RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	COMMODORE HOTEL & TAGGART EARTHMOVING MAIDEN (1400m)
	<p>LOYALLE ISSY was slow to begin.</p> <p>RUB IT IN shifted inwards shortly after the start and dictated D'BOY inward. D'BOY shifted inwards abruptly away and hampered COUP TAURANGA which had to steady.</p> <p>ROUGH RULER made firm contact with WANDERIN ALONG shortly thereafter.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres WANDERIN ALONG (T Moseley) was placed in restricted room by ROUGH RULER (S Wynne).</p> <p>D'BOY continued to race ungenerously in the early stages and shifted outwards near the 1000 metres. WANDERIN ALONG raced fiercely when being restrained when tight to the inside of ROUGH RULER which continued on an inward movement. Apprentice S Wynne was severely reprimanded and issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and reminded that she must afford runners to the inside more room when shifting ground.</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres JULIEFOUNDER which commenced to over race shifted inwards and placed ROUGH RULER in restricted room momentarily. WANDERIN ALONG which was racing in tight quarters was further hampered in this incident, having to be steadied off heels for some distance.</p> <p>COUP TAURANGA raced keenly for a shortly distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>FERGIE raced wide throughout.</p> <p>ROUGH RULER shifted outwards across heels near the 250 metres.</p> <p>JIGGER INN shifted outwards under pressure near the 125 metres and made contact with JULIEFOUNDER.</p> <p>JULIEFOUNDER and JIGGER INN came together and brushed on two occasions in the final 100 metres.</p>

Race 2	INNOVATIVE LANDSCAPES & OPTIMISE FERTILISERS RATING 75 (1800m)
<p>LUCILLE was slow to begin. DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE began awkwardly and got back. PHEASANT was restrained to the rear on jumping. CODY CAT raced wide throughout. FLY ME TO DA MOON raced wide in the early to middle stages. KAGE IS KING was steadied for a short distance passing the 800 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of the heels of DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE. VANQUISHED gave ground quickly from the 600 metres, finishing in a distant last position. Rider D Bradley reported that in his opinion VANQUISHED had come to the end of its preparation and was unsuited to the prevailing track conditions. Trainers T & L Prendergast advised it was their intention to spell the gelding. VAPORETTO had to steady momentarily passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of the heels of CODY CAT which was dictated inwards by PHEASANT. A post race veterinary inspection of VANQUISHED did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 3	NORTH CANTERBURY VETERINARY CLINICS THREE-YEAR-OLD (1200m)
<p>LETSAVAFLING began awkwardly and got back. ALL DRESSED UP raced fiercely in the early stages. LETSAVAFLING raced keenly in the early stages. MIDNIGHT CAPPA shifted inwards and got its head up for a short distance passing the 1000 metres when restrained.DRIVING MISS DAISY was steadied in consequence. ALL DRESSED UP which had continued to race keenly shifted outwards passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of DRIVING MISS DAISY and made firm contact on two occasions with DOLLYADAY which was unbalanced momentarily.</p>	
Race 4	SONIA & GARRY THOMPSON OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>ISHIMINE began awkwardly, shifting out making contact with KEEPA TRAMP which got back. JACK'S RUN raced keenly in the early and middle stages. SIR SINGO was steadied passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed between ISHIMINE ,which shifted inwards, and JACK'S RUN.</p>	
Race 5	ACCESSMAN CITY RATING 65 (2000m)
<p>PUTT FOR CASH was very slow to begin. ODABELLA shifted inwards on jumping making contact with ANGEL FALLS and got back. PIENZA was steadied shortly after the start when awkwardly placed on the heels of SORLEY BOY. MISS MIA and PENTULTIMATE raced keenly in the early stages. PIENZA and ANGEL FALLS came together and bumped at the 150 metres when well back in the field. When questioned regarding the performance of ANGEL FALLS, apprentice rider S Wynne advised that the mare travelled lethargically in the conditions throughout and had disappointed. A post race veterinary inspection of ANGEL FALLS did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. Trainer D Champion reported that the mare may have choked down and he would consider a gear adjustment at its next start. When questioned regarding the performance of MISS MIA, apprentice rider R Cuneen reported that the mare travelled keenly in the early stages however when placed under pressure failed to run on. R Cuneen added that in his opinion MISS MIA was better suited to looser track conditions.</p>	
Race 6	GREENWOOD AMBERLEY CUP (1600m)
<p>TACTICALL was slow to begin. HEXIE HAO shifted out on jumping and made firm contact with TIMY TYLER. IRISH EXCUSE tended to get its head up when being restrained passing the 1500 metres and shifted outwards near the 1400 metres when racing ungenerously forcing THE GORDONIAN over extra ground for a short distance. Passing the 700 metres TIMY TYLER was placed in restricted room by ELECTRONIC MOTION which lay in.</p>	
Race 7	SMITHS HIRE RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>BIG HOSS was fractious in the barriers. TOETWOTOE was slow to begin. DO UNO WHOIAM raced wide throughout. BEACONS over raced near the 1000 metres and had to be steadied off heels. BIG HOSS raced wide in the middle stages. MAEVE DAVONE and EL BEE DEE were held up momentarily passing the 500 metres. CARMEN SANDIEGO lost the right front plate during the running. When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner CARMEN SANDIEGO, rider D Walsh reported that the</p>	

mare had become upset prior to the start due to **BIG HOSS** being fractious in the next barrier. He added that the mare never travelled at any stage.

A post race veterinary inspection of **CARMEN SANDIEGO** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 8

KONICA MINOLTA 'ROB FIELDER FAREWELL' RATING 75 (1400m)

LET'S ESCAPE was slow in the early stages.

DANCE was steadied off heels for a short distance near the 750 metres.

Passing the 700 metres **SPRINGWATER** shifted outwards and made contact with **CORBYN** which was unbalanced momentarily.

NATKINGCOLE shifted inwards under pressure in the concluding stages.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **CORBYN**, rider D Walsh advised that he received a bump at the 700 metres and the gelding had been flat from that point and had disappointed.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **LET'S ESCAPE**, apprentice rider B Murray advised that the mare had not handled the step up in class today.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **SPRINGWATER**, rider R Cuneen advised that in his opinion the mare had not handled today's Heavy (10) track conditions.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **BARBERRY ROZE**, apprentice rider A Morgan advised that the mare had not handled the sticky nature of today's Heavy (10) track, believing that the mare prefers wetter looser tracks.
