RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LION RED 3YO
WHO CAN TELL (M Sweeney) stumbled leaving the barrier. THE SECRET'S OUT (D Johnson) lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.	
Race 2	VERO 1600
MISTAAR (M Cameron) and CHILL BILL (C Grylls) were both slow away after appearing to anticipate the start. The starter reported that after depressing the start button there had been a slight delay prior to the gates opening. After checking and cleaning electrical plugs the starting gates were re-tested and found to be functioning normally. CORNELIUS (D Johnson) over-raced in the early stages. Passing the 900 metres OLD DRUMBLE (V Gatu) was steadied when crowded to the inside of JOHN GRAY (U Holmquist) which shifted in when not fully clear. U Holmquist was advised that a warning would be placed on her record. OLD DRUMBLE shifted out near the 300 metres hampering the tiring CHILL BILL . V Gatu was advised that a warning would be placed on her record.	

Race 3	MILLS REEF WINERY & RESTAURANT 1600
<p>BLACKLISTED (A Schwerin) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers, hampering THAT'S HOW IT GOES (C Grylls). Approaching the 1400 metres SHEEMA (L Magorrian) shifted in, hampering MARIPOSA (B Hutton) which was steadied and shifted in, inconveniencing FREEWHEELER (S Collett). L Magorrian was advised that he must exercise greater care.</p> <p>Near the 1400 metres RAJASTHAN (R Elliot) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of PINZ CHARMING (M McNab) which was shifting in with RAJASTHAN then shifting in further crowding THAT'S HOW IT GOES which was checked losing ground. With Stewards taking into account the racing manners of RAJASTHAN, riders M McNab and apprentice rider R Elliot were advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. RAJASTHAN then over-raced for a distance.</p> <p>Passing the 900 metres SORORIA (D Johnson) made the bend awkwardly, shifting across the heels of MARIPOSA and was then hampered losing ground.</p> <p>THAT'S HOW IT GOES shifted out approaching the 600 metres to obtain clear running, making contact with SORORIA. LEON (S Spratt) was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight making brief contact with PINZ CHARMING. SHEEMA was also inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	CLUB MT.MAUNGANUI-OHOPE CHARTERED CLUB 1300
<p>INTO THE MYSTIC (A Collett) reared in the barriers stalls, getting its front legs over the side panel. INTO THE MYSTIC was then removed to undergo a veterinary inspection, being passed fit to run.</p> <p>TOP DRIVE (D Johnson) shifted in abruptly shortly after leaving the barrier, making contact with THE GIN KEEPER (S McKay) with that runner then shifting in making contact with INTO THE MYSTIC which as a result had to steady, losing ground.</p>	
Race 5	TAURANGA RSA-MT.MAUNGANUI RSA 1400
<p>SUNBEAM (M Coleman) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>CONRWIN (A Schwerin) shifted out on jumping away, crowding GOODN'TARG (L Magorrian).</p> <p>CONRWIN was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>TORBA (R Elliot) began awkwardly, and then shifted out abruptly, with Rider R Elliot briefly losing the use of his stirrup iron.</p> <p>TORBA raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>MISS SERENDIPITY (R Norvall) was held up until approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>FLYING RIO (A Jones) commenced to hang outwards soon after leaving the barrier, and continued to hang through the middle stages becoming tailed off passing the 600 metres. Stewards advised Trainer B Pomare a warning would be placed against the filly's racing manners, with B Pomare advising that it would be his intention to trial the filly.</p>	
Race 7	TAURANGA CITZ-TE PUKE CITZ 1200
<p>GERRY MERITO (V Colgan) began awkwardly, shifting out, crowding LIME STREET (D Johnson).</p> <p>HUG A GINGA (M Chui) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>PRESUME (T Thornton) began awkwardly, and then was further hampered by BRONDAN (S Collett) which began awkwardly and shifted out.</p> <p>GERRY MERITO became awkwardly placed on heels for a distance passing the 600 metres, having to be restrained.</p> <p>BACHATA (L Magorrian) commenced to lay in when placed under pressure passing the 300 metres, and was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. Apprentice jockey L Magorrian reported that BACHATA had felt indifferent in its action. BACHATA underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which found the gelding to be showing signs of lameness in the right hind leg, with connections being advised a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to racing again.</p>	
Race 8	WHAKATANE RSA-WAIHI BEACH RSA 2150
<p>ENURE (S Spratt) and FORT STREET DANCER (M Coleman) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>SHIMMY (S Collett) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>SPECIAL UNIT (T Thornton) lay in passing the 2000 metres having to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of ENURE.</p> <p>Trainer Mr G Rogerson advised that SHIMMY would now be spelled.</p> <p>Rider M Coleman advised that FORT STREET DANCER had found the track conditions too testing when stepping up to middle distance.</p>
