RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 RAWHITI HORT 1200

MISS SERENDIPITY (R Norvall), DYLAN DE LAGO (M McNab) and RAROONEY (T Thornton) were slow to begin.

MALONE (O Bosson) and BELLA MOSSA (R Smyth) came together leaving the barriers.

PINZ CHARMING (R Hannam) began awkwardly.

I'LL STAND BY YOU (U Holmquist) got its head up when being restrained near the 1100 metres and raced ungenerously. I'LL STAND BY YOU then shifted inwards when continuing to race ungenerously passing the 1000 metres placing DYLAN DE LAGO in restricted room with DYLAN DE LAGO having to be steadied and making the first turn awkwardly. RAROONEY also made the bend awkwardly when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of DYLAN DE LAGO.

BELLA MOSSA raced ungenerously getting its head up when being restrained near the 1000 metres then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of runners ahead for a distance.

I'LL STAND BY YOU continued to race greenly through the middle stages, being hampered passing the 800 metres when RAROONEY which was over-racing shifted outwards to avoid the heels of MISS SERENDIPITY. I'LL STAND BY YOU then dropped back quickly on to BELLA MOSSA which was hampered making contact with CHADSDALE (C Lammas) and losing ground. Also inconvenienced was DYLAN DE LAGO and PINZ CHARMING.

WARZONE (V Colgan) raced wide without cover throughout.

DYLAN DE LAGO was held up rounding the final turn.

RAROONEY was held up rounding the turn passing the 500 metres and raced ungenerously when having to be restrained. **RAROONEY** was then unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

DYLAN DE LAGO shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages hampering **PHOEBE SNOW** (D Johnson) just short of the finish and inconveniencing **GOTTA REPRIEVE** (B R Jones) and **WARZONE**. M McNab was issued with a warning

and advised that he must make a far greater attempt to maintain his mount on a straight line of running when riding in similar circumstances in future.

RAROONEY lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 2 ZEST 1200

TYNE COT (O Bosson) was slow to begin.

WAINUI PRINCE (U Holmquist) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of **KHEMOSABI** (M Hills). **WAINUI PRINCE** then raced ungenerously for a distance losing ground and continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

SUNBEAM (A Jones) began awkwardly.

HAPPYTO KEEPA (R Norvall) raced three wide without cover.

HAPPYTO KEEPA hung outwards rounding the final turn.

SUNBEAM was inconvenienced near the 200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **ELUSIVE GOLD** (B Hutton) after being taken in by **WAINUI PRINCE**.

Race 3 GILMOURS TAURANGA 3YO

ELETIST (B Hutton) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

AMBER RAYNE (R Smyth) had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages.

MARTINIZ SPECIAL (A Jones) lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4 SEEKA KIWIFRUIT INDUSTRIES 1400

POCKETS (C Lammas) began awkwardly losing ground.

PRESIDENT TOMADO (C Grylls) and **WADAPLEASURE** (G Cooksley) were crowded soon after leaving the barriers having to be steadid

LAMASON (M McNab) raced keenly in the early to middle stages when being restrained.

SEA OF SPEED (S Collett) and GARDONE (R Hannam) both raced wide without cover.

Race 5 TEAM WEALLEANS TAURANGA CLASSIC

NORTH AND SOUTH (R Hannam) reared at the start and was very slow away (3L).

AAJA NACHLE (S Spratt) shifted inwards abruptly leaving the barriers crowding **CASSIE ANNE** (M Cameron), **ALLEYOOP** (B Hutton) and **ROCKNROLLA** (S Collett) all of which were hampered losing ground. Contributing was outward movement from **EVEREADY** (T Thornton).

HOSTAGE (S McKay) and **CHOICE** (D Johnson) were slow away.

ALLEYOOP commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres continuing to do so into the middle stages.

AAJA NACHLE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

HAYLEY GRACE (M McNab) made contact with **NORTH AND SOUTH** when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 300 metres with those two runners continuing to come together for a distance.

