNAH SOMOYA</b> then over-raced for a distance shifting out passing the 900 metres again making contact with <b>MIA ROSE</b> which shifted out, forcing <b>RAROONEY</b> (K Joyce) wide on the track. <b>RAROONEY</b> then raced ungenerously for a distance when racing wide.  <b>STELLAR WAY</b> over-raced for a distance approaching the 800 metres.  <b>MIA ROSE</b> raced wide without cover.  When questioned regarding the performance of <b>DANCING DONNA</b> Rider D Johnson was unable to offer any tangible excuses.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Northland Waste 1400</b>
<p><b>GENDARME</b> (R Hutchings) and <b>THE FLYING AFFAIR</b> (M Du Plessis) came together when leaving the barrier.  <b>D'CASH MAN</b> began awkwardly with Apprentice Rider R Smyth dropping her whip.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>100% Barrell's 1400</b>
<p><b>RIVER RAIDER</b> (C Dell) shifted in when leaving the barriers, inconveniencing <b>IWANNAGOHOMIE</b> (R Smyth) and <b>LITTLE DREAMER</b> (Z Moki).  <b>GOLD VAULT</b> (S McKay), <b>BLACKLISTED</b> (T Wenn) and <b>THE BAMPOT</b> (A Schwerin) all began awkwardly.  <b>BERG EN DAL</b> (R Hutchings) was slow to begin.  Passing the 900 metres <b>THE BAMPOT</b> raced ungenerously when being restrained, shifting in and making contact with <b>GOLD VAULT</b>.  <b>WOODSMAN</b> (A Taylor) raced wide without cover.  <b>RIVER RAIDER</b> and <b>OSCAR LEGEND</b> (L Magorrian) both commenced to race greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight and came together and brushed near the 50 metres.  Following the race the connections of the second placed horse <b>OSCAR LEGEND</b> lodged an objection against the first placed horse <b>RIVER RAIDER</b> alleging interference in the final straight. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.</p>
