RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MCKEOWN GROUP LTD MAIDEN (1400m)

EL JODI shifted inwards on jumping and made firm contact with SWEET TIME, which got back.

TYCOON CLASS raced keenly in the early stages.

ROUGH RULER and **DE ARVIL** raced wide in the early stages.

TYCOON CLASS raced wide from the 1000 metres.

SPIDER LILY made the bend awkwardly passing the 600 metres making contact with the running rail momentarily.

Passing the 400 metres **TYCOON CLASS** which had become awkwardly placed on the heels of **NAVA** shifted wider to obtain clear running .

Passing the 350 metres TYCOON CLASS and JANEFIELD JEWEL came together and bumped.

Shortly thereafter **NAVA** lay outwards under pressure placing **JANEFILED JEWEL** in restricted room for a short distance.

Passing the 200 metre mark TYCOON CLASS lay inwards and bumped with JANEFIELD JEWEL for a short distance.

EL JODI lay in under pressure over the concluding stages having to be straightened in the shadows of the post.

When spoken to about the performance of **NAVA** rider R Bishop reported the filly did not appreciate the firmer nature of today's track.

Race 2 DE GEEST CONSTRUCTION MAIDEN (1400m)

MRS NEVILL was a late scratching at 8.50 am due to transport difficulties.

The start was delayed three minutes due to having to be DIVA'S HALO re-saddled at the start.

PEPPER MILL shifted inwards despite the riders' effort on jumping contacting TOMMYRA.

ASSAIL was slow to begin and tailed the field throughout, the connections were advised that a warning had been placed against the mares racing record.

URBAN raced keenly in the early stages.

PREFEREED FLIGHT and DIVA'S HALO both raced wide in the early stages.

PEPPER MILL made the bend near the 950 metre mark awkwardly, having to steady.

FERAL ICE made the home bend awkwardly shifting wider forcing PREFERRED FLIGHT over extra ground.

Race 3 BRACKENS PRINT OAMARU 2YO (1200m)

The start was delayed due to a number of runners being reluctant to enter the barrier.

BELLS OF OUZELEY began awkwardly.

SNIPARINDA jumped inwards making contact with **PERCEPTIVE**.

WILLOW raced wide throughout.

Passing the 1000 metres MARGARITA MOVER shifted in when not clear and crowded SNIPARINDA inwards onto SALU which had to check and lost momentum. VELLUTO was hampered in consequence and over raced for a short distance. Passing the 900 metre mark SNIPARINDA which had begun to over race clipped a heel of MARGARITA MOVER and

RED ACE made the bend awkwardly passing the 500 metres shifting wider on the track.

When questioned about the performance of **RED ACE** rider C Johnson reported that the gelding had travelled favourably until placed under full pressure where from that point onwards the gelding had raced greenly.

Following the running of this event the connections of **SNIPARINDA** lodged a protest against the winner **MARGARITA MOVER** re interference at the 1000 metres. After considering all submissions and viewing the films the JCA dismissed the protest.

S Wynne (MARGARITA MOVER) admitted a breach of rule 638(1)(d) in that she rode carelessly near the 1000 metres. After hearing all submissions the JCA suspended her license to ride in all races from 20 July up until and including the 25 July and in addition imposed a fine of \$400.

Race 4 GLENMOA FARMS LTD WAITAKI RIVER TROPHY OPEN HCP (1200m)

PARAKETO was slow to begin.

JAZZMAN began awkwardly.

JACK'S RUN was slow to begin.

PARAKETO lay outwards from the 500 metres and made the final bend awkwardly.

When questioned about the performance of **PARAKETO** rider C Johnson reported that the gelding had travelled well throughout however when placed under full pressure the gelding had lay outwards and he had to swap whip hands passing the 100 metre mark. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Following this event the track was upgraded to a Good 3 rating.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE RATING 65 (1200m)

AGNUS BROWN bounded and began awkwardly racing ungenerously through the early stages.

MATOAKA was slow to begin.

LETSAVAFLING began awkwardly shifting outwards.

SPRINGWATER over raced in the early stages.

HOT PANTS and HEEBY JEEBY came together and made contact shortly after the start.

Passing the 1000 metres **AGNUS BROWN** which had continued to race ungenerously shifted outwards and made contact with **WILBERRY** forcing that runner wider for a short distance.

