## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>JUMPING SUPPORTERS HURDLES</b>
<p><b>ISHIDANZIN</b> (M Mitchell) put in a poor jump at the second fence and dislodged the rider who was uninjured.</p> <p><b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> hit the first fence in the back straight on the second round.</p> <p><b>IVENOIDA</b> returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils with a subsequent veterinary examination confirming the gelding as a bleeder and as a result is now ineligible to race for the mandatory three month period.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>JUMPING SUPPORTERS HURDLES</b>
<p><b>GOLD MIST</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>KICK BACK</b> misjudged the fence near the 2100 metres and fell dislodging rider M Gillies who was uninjured.</p> <p><b>GET FLASH</b> momentarily hampered <b>HEMINGWAY</b> when shifting ground after jumping the last fence.</p> <p><b>GOLD MIST</b> was inclined to run down its fences throughout the final straight.</p> <p><b>PROLOGUE</b> shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>THE LISA NEYLON PHOTOGRAPHIC TRUST STEEPLECHASE</b>
<p><b>IN FOR FUN</b> was declared a late scratching due to there being no suitable rider.</p> <p><b>STORMIN NORMAN</b> over raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>STORMIN NORMAN</b> jumped outwards at the fence near the 300 metres crowding <b>WILBUR</b> outwards on to <b>RIPDIDDLER</b>.</p>	

<p><b>RIPDIDDLER</b> and <b>STORMIN NORMAN</b> came together and bumped after jumping the second last fence. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>STUERTZER</b> which finished last, rider C Studd stated in his opinion the mare jumped well throughout but when placed under pressure passing the 800 metres failed to respond and was disappointing. C Studd also stated that the mare was making a respiratory noise on returning to the enclosure. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>HYPNOTISE STEEPLECHASE</b>
<p><b>AUTHENTIC</b> jumped the second last fence awkwardly.  <b>ELECTRICLITE</b> was retired from the event after jumping the fence near the 800 metres when well back and out of contention. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of <b>ELECTRICLITE</b> which revealed near fore leg flexor tendon damage. Trainer M Oulaghan advised the gelding is retired.  <b>VOLKSWAGIN</b> disappointed and was withdrawn from the contest passing the 700 metres when out of contention. Rider S Phelan was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to a more rain affected track as it appeared to be feeling the ground. Trainer J Wheeler advised that <b>VOLKSWAGIN</b> may be retired. Stewards ordered an examination of <b>VOLKSWAGIN</b> which failed to reveal any abnormality.  <b>ROODYVOO</b> failed to finish the race off as expected and finished well back. Rider S Fannin said the gelding may be better suited to a more rain affected track.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>REMBRANDT MOTEL 2100</b>
<p><b>PRESTIGIOSA</b> was slow to begin and was further hampered when <b>HEADCASE</b> which had begun awkwardly shifted in. <b>MR DEEJAY</b> began awkwardly and lost ground.  <b>TIZZA SECRET</b> and <b>LADY'O</b> came together and bumped on jumping away.  <b>HOUNDSCRY</b> was slow to begin.  Approaching the crossing near the 1800 metres <b>PRESTIGIOSA</b> improved up on to the heels of <b>MR DEEJAY</b> and when being steadied shifted in making contact with the gap rail which became dislodged. The rail was replaced immediately by staff who were present.  <b>GAGARIN</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.  <b>TIZZA SECRET</b> shifted out under pressure in the home straight and bumped <b>GAGARIN</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BIG BLADE HEDGE CUTTING &amp; SILAGE MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>KINGS KITE</b> jumped outwards abruptly at the start making heavy contact with <b>I'M YOUR MAN</b> which became unbalanced. <b>WEE BISKIT</b> was slow away.  <b>IT'S A WONDER</b> over raced in the early stages passing the winning post on the first occasion had to be restrained when awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>ZCASTLE</b>.  <b>ZCASTLE</b> raced wide in the early stages until obtaining cover near the 1200 metres.  <b>Rider M Dee</b> (WEE BISKIT) lost his whip near the 100 metres.  <b>Rider M Dravitzki</b> (I'M YOUR MAN) was spoken to regarding her use of the whip on a runner out of contention.  <b>Rider J Parkes</b> (IT'S A WONDER, 3rd place) advised the gelding only battled in the home straight and had no real excuse. Trainer K Gray attributed the winner's (<b>ZCASTLE</b>) improved performance to the better track conditions.  When questioned into the performance of <b>KINGS KITE</b> rider <b>C Dell</b> stated in his opinion the gelding would be better suited to a more rain affected track. Stewards ordered <b>KINGS KITE</b> undergo a veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>CHILLCO MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>PRINCESS PADOZA</b> was slow to begin.  <b>FERNLIN</b> began awkwardly and made contact with <b>SAINT REMI</b>.  <b>PRINCESS PADOZA</b> over raced in the early stages and near the 800 metres when being restrained shifted in abruptly making contact with the running rail. Rider J Parkes reported that the mare had raced greenly throughout.  <b>CARLEEN</b> commenced to over race near the 800 metres and made the first bend awkwardly shifting out forcing <b>SYDNEY CARTON</b> over extra ground.  <b>FERNLIN</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.  <b>SAINT REMI</b> was briefly held up entering the home straight.  <b>UNICO</b> raced greenly under pressure over the final 100 metres.  <b>UNICO</b> had minor abrasions to the hind legs on returning to the enclosure.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES / NZI INSURANCE 1400</b>
<p><b>Trainer G McBeth</b> was fined \$50 after presenting <b>SIR GONZALES</b> without notified gear  <b>TRANSLUCENCE</b> was slow to begin.</p>	

**LORD CASANOVA** raced three wide without cover throughout.  
**HOSTAGE** had to be angled in across the heels of **OLLIE'S NOTE** passing the 100 metres to improve.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>RICH HILL STUD TARANAKI BREEDERS SAT OCT 11<sup>TH</sup> MAIDEN</b>
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**UNREEL** was late scratched prior to the first event on veterinary advice. Trainer J Wheeler was advised that a clearance is required.

**SKYBIRD** began awkwardly.

**NIPPA MARY** and **YOUNGSYD** were slow to begin.

**COOLANGATTA** was inclined to get its head up and raced greenly throughout.

**GOLDEN EMPEROR** raced three wide throughout.

**YOUNGSYD** raced wide without cover throughout.

**YOUNGSYD** lay in under pressure passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.
