Late Scratchings Race 5 GUNNADOO at 2.53 pm at start on Stewards directive

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS MAIDEN (1600m)

Passing the 1400 metres **LOVE** was placed in restricted room when **KILMARNOCH** (R Black) which was laying inwards shifted in. Also hampered was **FAIR SPOKEN** which got its head up on a numbers of occasions when being restrained. R Black was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

LOVE over raced in the early stages.

OH SO FAMOUS raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

Passing the 900 metres **KILMARNOCH** tended to lay in.

LOVE was held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres.

Near the 500 metres **KILMARNOCH** made the bend awkwardly when laying inwards. **KILMARNOCH** continued to lay inward throughout the straight and made contact with the running rail near the 300 metres.

OH SO FAMOUS lay outwards rounding the home bend.

OH SO FAMOUS gave ground quickly from the 400 metres, eventually finishing in a distant last position. A post race veterinary inspection of **OH SO FAMOUS** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. Rider K Williams reported that **OH SO FAMOUS** had proved difficult to control throughout the running when tending to get on one rein.

Passing the 400 metres SPIDER LILY had to be straightened when laying inwards. SPIDER LILY continued to lay inwards in

the early part of the straight.

Near the 200 metres **DANSKE IN TIME** was placed in restricted room momentarily when **SPIDER LILY** which was laying in shifted inwards.

Race 2 SPEIGHTS MILE RATING 65 (1600m)

PERCY POSSUM began awkwardly.

CHIPMUNK and SHAYLEE WILDE were slow through the initial stages...

Approaching the bend near the 1300 metres, **SIR DANIEL** and **BELT UP** both commenced to race ungenerously for a short distance.

SIR DANIEL raced wide in the middle stages.

Passing the 900 metres **BELT UP** had to steady when placed in restricted room as **SIR DANIEL** (A McKay) shifted inwards. Rider A McKay was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised to exercise greater care when racing in similar circumstances in future.

Race 3 ONCEUPONATIME & PATAPAN 1600 RATING 75 (1600m)

EL BEE DEE was slow in the initial stages.

WINDWHISTLE (M Haruki) made the bend near the 1300 metres awkwardly when at the tail of the field. **WINDWHISTLE** which tailed the field throughout lost ground on the field from the 800 metres . A post race veterinary inspection of **WINDWHISTLE** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Apprentice rider M Haruki admitted a breach of Rule 636(1)(b) in that he failed to take all reasonable and permissible measures between the 800 metres and 500 metres when restraining **WINDWHISTLE** and lost ground. After hearing evidence the JCA suspended M Haruki's licence to ride at race meetings for 4 weeks effective 30 August to 26 September inclusive.

EL BEE DEE had to check when awkwardly placed on the heels of **MY CHINO** (S Wynne) which shifted outwards passing the 400 metres. Apprentice rider S Wynne admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d), with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 3 days effective 30 August to 11 September inclusive.

Race 4 PORT FM MAIDEN (1200m)

MITCHAM began awkwardly and got back.

SAIGON PRINCE bounded as the start was effected and got back as a result.

WANDERIN STAR was slow to begin.

CAROLINA ISLAND made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly and got its head up when being restrained.

WANDERIN STAR which was following also over raced for a short distance when being steadied.

SOUTHERLY CHANGE, KING KAHUNA and WHISKEY BOLERO all raced wide in the early stages.

GEE WIZZ GERRY was steadied at the 800 metres when racing ungenerously.

Passing the 600 metres **OWE THE RANSOM** which was over racing had to steady for some distance when in restricted room.

Passing the 400 metres **GEE WIZ GERRY** which was awkwardly placed on heels raced ungenerously for a short distance when being steadied.

WHISKEY BOLERO had to be straightened passing the 375 metres when shifting inwards .**WHISKEY BOLERO** continued to shift inwards throughout the straight.

WANDERIN STAR was held up early in the home straight and shifted wider to obtain clear running near the 200 metres. **GALATOIRE** was held up for a short distance on entering the home straight.

Passing the 200 metres **GEE WIZ GERRY** steadied when on the heels of **MR MOONLIGHT**, resulting in the trailing **SAIGON PRINCE** shifting across heels abruptly. **SAIGON PRINCE** in turn became awkwardly placed on the heels of **OWE THE RANSOM** and shifted inwards.

Over the concluding stages **SAIGON PRINCE** (A McKay) became awkwardly placed between **CAROLINA ISLAND** and **GEE WIZ GERRY**.

GEE WIZ GERRY was buffeted and unbalanced by **SAIGON PRINCE** for a distance short of the winning post.

After due consideration Stewards referred apprentice A McKay to the apprentice jockey mentor.

Race 5 POINT LUMBER SPRINT RATING 75 (1200m)

The start of this race was delayed when **GUNNADOO** and **MISS EL BEE DEE** broke through the barriers. **GUNNADOO** which was unable to be restrained was late scratched by the Stewards at 2.53 pm.

MISS EL BEE DEE was inspected by the veterinarian and cleared fit to race.

All other runners were unloaded and the barriers tested prior to the restart.

RESPLENDENT was slow to begin.

COUP CAPRIO raced wide in the early stages. Rider R Bishop reported that **COUP CAPRIO** made a respiratory noise passing the 700 metres. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. Co-trainer D Champion reported that the gelding appeared to have a wind affliction and it was his intention to have the gelding scoped undertaking to keep Stewards informed of any developments in coming days.

Race 6 D'CASH DASH RATING 65 (1200m)

ALLSTARS began awkwardly.

ALLSTARS and SPRINGWATER came together for a distance shortly after the start.

RED DIRT GIRL raced in restricted room passing the 500 metres, contacting a heel and blundering.

THE RIGHT ANSWER was held up rounding the home bend.

NO SURRENDA lay in under pressure early in the run home.

MANUIA raced in restricted room near the 300 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **CRAFTY LOVE** which shifted outwards.

Passing the 150 metres **SKEET** was placed in restricted room when **SPRINGWATER** shifted in under pressure, with the rider unable to fully test the mare going to the line under a hold.

Passing the 100 metres MANUIA was steadied when in tight racing room.

AMAROK was unable to find clear racing room over the concluding stages.

Near the 50 metres **NO SURRENDA** had to steady when placed in restricted room when outside runners shifted in under pressure.

SAND'IOR was steadied inside the final 50 metres when **GUARDIAN** shifted in under pressure. Rider M Cameron was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. In the shadows of the post **COUP FLYER** was steadied when **RED DIRT GIRL** shifted inwards under pressure.

Race 7 FAREWELL & HAPPY RETIREMENT TREVOR RATING 65 (2100m)

DESERT GIRL was restrained to the rear on jumping.

SEEKING REDEMPTION raced keenly in the middle stages.

DESERT GIRL improved wide from the 1200 metres.

HEZA BACHELOR was held up passing the 600 metres when in restricted room, shifting wider near the 450 metres to obtain clear running.

Passing the 300 metres **HOWLONGODWEWAIT** was held up for a short distance.