SPRINGWATER made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly and got its head up on a number of occasions.

HEEBY JEEBY was held up for a short distance early in the home straight.

HOT PANTS and CARPATHIA came together and brushed passing the 50 metre mark.

Race 6 UNDER & OUT DRILLING RATING 65 (2200m)

PUTT FOR CASH over raced in the early stages .

CLEM got its head up on a number of occasions shortly after the start when being restrained.

Passing the 1800 metres **MASTERZED** was crowded for some distance and had to steady when **CLEM** (K Mudhoo) shifted inwards. Shortly thereafter **CLEM** shifted inwards and away from **RUBY TUESDAY** (R Hannam) which shifted inwards momentarily resulting in **MASTERZED** and **BLU MACH** being checked when awkwardly placed on the heels of **CLEM**. Apprentice Mudhoo in the presence of apprentice mentor W Harnett was severely reprimanded and instructed he must show better judgement in future. R Hannam was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground. **CROYDON** was steadied for some distance in consequence. **CROYDON** raced fiercely for a short distance passing the 1800 metres. Due to lack of tempo in this race **PUTT FOR CASH**, **CROYDON**, **MORGAN BET** and **BLU MACH** all over raced in the middle stages.

JIMMYTOSHOES raced wide from the 1500 metres.

CROYDON was held up passing the 400 metre mark for a short distance before shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running.

Race 7 SPEIGHT'S STAYERS RATING 65 (2200m)

ORIENTAL BRONZE shifted outwards on jumping hampering **KEEP THE LOT**.

SOMETHING ZED was slow to begin.

INIS ROSE shifted out on jumping and made contact with **DRUMGOLD** dictating that runner outwards. **DRUMGOLD** was buffeted for a short distance and got back as a result. Passing the 2000 metres **DRUMGOLD** began to race fiercely and over raced for some distance.

Passing the 1800 metres **SLICK NICKEL** was steadied when placed in restricted room by **ORIENTAL BRONZE** which shifted inwards momentarily.

INIS ROSE was steadied at the 1750 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of SWISS ALPS.

DRUMGOLD which had continued to race fiercely was taken forward passing the 1500 metre mark before settling near the 1300 metres, **DRUMGOLD** raced wide from that point. **SEEKING REDEMPTION** was obliged to race wide around the first bend before being allowed to improve forward with 1400 metres to run.

SLICK NICKEL was steadled for some distance passing the 1500 metres and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained. **SLICK NICKEL** continued to over race for some distance.

MESSINES raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1200 metre mark.

Race 8 THE CROMBIE CUP RATING 75 (2200m)

FLY ME TO DA MOON was declared a late scratching at 11.22 am on veterinarian advice.

PHEASANT was a late scratching at 1.18 pm due to the track upgrade.

KINGS PAL raced wide in the early stages.

ADDITUP raced keenly in the early stages.

DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1500 metres.

CHEEKY TART gave ground from the 800 metre mark.

Race 9 CROMBIE & PRICE LTD OAMARU CUP OPEN HANDICAP (1600m)

TACTICALL was slow to begin and got back.

MISS THREE STARS, TO THE MAX and KEEPA TRAMP all got back in the early stages.

Passing the 1200 metres **SIR SINGO** was steadied when **ELECTRONIC MOTION** shifted ground. D Prastiyou admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) and after hearing all submissions the JCA suspended his license to ride in all races for two days from 20 July up until and including the 1st August 2015.

ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA raced wide throughout.

LAKOTA improved wide from the 500 metre mark.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MISS THREE STARS** rider S Wynne advised she had got back further than expected when poorly away and the mare made ground fairly in the run home off a quickly run race.

Race 10 RON WILLIAMSON RATING 75 (1400m)

The start was delayed due to **RUMPELSTILTSKIN** being difficult to load into the barrier.

TAIPA TIGER was slow to begin.

FOREVER VITAL raced wide in the early and middle stages.

FASTFOOT raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1200 metre mark.

COFFEE raced keenly for a short distance passing the 900 metre mark and got its head up on a number of occasions.

COFFEE was steadied for a short distance when placed awkwardly on heels near the 600 metre mark.

TAIPA TIGER improved wide from the 500 metre mark.
