EL ENCANTO (race 2) and **RAROONEY** (race 3) had both been incorrectly handicapped at 56.5 kgs when the correct weight for both runners being geldings was 58.5 kgs. This error was rectified on Saturday 27 June and advertised through appropriate channels.

2 CHACHAR – At start, 11.32 am

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 FARMERS DAY 1400

CAILEAG was late scratched at 10.30 am due to transport difficulties en route to the racecourse.

Apprentice **L Magorrian** was issued a minor infringement notice and fined \$200 for being unable to claim down to his published riding weight.

NULLA CREEK (B Hutton) and GOLDCHI (T Thornton) were both slow to begin.

MY SHANTILLY (A Jones) over-raced badly in the early and middle stages having to be firmly restrained approaching the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **LADY FERNER** (M Sweeney).

NULLA CREEK was crowded losing ground approaching the 400 metres when **REAL WINNERS** (M McNab) shifted out and **TINGED WITH GOLD** (R Elliot) shifted in slightly. Rider M McNab was issued with a warning for the manner in which he shifted ground.

LOUVRES (M Dravitzki) was held up rounding the final bend having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running until passing the 300 metres.

TINGED WITH GOLD raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 2 100TH ANNIVERSARY WAIPA 4 OCTOBER 2015 1150

CHACHAR (R Goldsbury) was a late scratching at 11:32 am after refusing to enter the barriers. The stable representative

was advised that CHACHAR must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

VENTURA (M McNab) was slow to begin.

VIAAGO (C Grylls) began awkwardly.

Shortly after the start LA VAMOS (D Hain) was steadied when placed in restricted room.

DON'T STOP ME NOW (S McKay) was inclined to lay in throughout the running.

VIAAGO commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 900 metres, and continued to over-race through the middle stages.

Race 3 MAGNUM INDUSTRY 1150

RAROONEY (T Thornton) was slow to begin.

RAROONEY when being steadied dropped back on to **TRANKY DOO** (D Johnson) which was hampered approaching the 700 metres

LOLOTEA (M McNab) made the bend passing the 700 metres awkwardly when laying out forcing **MALINA** (M Dravitzki) over extra ground.

RAROONEY was held up rounding the final bend.

ZEDSATIONAL (L Magorrian) was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **LOLOTEA** which was eased down in the final straight rider M McNab advised Stewards that he had difficulty steering the filly throughout the running. Co-trainer Mr B Hawtin advised that the filly was now likely to be retired. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Following the running of this race the track was downgraded to Slow(9) retrospective to race 3.

Race 4 KITCHEN EQUATION 2000

SOUTHERNMAN (R Elliot) was very slow to begin (12L). A warning was placed on **SOUTHERNMAN'S** barrier manners. Cotrainer, Mr Rogerson, advised that he would be removing the blinkers from its gear.

SIR AL SYD (C Grylls) began awkwardly.

BEACH BABE (L Magorrian) shifted in on jumping away crowding EYESLUCKY (M Hills).

THE HAWK (P Holmes) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

FOUR DAY HIGH (M Cameron) lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

SPECIAL UNIT (B Hutton) shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages, and blundered just short of the finish inconveniencing **SOUTHERNMAN**.

Race 5 QUBIK 2000

DEAGON (M McNab) and **ST RHYTHM** (L Magorrian) were both slow to begin.

MAGIC MEMORIES (V Gatu) shifted out on jumping away crowding **LABELS** (B Hutton), **SOUTHERN COUNTESS** (A Schwerin) and **THE NOTT** (R Goldsbury) with all those runners losing ground.

Apprentice A Jones (**SOPHISTICATE**) dropped her whip passing the 1900 metres.

Race 6 JF GRYLLS MEMORIAL CLASSIC

HEISTHEONE (R Smyth) and THE SHACKLER (B Hutton) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

THE SHACKLER (B Hutton) over-raced in the early stages, racing ungenerously when being restrained shortly after the start and shifting outwards abruptly to avoid heels. **THE SHACKLER** was then allowed to improve forward to race outside the leader where it continued to over-race during the middle stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of **THEE ACHIEVER** rider D Johnson advised Stewards that the mare did not handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination of **THEE ACHIEVER** revealed slight lameness in the off foreleg.

Apprentice B Hutton was fined \$225 by the Judicial Committee for failing to ride his mount **THE SHACKLER** out to the end of the race when having a reasonable chance of finishing fifth.

Race 7 EDWARDS ENGINEERING SERVICES LTD 1150

CONRWIN (A Schwerin) jumped away awkwardly further hampering **MR KNOWITALL** (S McKay) which had been slow away. **SHEBANG** (M Cameron) and **THE CANON** (M Dravitzki) were both slow to begin.

When questioned about the performance of **SHEBANG** rider M Cameron advised Stewards that the mare may be better suited to looser track conditions.

Race 8 POWER FARMING 1580

MARANUI (S Collett) and NOTTOOBAD (T Thornton) came together on jumping away.

FAIR FLEET (B Hutton) was slow to begin.

Race 9 PGG WRIGHTSONS 1400

NIGHEAN (R Smyth) was slow to begin.

ARANMORE (C Grylls) was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **APACHEE TAAT** (B Hutton) passing the 1200 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BUFFALO LASS** apprentice A Jones advised that in her opinion **BUFFALO LASS** would be better suited over 1200 metres.

Race 10 TE AWAMUTU TYRE CENTRE 1400

MIHAIA (D Johnson) got its head up when being restrained going into the bend near the 1200 metres.

I'MDAONE (D Hain), HE'S A BIGDEEL (M Cameron) and MIHAIA which were all racing keenly going into the bend near the 1200 metres had to be steadied when I'MDAONE became awkwardly placed inside the heels of CHECKOUTTHEMISSES (V Gatu) which shifted in slightly, with HE'S A BIGDEEL losing ground. Contributing to the incident was some outward movement from RUSTANA (B Hutton). V Gatu was issued with a warning and advised to ensure that she is fully clear when shifting ground in future.

Apprentice A Jones reported that her mount **HEEZA DREIMER** had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.
