Race 1	A & C SURVEYS MAIDEN 2200
<p>BIG GAV reared as the gates opened losing ground.</p> <p>THE OYSTERMAN was crowded shortly after the start and got back.</p> <p>JUST COLLIE was steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 1,800 metres when inside COOL WONDER which shifted in and away from HAZY DAZE.</p> <p>KINGS KITE raced wide from the 1,000 metres.</p> <p>COOL WONDER was crowded and had to steady approaching the 500 metres when inside ZEDACE which was crowded inward by THE OYSTERMAN (M Singh) which when laying in shifted in. Apprentice M Singh was issued with a warning and told that he must make greater effort to correct his mounts when in similar circumstances.</p> <p>ZEDACE lay in passing the 300 metres having to be straightened.</p> <p>THE OYSTERMAN raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of HEZANAKILAD Rider J Parkes reported the gelding had been unable to quicken when pressured, and attributed this to the holding nature of today's track.</p>	
Race 2	STEELFORM ROOFING GROUP 2YO 1100
<p>GILLY MAN and LIAPARI both began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MORRIS LASS made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly shifting out.</p> <p>WESTERN was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight dictating JIGSAW out over extra ground.</p>	

SHOW FAR SHOW GOOD was awkwardly placed near the heels of JIGSAW passing the 250 metres.	
Race 3	GO THE MIGHTY VODAFONE WARRIORS MAIDEN 1200
REDFOO was declared a late scratching at 11.28am on veterinary advice after becoming very fractious in the stalls and sustaining a laceration to the off-hind leg. LADY TAVISTOCK was slow to begin. BROKEN BELT was momentarily held up passing the 400 metres behind the weakening SIR HIKO .	
Race 4	BRUCE PATTERSON CLASSIC 1200
FOXCUB was slow to begin. SCARLET LETTER blundered on jumping losing ground. BY THE POWERS began awkwardly shifting out crowding TIHI KEEPA outwards onto PHONE GIRL with PHONE GIRL losing ground. BOXAMOSA raced wide without cover throughout. RALPH'S GIFT and PHONE GIRL came together passing the 250 metres.	
Race 5	ECOLAB CARL GRAHAM MEMORIAL 1200
PHILIPA CHARLOTTE began awkwardly and was then crowded when runners either side shifted ground. NOVA SCOTIA was slow to begin. I SUGGEST made contact with the running rail passing the 800 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of DON'T BLAME BUSTER . DON'T BLAME BUSTER was held up for a short distance rounding the final bend. SUPERCEDE was momentarily held up passing the 350 metres having to shift outwards to obtain clear running. JUDI ANNE shifted out slightly rounding the final turn making contact with ARCHANGEL which in turn shifted out contacting the hind-quarters of MR INK with MR INK becoming unbalanced and then laying in.	
Race 6	RD1 WAVERLEY OPEN 1200
DAIELLO was slow to begin. UNBELIEVEABELLE after being fractious in the barrier began awkwardly. SALAMANCA was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of PASHA SUMORE passing the 1,000 metres. THE LONE RANGER was held up making the final bend having to shift out entering the final straight to obtain clear running, THE LONE RANGER was then inclined to shift ground outwards when placed under pressure inside the final 200 metres.	
Race 7	GENETIC TECHNOLOGIES 3YO 1400
MASTER PATRICK and FROCK were slow to begin. THE BEST MAN became awkwardly placed on the heels of ROSSINI GIRL approaching the 600 metres and when being steadied came back on to ONEFORTHE DITCH which lost momentum. ONEFORTHE DITCH was held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight was taken wider in search of clear running, however this did not eventuate so the filly was then taken inwards passing the 150 metres to improve. ARYA and SEA CRUISER shifted ground under pressure in the final straight and brushed near the 50 metres.	
Race 8	TRACTOR & MACHINERY HIRE 1400
KUZANOV , OUTOFTIME and ROYAL HAZE were slow to begin.	
Race 9	ALLAN BARNES 65TH BIRTHDAY BASH 1650
HIPPIE was slow to begin and then over-raced in the early and middle stages. SPENDAHOLIC shifted outwards under pressure approaching the 200 metres dictating ARZAK out wider on the track. PERFECTLY ENCHANTED was briefly held up passing the 250 metres.

MISS DEJAVU jumped in abruptly at the start. BROADWAY ROSE began very awkwardly losing ground. ARMANDO had to be steadied passing the 1,300 metres when in restricted room.

PACIFIC BELLE was slow to begin. LUAS after becoming fractious in the barriers and was slow away. TIME BOMB began awkwardly shifting in making contact with O'CEIRINS WHISPER . LUAS over-raced in the early and middle stages. CHANTILLY LASS was inclined to lay out rounding the final bend. JED CLAMPETT lay in rounding the final bend and throughout the final straight.
