## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>KELLY &amp; ASSOCIATES 2YO</b>
<p><b>GLENCOYNE (D Bradley)</b> began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p><b>EEPA NEEMA (N Teeluck)</b> had to be steadied off the heels of <b>MISS FI (R Hannam)</b> near the 800 metres when <b>MISS FI</b> shifted in when marginally clear. Contributing to the incident was outward movement from <b>BARE WITH (L Hemi)</b>. <b>EEPA NEEMA</b>, when being steadied shifted outwards tightening <b>GLENGOYNE, LONG SHOT (M Dravitzki)</b> and <b>MASTER PLATINUM (J Riddell)</b> which became unbalanced. <b>R Hannam</b> was advised to exercise more care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p><b>C Johnson</b> reported <b>PROUD ZOE</b> was not comfortable in the Heavy 11 track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MIDWEST DISPOSALS HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>AUTHENTIC PADDY (D Bradley)</b> jumped inwards leaving the barrier crowding <b>ST RANSOM (R Hannam)</b> and <b>MAROTIRI MISS (C Johnson)</b> which settled back.</p> <p><b>MAROTIRI MISS</b> shifted out under pressure over the final stages which resulted in <b>AUTHENTIC PADDY</b> having to be steadied.</p> <p><b>R Hannam (ST RANSOM)</b> was reminded of his obligation with regard to his whip use prior to the 200 metres when marginally outside the guideline.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>RURAL FUEL 3YO</b>
<p><b>LASTROLLOFTHE DICE (R Hannam)</b> jumped inwards leaving the barrier hampering <b>DAL SIR TEE (T Johnson)</b> which lost ground.</p> <p><b>LEEDS (J Riddell)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>LASTROLLOFTHE DICE</b> was angled wider near the 900 metres in search of better going.</p> <p><b>ACQUISTO (L Hemi)</b> shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p>	

Race 4	<b>RICHARDS CONSTRUCTION HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>KENNYS CHANCE (N Teeluck)</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>THE GRADUATE (D Mo)</b> and <b>IT'S A WONDER (M Dravitzki)</b> both began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>VEGA (C Johnson)</b> shifted out under pressure near the 250 metres and bumped with <b>CHAIROS (R Hannam)</b></p> <p><b>D Bradley</b> reported that after over-racing in the early and middle stages <b>LET ME THINK</b> had little left in the home straight. When questioned into the disappointing run of <b>DOIKNOWYOU</b> rider <b>J Riddell</b> said the gelding travelled reasonably well in the going through the early and middle stages but found the home straight too testing. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	<b>MANAWATU OFFICE PRODUCTS MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>HEAVENS KEEP (R Goldsbury)</b> and <b>BELIEVE IN ME (M Singh)</b> came together leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>ST JUNE (K Chiong)</b> shifted out leaving the barriers crowding <b>BARTHEZ (L Hemi)</b> and <b>OUR SPICE (C Johnson)</b> which lost ground.</p> <p><b>FROCK (R Hannam)</b> and <b>MASTER PATRICK (M Dravitzki)</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>HEAVENS KEEP</b> over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>BELIEVE IN ME</b> shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip near the 300 metres hampering <b>BATHEZ</b>.</p>	
Race 6	<b>BJW MOTORS HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>KING VICTOR (R Goldsbury)</b> jumped outwards leaving the barrier hampering <b>CORNELIUS (D Bradley)</b></p> <p><b>CORNELIUS</b> then commenced to over-race through the early stages.</p> <p><b>CONROY (J Riddell)</b> and <b>DOUBLE OH SEVEN (R Hannam)</b> bumped several times in the home straight when both runners shifted ground under pressure.</p>	
Race 7	<b>J&amp;J WALTERS HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>MISS LIGHTNING (L Hemi); NOM DE BOSS (J Riddell)</b> and <b>CAUGHT BEHIND (M Singh)</b> bumped at the start.</p> <p><b>KERMIT (T Johnson)</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>SUPERCEDE (D Bradley)</b> had to be steadied on the point of the home turn when racing in restricted room to the inside of <b>KERMIT</b> which shifted in. T Johnson was advised to exercise care.</p> <p><b>KERMIT</b> shifted ground outwards under pressure over the final stages and near the 150 metres hampered <b>MR INK (M Dravitzki)</b>.</p> <p>Prior to the authorisation of dividends, the connections of the third place <b>SUPERCEDE</b> after viewing footage of the final straight elected not to lodge an objection against the second placed <b>KERMIT</b>. Apprentice jockey <b>T Johnson</b> was issued a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) regarding his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>R Goldsbury</b> reported that <b>ALARINDA</b> did not handle the Heavy 11 track.</p>	
Race 8	<b>COOMBE SMITH RANGITIKEI LTD HANDICAP</b>
<p>Connections of <b>BEEBEE STAR</b> sought and were given permission to remove the blinkers due to the track conditions.</p> <p><b>ACUTELYGOLD (C Johnson)</b> raced keenly in the lead in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>HANDLEMEWITHCARE (M Singh)</b> and <b>DANCE IN THE PARK (L Hemi)</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>M Dravitzki</b> the rider of <b>LET'S</b> was unbalanced when hit in the face by a turf clod near the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>SPECIAL BID (R Goldsbury)</b> had to change ground near the 600 metres when unable to make ground wide so was then angled inwards to continue to improve.</p> <p>Near the 250 metres <b>ANOTHER BACHELOR (N Teeluck)</b> shifted ground inwards under pressure and in so doing bumped with <b>GYPSY STAR (D Bradley)</b>.</p>
