RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WEALLEANS ALLIED PETROLEUM HURDLE
<p>FLYING COSSACK (S Karnicnik) jumped indifferently throughout. SILVERADO (R Cole) jumped the third fence awkwardly. HUNTERS CREEK (M Gillies) misjudged the fifth fence situated near the 2000 metres and landed awkwardly, dislodging its rider. Both horse and rider were uninjured. WEST END (E Farr) misjudged the third last fence. SILVERADO put in a poor jump at the third last fence.</p>	
Race 2	WEALLEANS GROUNSPREAD HURDLE
<p>COMTE DE JEU (A Tata) over-raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages. READY EDDIE (M Mitchell) put in a poor jump at the fourth fence and landed awkwardly. FIELD DAZE (S Fannin) reached for the fence near the 1400 metres. ISTIMAGIC (T Harris) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1100 metres and commenced to give ground. FIELD DAZE landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 900 metres. READY EDDIE put in a poor jump at the fence near the 900 metres. READY EDDIE badly misjudged the third last fence almost falling.</p>	

D'LLARO (A Kuru) hit the second last fence and jumped the final fence poorly	
Race 3	McDONALDS LIME LTD 2YO
<p>ROCKET NAVIGATOR (V Gatu) and YOUWANTMORE (M McNab) were slow away. ROC ME (B Hutton) lay out rounding the final turn and ducked outwards abruptly near the 400 metres and continued to race greenly for the remainder. THE DOM (A Jones) raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	REPOROA GROUNDSREAD 2200
<p>BEVERLEY BECK (A Jones) jumped away awkwardly. THENAMESBOND (V Gatu) commenced to shift outwards under pressure approaching the 300 metres making contact with IZ (BR Jones) on a number of occasions until passing the 150 metres. Apprentice V Gatu was reprimanded and advised that a warning would be placed on her record. SECRETARY OF STATE (T Thornton) shifted outwards under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	FERTCO 3500 STEEPLECHASE
<p>SPACE ODDITY (C Studd) jumped indifferently in the early stages being inclined to run down its fences. SPACE ODDITY was then retired from the race prior to the fifth fence. Rider C Studd advised the gelding had jumped poorly and had felt indifferent in its action after landing awkwardly at the third fence. SPACE ODDITY underwent a post race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. STAGEHAND (R Cole) misjudged the fence near the 1600 metres hampering KICK BACK (S Fannin). MANGAROA HUSTLER (M Mitchell) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1600 metres. AROSE (E Farr) was hampered at the fence near the 700 metres jumping outwards hampering RIMROCK (D Miller). STAGEHAND misjudged the send last fence dislodging rider R Cole who was uninjured. MANGAROA HUSTLER returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils undergoing a veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination which confirmed the gelding as a bleeder now being subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing. MANGAROA HUSTLER was also found to have suffered a tendon injury to the left foreleg. Trainer Mrs A Browne indicated that MANGAROA HUSTLER was now likely to be retired.</p>	
Race 6	GROUNDSREAD LTD 3500 STEEPLECHASE
<p>MISTER DEEJAY (C Studd) jumped the first fence awkwardly. MISTER DEEJAY ran down the second fence badly and put in a poor jump hampering TOM'S MYTH (S Fannin). MISTER DEEJAY continued to run down its fences for the remainder of the race being retired from the event prior to the second last fence when well beaten. TOM'S MYTH then jumped indifferently throughout. GO JIMMY GO (R Cole) misjudged the fence near the 1600 metres and fell. Both horse and rider were uninjured. GOOSEBUMPS (D Miller) and ROSETOWN JOE (S Karnicnik) put in poor jumps at the fence near the 1200 metres. JACK ROMANOV (M Mitchell) jumped the final fence awkwardly.</p>	
Race 7	WESTERN BAY GROUNDSREAD 1400
<p>HIGH DISDAIN (S McKay) and FOR FASHION (S Collett) were slow away. BE YOURSELF (T Thornton) and SUM FAVOUR (D Hain) were crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. DINAH LEE (M McNab) made contact with LEON (S Spratt) when shifting outwards to improve approaching the 600 metres. SUM FAVOUR shifted outwards when placed under pressure passing the 400 metres hampering KEEP IN FASHION (BR Jones). D Hain was issued with a warning. Rider M McNab (DINAH LEE) was issued a warning for using his whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 8	WEALLEANS BAY OF PLENTY 1600
<p>CARDON BOY (R Smyth) jumped outwards at the start crowding SHE'S ALL CLANG (M McNab) onto MAN DOWN (B Hutton) which lost ground. DOUCETTE (U Holmquist) shifted inwards abruptly leaving the barriers further hampering DEAGON (Z Moki) which had begun awkwardly. SINGAPORE GIRL (T Thornton) was pulled up by its rider after going amiss near the 1300 metres. SINGAPORE GIRL was humanely euthanased by the veterinarian as it was found to have suffered a fracture to the right hind leg. SHE'S ALL CLANG shifted outwards under pressure over the final 200 metres.</p>
