RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 THE SPRAY RIG – TE AROHA HURDLE

PIONEER (S Phelan) was slow to begin.

CARUSO (E Farr) ran the second fence down, and continued to jump indifferently throughout.

BIG MEADSY (A Kuru) jumped the fence near the 2400 metres awkwardly.

BIG MEADSY shifted out when jumping the fence near the 1400 metres, inconveniencing **PIONEER** which then jumped the fence near the 1200 metres awkwardly.

HUNTERS CREEK (M Gillies) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 400 metres, landing awkwardly.

ARAKI (D Miller) jumped the fence near the 400 metres poorly when well back.

YARDARM (M Mitchell) and ZAVAMAR (C Studd) came together on a number of occasions over the final 75 metres.

BIG MEADSY returned to the enclosure with a minor laceration to the off hind coronet.

Race 2 MORONEY DIAMOND WEDDING ANNIVERSARY HURDLE

SILVERADO (R Cole) was slow to begin.

BRACHETTO (H McNeill) was slow to begin, and was further hampered.

YARDSTICK (M Mitchell) put in a poor jump at the first fence.

HAZY DAZE (M Gillies) ducked out approaching the first fence, hampering **CANDIDLY** (S Phelan). **HAZY DAZE** then put in a poor jump and landed awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced, losing the use of his left stirrup iron.

HAZY DAZE then shifted in when Rider M Gillies was trying to regain the stirrup iron, badly hampering GLAMOUR ROY

BRACHETTO raced ungenerously when being steadied after jumping the second fence.

BAHHTON (E Farr) raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

SIR AL SYD (G Walsh) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

CANDIDLY put in a poor jump at the last fence, landing awkwardly.

Race 3 WAIHOU TAVERN HURDLE

BIG BROWNIE (S Phelan) was slow to begin.

D'LLARO (A Kuru) jumped indifferently throughout.

MAHANADI (S Fannin) landed awkwardly after jumping the second fence in the back straight on the last occasion.

MAHANADI jumped the third fence down the back straight on the last occasion awkwardly.

D'LLARO jumped the last fence poorly landing awkwardly and losing momentum.

Race 4 MARTIN & PEG GLEESON MEMORIAL 2200

CRUISEO (T Harris) was obliged to race three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

THE TALISMAN (M Mitchell) and **CRUISEO** were both inclined to shift out under pressure in the final straight with **EYESLUCKY** (C Studd) being inconvenienced and having to change ground.

Following the race the rider of the third placed horse **EYESLUCKY** C Studd wished to view Stewards footage alleging interference in the home straight, electing not to proceed with an objection.

M Mitchell (THE TALISMAN) was reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 5 NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY CENTRE 2200

FLAVOUR FLAV (C Studd), RAISAFUASHO (N Quinn) and MAN O' MANN (L Kennedy) were all slow to begin.

NOTABADROOSTER (E Farr) was inclined to race greenly in the final straight.

Race 6 TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES STEEPLE

STAGEHAND (R Cole) was slow to begin.

NOAH JON (M Mitchell) was inclined to run its fences down throughout.

WAITOKI AHI (A Tata) was hampered when jumping the last fence in the straight on the first occasion.

STAGEHAND who had been jumping indifferently, put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres, unbalancing rider R Cole who lost the use of his stirrup irons. **STAGEHAND** was then retired from the race.

RIMROCK (C Studd) was retired before jumping the third to last fence near the 700 metres.

WAITOKI AHI put in a poor jump at the fence near the 700 metres losing momentum.

NOAH JON ran the last fence down, and as a result ran wide on the track.

STAGEHAND lost the near fore plate during the running.

Race 7 HOUSE OF TRAVEL STEEPLE

GO JIMMY GO (E Farr) was inclined to run the first fence down making contact with **JOKING** (M Mitchell) which became unbalanced. **GO JIMMY GO** then ran the second fence down, jumping into the line of **JOKING** which was hampered. **GO JIMMY GO** continued to run its fences down ran down, hampering **GOOSEBUMPS** (M Gillies) at the first and second fences in the straight on the first occasion.

JOKING became awkwardly placed on heels when approaching the fence near the 1800 metres and jumped the fence poorly as a result.

SINISTA (R Cole) was pulled up after jumping the fence near the 700 metres.

GOOSEBUMPS knuckled on landing when jumping the second to last fence.

Race 8 TE AROHA TRACTOR & GARDEN MACHINERY 1600

THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (D Miller) and HIGH DISDAIN (S Phelan) were both slow to begin.

Passing the 1000 metres **TINY BIT BIG** (G Walsh) faltered and shifted out, crowding **BIG 'N' RICH** (S Fannin) out on to the hind quarters of **JUSTABOUT READY** (D Nolan) which then became unbalanced and lay in, further crowding **JUSTABOUT READY**. **TINY BIT BIG** was then pulled up quickly by its rider.

BIG 'N' RICH shifted out becoming awkwardly placed passing the 400 metres. **BIG 'N' RICH** then shifted back in near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

TINY BIT BIG sustained a pelvic injury and was taken off the course for further veterinary assessment and subsequently euthanased.

Race 9 SOUTH AUSTRALIAN RACING 1600

TOFINO (H McNeill) and SUGGEST GOLD (D Miller) were both slow to begin.

Rider E Farr (WORTHISWAITNGOLD) was reprimanded regarding her victory salute near the winning post.

A Tata (**GOLD HUNTER**) was reprimanded regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record.

ALICORN underwent a veterinary examination following the race which found the mare to have a slow recovery and signs of a possible respiratory infection.