When questioned S Spratt was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of **AAJA NACHLE** advising that the mare had travelled comfortably, but had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure.

B Hutton the rider of ALLEYOOP advised that the mare had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.

Post-race veterinary examinations of AAJA NACHLE and ALLEYOOP did not reveal any abnormality.

The track was downgraded to Heavy(10) following this race.

Race 6 GPS-IT PRECISION LAND MAPPING 1400

CASINO PARK (C Lammas) and THE GRADUATE (M Sweeney) were slow to begin.

SPOKE TO CARLO (D Johnson) began awkwardly.

COMMETT (M Cameron) shifted inwards leaving the barriers further inconveniencing **JESSHANIMO** (M McNab) which had begun awkwardly.

HAYPIN (T Thornton) over-raced in the middle stages.

PACE SETTER (B Hutton) made contact with **SPOKE TO CARLO** when attempting to shift outwards for clear running approaching the 600 metres.

YSABELLA BRAVE (U Holmquist) ran wide rounding the final turn passing the 400 metres taking **SPOKE TO CARLO** over extra ground.

Apprentice U Holmquist admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted her mount **YSABELLA BRAVE** to shift outwards near the 300 metres when not sufficiently clear of **SPOKE TO CARLO** which was hampered for a distance before being checked to avoid the heels of **YSABELLA BRAVE** near the 150 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Ms Holmquist's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 24 June until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 8 July, seven riding days.

SPOKE TO CARLO then shifted ground inwards across the heels of YSABELLA BRAVE to obtain clear running.

Race 7 QUADRANT PACIFIC 1600

JOEY JONZ (B Hutton) was slow to begin.

LITTLE ALFIE BROWN (R Norvall) began awkwardly and shifted outwards hampering SARABI (S Collett).

DRAGONKEEPER (R Smyth) began awkwardly before being crowded by **CLARA JANE** (V Colgan) which shifted inwards.

CLARA JANE continued to shift inwards briefly crowding DOIKNOWYOU (M McNab) and CORNELIUS (D Johnson).

LITTLE ALFIE BROWN shifted inwards approaching the 1400 metres when being restrained into the line of **DOIKNOWYOU** which clipped a heel and blundered. R Norvall admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with his license to ride in races being suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 27 June until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 2 July, three riding days. In assessing penalty the Judicial Committee took into account the excellent riding record of Mr Norvall.

CLARA JANE over-raced when being restrained near the 1200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **MAXIMUM HEIGHT** (C Grylls).

CORNELIUS over-raced when being restrained near the 1200 metres.

DOIKNOWYOU shifted outwards when attempting to improve forwards near the 800 metres inconveniencing **OLD DRUMBLE** (M Coleman). M McNab was advised to exercise more care.

DRAGONKEEPER shifted outwards under pressure inconveniencing **MAXIMUM HEIGHT** near the 300 metres.

CLARA JANE lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 8 ORORA KIWI PACKAGING – LRK TRAYS KIWIFRUIT CUP

INTRANSIGENT (K Smith) and PEACEFULEASYFEELIN (A Jones) were slow to begin.

PERMESSO (B Hutton) began awkwardly and was steadied.

SMARTLY (S Collett) was briefly crowded when weakening near the 350 metres.

MISS MOSSMAN (M Coleman) and ETHICAL (T Thornton) came together near the 200 metres with ETHICAL then being inclined to lay inwards for the remainder of the race inconveniencing MISS MOSSMAN passing the 100 metres.

M Coleman (MISS MOSSMAN) was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

Race 9 SWIRE SHIPPING 2100

BAHHTON (D Johnson), RETROSPECT (M McNab) and FAIR FLEET (B Hutton) were slow to begin.

LADY SAYYIDA (V Colgan) began awkwardly.

M Cameron (HIGHLY LIKELY) dropped his whip near the 400 metres.
