RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JUMPING SUPPORTERS HURDLES
<p>ISHIDANZIN (M Mitchell) put in a poor jump at the second fence and dislodged the rider who was uninjured. OUR ALCHEMIST hit the first fence in the back straight on the second round. IVENOIDA returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils with a subsequent veterinary examination confirming the gelding as a bleeder and as a result is now ineligible to race for the mandatory three month period.</p>	
Race 2	JUMPING SUPPORTERS HURDLES
<p>GOLD MIST raced keenly in the early and middle stages. KICK BACK misjudged the fence near the 2100 metres and fell dislodging rider M Gillies who was uninjured. GET FLASH momentarily hampered HEMINGWAY when shifting ground after jumping the last fence. GOLD MIST was inclined to run down its fences throughout the final straight. PROLOGUE shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.</p>	
Race 3	THE LISA NEYLON PHOTOGRAPHIC TRUST STEEPLECHASE
<p>IN FOR FUN was declared a late scratching due to there being no suitable rider. STORMIN NORMAN over raced in the early and middle stages. STORMIN NORMAN jumped outwards at the fence near the 300 metres crowding WILBUR outwards on to RIPDIDDLER.</p>	

<p>RIPDIDDLER and STORMIN NORMAN came together and bumped after jumping the second last fence. When questioned regarding the performance of STUERTZER which finished last, rider C Studd stated in his opinion the mare jumped well throughout but when placed under pressure passing the 800 metres failed to respond and was disappointing. C Studd also stated that the mare was making a respiratory noise on returning to the enclosure. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 4	HYPNOTISE STEEPLECHASE
<p>AUTHENTIC jumped the second last fence awkwardly. ELECTRICLITE was retired from the event after jumping the fence near the 800 metres when well back and out of contention. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of ELECTRICLITE which revealed near fore leg flexor tendon damage. Trainer M Oulaghan advised the gelding is retired. VOLKSWAGIN disappointed and was withdrawn from the contest passing the 700 metres when out of contention. Rider S Phelan was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to a more rain affected track as it appeared to be feeling the ground. Trainer J Wheeler advised that VOLKSWAGIN may be retired. Stewards ordered an examination of VOLKSWAGIN which failed to reveal any abnormality. ROODYVOO failed to finish the race off as expected and finished well back. Rider S Fannin said the gelding may be better suited to a more rain affected track.</p>	
Race 5	REMBRANDT MOTEL 2100
<p>PRESTIGIOSA was slow to begin and was further hampered when HEADCASE which had begun awkwardly shifted in. MR DEEJAY began awkwardly and lost ground. TIZZA SECRET and LADY'O came together and bumped on jumping away. HOUNDSCRY was slow to begin. Approaching the crossing near the 1800 metres PRESTIGIOSA improved up on to the heels of MR DEEJAY and when being steadied shifted in making contact with the gap rail which became dislodged. The rail was replaced immediately by staff who were present. GAGARIN raced three wide without cover throughout. TIZZA SECRET shifted out under pressure in the home straight and bumped GAGARIN.</p>	
Race 6	BIG BLADE HEDGECUTTING & SILAGE MAIDEN
<p>KINGS KITE jumped outwards abruptly at the start making heavy contact with I'M YOUR MAN which became unbalanced. WEE BISKIT was slow away. IT'S A WONDER over raced in the early stages passing the winning post on the first occasion had to be restrained when awkwardly placed inside the heels of ZCASTLE. ZCASTLE raced wide in the early stages until obtaining cover near the 1200 metres. Rider M Dee (WEE BISKIT) lost his whip near the 100 metres. Rider M Dravitzki (I'M YOUR MAN) was spoken to regarding her use of the whip on a runner out of contention. Rider J Parkes (IT'S A WONDER, 3rd place) advised the gelding only battled in the home straight and had no real excuse. Trainer K Gray attributed the winner's (ZCASTLE) improved performance to the better track conditions. When questioned into the performance of KINGS KITE rider C Dell stated in his opinion the gelding would be better suited to a more rain affected track. Stewards ordered KINGS KITE undergo a veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 7	CHILLCO MAIDEN
<p>PRINCESS PADOZA was slow to begin. FERNLIN began awkwardly and made contact with SAINT REMI. PRINCESS PADOZA over raced in the early stages and near the 800 metres when being restrained shifted in abruptly making contact with the running rail. Rider J Parkes reported that the mare had raced greenly throughout. CARLEEN commenced to over race near the 800 metres and made the first bend awkwardly shifting out forcing SYDNEY CARTON over extra ground. FERNLIN raced three wide without cover throughout. SAINT REMI was briefly held up entering the home straight. UNICO raced greenly under pressure over the final 100 metres. UNICO had minor abrasions to the hind legs on returning to the enclosure.</p>	
Race 8	LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES / NZI INSURANCE 1400
<p>Trainer G McBeth was fined \$50 after presenting SIR GONZALES without notified gear TRANSLUCENCE was slow to begin.</p>	

LORD CASANOVA raced three wide without cover throughout.

HOSTAGE had to be angled in across the heels of **OLLIE'S NOTE** passing the 100 metres to improve.

Race 9

RICH HILL STUD TARANAKI BREEDERS SAT OCT 11TH MAIDEN

UNREEL was late scratched prior to the first event on veterinary advice. Trainer J Wheeler was advised that a clearance is required.

SKYBIRD began awkwardly.

NIPPA MARY and **YOUNGSYD** were slow to begin.

COOLANGATTA was inclined to get its head up and raced greenly throughout.

GOLDEN EMPEROR raced three wide throughout.

YOUNGSYD raced wide without cover throughout.

YOUNGSYD lay in under pressure passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.
